Pride Of The Chesapeake x 50

In August 1974, Nationwide purchased a struggling Middle-Of-The-Road station in Baltimore for \$975,000 and changed its call letters

from WFMM to WPOC – "Pride Of The Chesapeake." Newspaper ads heralding the station's Labor Day launch promoted its coverage of the NASCAR Southern 500, hardly mentioning it would also be the city's newest Country outlet. Fifty years later, WPOC is one of the format's most consistently successful stations with 49 total No. 1 books and an unparalleled 104 years' worth of combined tenure among its current airstaff. Country Aircheck caught up with WPOC staff past and present for the occasion.



Jeff Kapugi, PD (2020-present): It's fun to be a part of this, with Laurie DeYoung in her 40th year, Bob Delmont just celebrating his 25th and Michael J. Foxx in his 25th, there are a lot of milestones surrounding our 50th. They are stars in Baltimore. Everywhere they go, people want to take a picture with them. It's amazing to see how many people walk up and say, "I've listened to you forever."

Michael J. afternoon host (2000-present): Growing up in Baltimore, I remember WPOC was all my grandad listened to. He loved listening to Trish Hennessey – one of the first DJs on WPOC in the '70s. In 2000, Scott Lindy brought me back home to do afternoon drive, the same shift Trish was in two decades earlier.

Laurie DeYoung, morning host (1985-present): Baltimore is a unique city, I came here from San Diego, where I'd see bumper stickers that said, "Welcome to California, now go home." Baltimore is the opposite; this city is known for people who are born here and stay here. I love that. It really is like a big, small town.

Bob Moody, PD (1987-96): Laurie is a remarkable talent. She has a unique ability to come across as, not the girl next door, but as the neighbor you'd talk to over the fence. A lot of people don't realize she was part of a male-female duo at first. The guy, Rocky Marlowe, was the lead, but right away it struck me we needed to expand her role. After he left, Laurie said, "You know I can do this by myself," and she's still there doing better than ever.

The latter is precisely why they teamed up to found the nonprofit that aims to provide community, education, support and other resources for parents, caretakers and those wanting to have a family while working in the music industry (CAT 3/21).

Beyond the co-founders, FAM has assembled a task force of about a dozen volunteers who are establishing goals and support for the organization. Among those goals is working to improve benefits and

company policies with regard to childcare and elder care, including support for adoption and IVF journeys.

Like many women, Montgomery said she didn't see a lot of role models of successful women in the industry also raising children, and a few years ago began to think, "If I stay in this industry, maybe I'm not supposed to have a family." Inspired by the way Jones has been able to juggle her job and being mom to an eight-year-old daughter, she reached out for advice while simultaneously asking friends in the industry about family leave policies at their companies.

FAM has already succeeded in getting a handful of companies to change family leave or bereavement policies, Montgomery says, noting that one of the reasons there has been so much support is that "the industry needs to have this conversation. We were the catalyst for something that had been building up behind the scenes."

Even before connecting with Montgomery, Hart (a mother of two) says she and Jones had come to the realization that even though they both work at companies with "great benefits," conversations with others in the industry led them to the realization that "that wasn't the norm. We were having very disturbing conversations with younger women who weren't sure if they could stay in the industry and have kids. It was really heartbreaking."

Hart says the group's initial focus is on "making small changes, because we know that will lead to big action." Their priorities are advocacy, community and education. This includes family-friendly events like the group's kickoff at the RIAA Diamond certification party for artist Brett Young earlier this year. Plans include establishing grants in three areas – live entertainment (i.e. an artist who would like to provide family leave for a band member), a

small business without the resources to provide family leave, and for a recipient's fertility journey. Resources at familyallianceinmusic.org include primers on the best ways workers can talk with their HR departments about family care policies.


FAM has received a financial grant from the RIAA, sponsorship from Creative Visions and is consulted by Carla Denham of Brand Ethos Partners. They're on the lookout for additional task force members, particularly those with graphic design and social media skills.


