Touring Update: Correction Underway



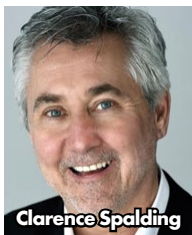

Coming out of the pandemic, the country music touring business was as robust as it has ever been. Several years later, industry leaders are exercising caution. Spurred by economic conditions, a crowded marketplace and perhaps even some greed, country touring is adjusting to a new reality. That said, developmental bright spots and a clean sheet at several stadiums point to a better 2027.

"All genres are feeling it," says AEG SVP/Global Touring & Talent **Adam Weiser**. "Stadiums are predominantly country, with Luke Combs, Zach Bryan and Morgan Wallen taking the lion's share of the business even with FIFA [World Cup soccer] taking out a lot of major markets. But for the artists who've been going out year after year for four or five years now, this is the year it's become harder."

Calling the market "tough," CAA Agent **Chad Kudelka** says the post-COVID bump is over.

"We were wondering if that was the new ceiling, or if we were going to come back down. We did. We're there. We have to be really careful in rethinking venue size, ticket prices and how much traffic is out there. We saw all the late summer and fall tours coming – eight or nine acts doing on-sales in the same window for shows that were landing within three or four months. Something was going to break, and that's exactly what happened. Everybody's feeling it."

Country Thunder President **Troy Vollhoffer's** festivals are doing well – including celebrating 30 years of *Country Thunder Wisconsin* this month – but many similar events don't enjoy that kind of longevity. "The strong will survive and the weak will go away," he says. "The cost of booking some artists is outpacing the ability to sell tickets. That's where you see festivals [fail]. This happened in the late '90s,

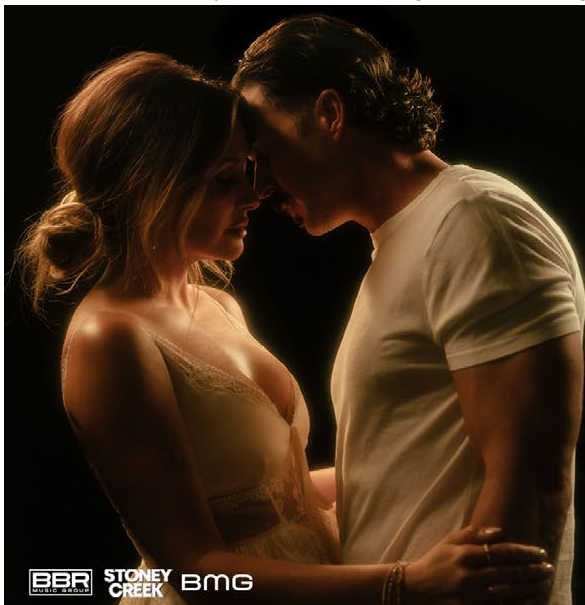

Q2 PPM Drivetime Leaders

Following the release of the June Nielsen PPM monthlies, **Country Aircheck** has analyzed Q2 numbers to determine the stations with leading shares and cumes in drivetimes. Quarterly averages eliminate the wobbles that can be present at a daypart level on a month-to-month basis. Additionally, with Cumulus no longer subscribing to Nielsen, several stations that previously landed on the leaderboards are no longer shown in ratings releases. All figures are Persons 6+.

Mornings: For the first time since CA began tracking daypart leaders, **KKGO/Los Angeles** takes the crown in morning cume. **Bruce Scott**, who joined the station in March 2025, reached 320,700 listeners, enough to help KKGO leapfrog last quarter's top three. Just 2,400 listeners behind KKGO is last quarter's leader, **KKBQ/Houston**, followed by **WUSN/Chicago** and **KILT/Houston**. **KEEY/Minneapolis'** **Chris Carr & Co.** notches its first ever top five finish.

In the share category, last quarter's leaders, **WWYZ/Hartford's** **Damon Scott** and **Amanda Jo Parker**, finish in a tie with fellow New Englanders **Courtney Kelley** and **Brendan Sharp** from **WCTK/Providence**, with each show pulling a 9.3 share. WCTK's rise from third marks its first quarter at the top of the list. Ohio is represented in third and fourth place by **WCOL/Columbus** and **WUBE/Cincinnati** respectively, while KEEY duplicates its No. 5 finish in cume category.

Afternoons: After having a three-quarter streak at the top snapped in Q1, **WUSN's** **Scotty Kay** returns to the top with a cume of 476,700. In his first quarter since moving from middays, **KKGO's** **Adam Bookbinder** leads the station to a best-ever second place finish, while last quarter's cume leader, **KKBQ's** **Lauren "Lo" Sessions** rounds out the top three.

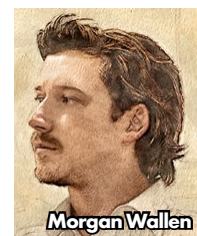
In the share category, WCTK's **Kevin Lawrence** is edged out of first place for the first time in six quarters, finishing half a share behind WWYZ's **Brandon Clay**, who also joins the first-timers club thanks to an even 11 share. Holding steady in third place is WUBE's **Big Dave Show**.

