
Prepare To Be Fired: Radio Pros Cope

Lifelong radio careers happen ... sometimes even in the same place (hello, <u>Mary McCoy</u>). Even before <u>consolidation</u>, however, broadcasting

Brook Stephens

has been a transient gig. **Country Aircheck** checked in with three established pros who recently hit the beach to see how they're coping ... and what they've learned.

The first of July started like any other weekday for **Brook Stephens**. That all changed when she arrived at work and learned that after two decades, her job as MD/afternoon host at KZPK/St. Cloud, MN was no more. "I thought it was a joke at first, and I literally laughed," she admits. "And then they were like, 'No, we're eliminating your position,' and it was like a kick to the gut. The first thing I thought was, 'What did I do wrong?'"



laid off, too."
In February, Isaac "Brooks" Wenzel learned he was no longer the APD/afternoon host at KBAY/San Jose. "I had this weird gut feeling and didn't sleep well the night before," he recalls. "When I

at that time and everyone around me was getting

woke up, I'd received a direct deposit in my account, and I thought that was weird because I'd just gotten paid. Then I looked at my workday system and my PTO was gone. While it was an unfortunate way to find out, I also appreciate it because I wasn't completely blindsided."

The Feel Deal: In the aftermath, the three experienced a range of emotions. "I was in shock most of the first day," recalls Stephens. "Nobody talks about what happens when you get home.

Black Opry Rises With The Phoenix

With the recent extension of her **Black Opry** brand into a label, **Black Opry Records**, co-founder **Holly G** is hoping to expand

opportunities for artists of color within the country and roots genres with the help of partner Thirty Tigers. Surprisingly, she says launching a record company had never been a goal.

"I was very much against starting a label, to be honest with you," she says. "I spend most of my time interacting with artists, and the overwhelming sentiment is that labels don't have their best interest in mind. I never wanted to put myself in a position where I was adversarial with artists I was trying to advocate for."

A meeting with Thirty Tigers co-founder / Pres. **David Macias** changed her mind. "He showed me a different way it could be done," she explains. "All of their artists own their own music and are in control of their projects – especially on the creative side." The partnership was "too good of an opportunity to pass up."

Debut artist Jett Holden's first album, the Will Hoge-produced *The Phoenix*, will be released Oct. 4 (<u>CAT 6/13</u>). The already available first single, "Backwood Proclamation," features Charlie Worsham and John



Osborne on guitar. And while the focus is on Holden right now, Black Opry Records has already signed a second artist, Tylar Bryant, who is working on an album for 2025.

Macias says he admired what Holly was doing from afar before partnering with her, calling her "a very sharp business person." Founded three years ago as an artist collective, the organization's touring arm – Black Opry Revue – does 60 dates a year and has given 150 artists an opportunity

to play paid shows. "I believe in what she's doing, and also in her ability to do it well," Macias says. He was also impressed with the relationships she's built, and "how much value is in the Black Opry name at this point."

With the label, Holly is hoping to combat the issue of "very talented artists not getting the same financial backing as their white peers," which she says makes it hard for them to compete. There are early signs of success. After announcing the label and Holden's single on a Thursday [6/13], Holly says, "By Friday we'd gotten seven pickups from DSP playlists, which was huge."

She's not currently planning to work Holden to Country radio, saying, "We would obviously really love the support from mainstream Country radio because, as you know, nothing happens in the country world without it. But given the history of the lack of support for marginalized artists, I don't think that's a smart use of our resources. If it happens organically, that would

be lovely. But I don't want to waste an opportunity knocking on a door that doesn't want to open.

"There's a huge demographic of people who love country music, but are not being served well by how restrictive the mainstream space is," Holly adds. "We want to develop an audience of people that just want to love country music and feel good about the people they're supporting." At the same time, she says, "We're making sure we're setting up artists to have long and sustainable careers."

For now, Thirty Tigers is handling label services for Black Opry Records (jokes Macias, "We're everyone's loving and dutiful back end staff") and Holly is doing A&R and artist development herself. Eventually, she says, "We're definitely going to need some staff, because I'm on my second Red Bull as I'm speaking to you." She's also managing Holden until his career gets to the point where it makes sense to shift those duties elsewhere.

Holden had a prior label developmental deal, but Holly says he was dropped after sharing that he is gay. "He was told,



'It might have worked if you were only black or only gay, but not both.' When people hear us talk about how we are marginalized and pushed out of the space, they think that it's something that we are either imagining or exaggerating. But that's what's happening behind the scenes."