Since starting the group "we feel so much more connected" to others, Montgomery says. "The conversations have shifted from, 'How's your artist' to, 'How's your kid or your mom.'" And they continue working to change the narrative. Says Montgomery, "Having passion for something outside of work doesn't mean you're less passionate about work. We have to start seeing [parenthood] as an asset and something that balances the mental health of our employees vs. something that takes away from their passion."

MCA's Josh Turner goes Off The Record: Honestly, I wouldn't tell the younger me to do anything different. The younger me did a great job holding true to his convictions and not being pushed around. Of course, I was young and made mistakes here and there, but that's part of the process and you learn more from your mistakes than you do your successes.



I didn't have a specific direction in mind with [This Country Music Thing]. There were

lots of personal things I was dealing with when I started the record, so I allowed the songs to dictate the direction and outcome. I'm very proud of how it turned out.

"This Country Music Thing" is a song I wrote myself ... but I don't have any recollection of writing it. It's a snapshot of my musical career from an early age to now. My producer thought it was the best way to kick this record process off, because it was autobiographical and honest. The outro with all the snippets came about after I had done my vocals when I was listening back to it. I started goofing off singing all these different country songs that I felt fit into the chord progression. And fans seem to really like the new music.

Scott Lindy, PD (1997-2004): I was working in AC in Richmond when I got a call about the PD job. I drove up to Baltimore, and when I finally listened to 'POC, I thought, "What's going on here?" In my interview, I told the GM how bad I thought the station was. He just let me keep digging my hole. I left there thinking I was an idiot. On the drive back to Richmond he called and offered me the job. I think the other candidates had all said the same things, and he heard things from me he hadn't heard from anyone else.

Bob Delmont, midday host (1999-present): When I got here, I learned there was a specific vision for the station: being family friendly, patriotic and

very local. Those things have helped the station be consistently at or near the top. When the Key Bridge collapsed earlier this year, we were able to give information and help listeners get through a tough time. Those are the special moments.

LD: Our big annual event is *Sunday In The Country*. We've done it for more than 20 years and it's part of our listeners' summer routine. There are a lot of people who've been to every one. Those are the kinds of things the community gets around, and it becomes part of their history as much as ours.

BM: WPOC helped a lot of artists get started in the '90's because it was among the most aggressive of the large market stations. The backside was we became known as the "12 Week Station" because after we'd been on a song for 12 weeks, we'd generally take it off, rest it a couple of weeks and put it back in as a recurrent. It didn't always make the labels happy, and it got to the point where they would ask me to hold off on adding a record. We were targeting the heavy users who listened 25 hours or more a week and those were the people who were going to get tired of a current before the average listener. If we could own that small segment and do ok with the rest, we'd do well. It was a strategy that seemed to work for us at the time.

SL: Right after I got there, Laurie was celebrating her 13th anniversary. I remember congratulating her and saying, "Here's to another 13." She said, "You've got to be kidding me, can you imagine doing this for another 13 years?" It took me years to be able to give her any valuable input because she just knew what to do. She has such great instincts; I hold her talent in

JK: This staff is very active. Any time you give them an idea you can see them thinking about how to make it a part of the WPOC brand. The rich programming history here has given them good feedback. It's not an airstaff that you aircheck; you talk strategies with them.

LD: I was at an event and two sisters in their early 20s approached me. They told me how growing up, their mom had addiction issues. They said, "When we listened to you in the morning, it made us realize that there














were moms out there who cared about their kids. You really got us through our childhood years." The fact that they tracked me down to tell me that – nothing in my career has meant as much as those two women.

BD: Baltimore is very blue collar, hardworking and loyal. When I got here, I immediately felt like everyone was family, and it's still like that. I didn't know how legendary this station was until I got the job, but I'm very lucky to be here.

SL: I just can't say enough about what I learned at WPOC. Mike McVay

once told me, "If you ever drive into a city and listen to a highly rated station and you don't get what they're talking about – that's a local radio station." And that's what WPOC has always been. I had no idea the profound impact that station and those people would have on me.

MJ: Baltimore accepts people from other places, but we can still tell when you're from here – we speak "Bawlmerese." This station is the same way. It's comfortable and part of the fabric of Baltimore. It's an amazing thing, especially when I still feel the responsibility of not messing up my grandad's one and only FM 93 WPOC. – Chris Huff