Holden's status as the label's flagship artist carries more weight as a result. "Intersectionality is so important," Holly says. "And I want it to be very clear from the beginning that we are open, accepting, and loving everybody from any background. That's our ethos."

Adds Macias, "If you put together the credibility and good business sense that Holly brings to the table, the credibility we hopefully bring to the table, and the quality of the music, we're going to give this thing a real shot. I'm super excited about it." Reach Holly G here.








Chart Chat

Congratulations to **Shaboozey; Magnolia**'s **Heather Propper**, **Ray Vaughn** and **JC Coffey;** and **Heather Vassar** and the **Empire** team on taking his debut release, "Tipsy (A Bar Song)," to No. 1. This is the first chart-topper for Shaboozey, Magnolia and Empire, and is the first song to simultaneously serve as the first No. 1 for both an artist and a label since Big Loud and Chris Lane hit



the top with "Fix" in August 2016. Songwriters are **Nevin Sastry, Sean Cook, Jerrell Jones, Mark Williams** and **Collins Chibueze**.

Kudos to **Miranda McDonald** and the **MCA** promotion team on scoring 98 adds for "I Ain't Sayin'" by **Jordan Davis**. This is Davis' largest add week ever, surpassing the 56 for "Slow Dance In A Parking Lot" in April 2019. This also ends a near two-year drought atop the CA/MB Add Board for MCA, which hadn't topped the board since August 2022.

Nobody talks about how your child isn't going to understand. How he sees mom come home and wonders what happened. He asked my husband, 'Where are we going to sleep tonight?' We don't think about how there are ripples through a family."

"After the initial shock and a couple of days of crying, I jumped right into applying for jobs," says Schuler. "I got a job at Chick-fil-A, which isn't the most glamorous, but it keeps me busy, pays the bills and, honestly, it's a nice change. I got into radio when I was in college and it's pretty much the only job I've ever had, so this has given me a new appreciation for the things I've been able to do and what I want to do with my life going forward."

"A few weeks before it happened, I'd joined Orange Theory, so I really started working out heavily again and have been since," adds Wenzel. "Having more time to do that really helped, and it also helped from a metal health standpoint. I also gave myself grace. There are some days I do absolutely nothing – and I may feel a sense of guilt for it – but I have learned to be okay with that and appreciate the time off."

Resume Résumé: Looking back, Stephens says she's also gathered a lot from her experience. "I didn't know I'd have to contact a lawyer or negotiate severance," she says. "You don't have to have millions of dollars to have someone look over your contract and make sure you're not getting taken to the cleaners. Nobody teaches you that stuff; nobody ever wants to think about it. It's a little bit like planning your own funeral, and that's okay."

"Let yourself be upset, sad, mad, feel all those things you need to feel," advises Schuler. "At first, I tried to just take it on the chin and that was not a good idea. You never think it's going to happen to you so take a few days to be upset, listen to the sad songs, cry your eyes out, then turn around and give 'em hell."

"If you're discouraged, be discouraged; if you're angry, be angry," adds Wenzel. "You have every right to feel that way. This time around I knew I needed to slow down and not rush to find another job. It became a matter of how I could take advantage of this and utilize this time to take care of myself and put myself first."

"When you go through this, your imposter syndrome is going to go through the roof," explains Stephens. "You have to know your worth; it has not changed. In fact, you can add tax. You're still you. I could sit and be sad, but that's not going to get anybody anywhere, so I am working on improving my home studio and starting a podcast series to keep being creative, and to tap into being vulnerable and real about this experience. Even if only one person listens, if they get something out of it, then I will have done my job."



"This has almost made me question if I want to get back in radio," confesses Schuler. "Is constantly moving for new opportunities and uprooting my life for jobs that may or may not work out sustainable? There's a good chance if I take a radio job, that position could be eliminated in the next few years. I hope I can stay in the industry in some capacity, but radio may not be my path anymore, and that's a bummer because I love it so much. However, I have to do what's best for me and for my family."

"I hadn't truly been back home to Minneapolis since high school, so I thought, 'Why not take advantage of this and go back?'" says Wenzel, who is now doing part-time work at Hot AC KSTP. "Nothing lasts forever, and it's hard to go out on your own terms. Just like any goal, it's not a straight line. There are going to be ups and downs, so appreciate the journey. It might not feel like it in the moment, but things work out the way they're supposed to." Reach Stephens here; Schuler here and Wenzel here.