One other achievement worth noting: for the first time in CA tracking, one station has finished in the top 10 in all four categories, as **KCYY/San Antonio's** **Erik & Jenny** finished top 10 in both morning share and cume, and **Brody** finished top 10 in afternoon share and cume. Chart Chat

Congratulations to **Morgan Wallen**, **Tyler Vaughn**, **Lauren "LT" Thomas** and the **Big Loud** promotion team on taking "Don't We" to No. 1. This is Wallen's 22nd visit to the top and moves him into a tie for 19th most with **Brooks**



& Dunn and Brad Paisley. Songwriters are **Rocky Block, John Byron, Ashley Gorley, Blake Pendergrass, Ryan Vojtesak** and Wallen.

Not content with simply taking the No. 1 position, the Big Loud crew also topped this week's Add Board with Wallen's next single, "Been By Now," which landed 157 adds out of 158 reporters. It is Wallen's biggest solo add week, and with 99.4% of the panel, it is the second largest percentage of the panel closed in its first week in the Mediabase era. Only the three releases that closed the entire panel ("I Had Some Help," "Carry On" and "I Knew It, I Knew You") rank higher.

Additionally, "Been By Now" sets a record with its No. 24 debut on the chart, becoming Wallen's highest solo debut, and the second-highest debut this decade, eclipsed only by the No. 15 debut of "I Had Some Help."

as well, where the market corrected and you saw a lot of festivals [fold]. I don't know if it's fully corrected yet."

Johnny Bench: "I don't know that there is enough headline talent to fulfill the demand all the fairs and festivals had," says Maverick Management Partner **Clarence Spalding**. "In year one and year two of a festival, it might be great. But you get to year three and have already had Morgan, Luke, Luke and Jason – now what do I do?"

Spalding illustrates from past experience: "Years ago when I did Neon Circus with Brooks & Dunn, we had Toby Keith, Keith Urban and Montgomery Gentry in support," he says. "The second year I had Rascal Flatts, Brad Paisley and Trick Pony. And so on. [Live Nation's Brian] O'Connell and I got to year four and I just looked at him and said, 'There's no fucking year four. I've run out of talent.'"

And quick hits don't build careers. "There are positives and negatives to the ease of access to music," Kudelka says. "Artists can have a viral moment with millions of streams and all of a sudden there's this madness in trying to figure out what's real and what's not in sustaining long term business. We used to work at breaking artists regionally and expand from that. Now, some young artists are eager to very quickly capture the entire country even when they're at a point that they haven't really set foot on a stage."

Vollhoffer agrees. "I can think of an artist who had a minor hit and was quoting a \$50,000 fee. Now they're up to \$150,000 and nothing has happened in that person's career."

Old School: "Part of it is that we're a bunch of greedy fucks," Spalding adds. "We always want more money. Just because a young artist has a hit doesn't mean there's more in the tank, but all of a sudden, they're a \$100,000 act. They're building something online – on the phones – but most people can't afford to pay someone \$100,000 for direct support, so you can't get on a tour."

"The traditional way of building a fan base means becoming a better performer," he says. "I know that sounds old school because it is. Use that TikTok fame while applying the old school approach, but don't try to get all the money all at one time."

The good news is that sustainable careers continue to be built. "We're fortunate to work with artists and managers who understand this," Kudelka says. "Some folks have gone to the grind of what things looked like prior to COVID; keep demand high as opposed to stretching things too thin and getting into a problematic spot. It can go away faster than it was gained if you don't protect demand."

"What we've done really well is build some great female artists in Megan Moroney, Ella Langley and Lainey Wilson," says Vollhoffer. "That's a fantastic strength we haven't had in a long time. And there are now genres within the genre with bands like The Red Clay Strays and Treaty Oak Revival."

Six-Seven: "Megan Moroney has had a great year and I expect '27 to be even bigger," Spalding says. "Same with Ella Langley and Riley Green. They did the support dates and are great examples of artists who had a hit and didn't immediately decide they were a headliner. All three have the opportunity for long careers."

Meanwhile, even long-tenured names are doing great business. "Brooks & Dunn are as hot as ever," Spalding says. "I have a sold out tour on an act I've been with for 34 years. But here's the thing: We're doing 21 shows. We're not trying to do 50 or 60. I think we're doing 27 with Jason Aldean. You have to protect the markets instead of constantly beating them up."

"The great thing is, I don't have acts that need the money," he continues. "I've done that before in my career, and I'm not even sure that's artist management at that point. 'You have \$50,000? We'll fucking take it. We don't care where it is, my act needs the money.' They bought two farms and have a sister and a brother on the payroll. They want to support their band. Now the artist works for their siblings and the band. There are a lot of acts in that position."

But for the most part, the industry is adjusting to the new reality. "We're more mindful than ever of what people are going through economically," Weiser says. "Going to a concert is not just the ticket price. It's parking, dinner, drinks, merch – some shows cost as much as a vacation. Being

OFF THE RECORD

Spirit Music songwriter **Jamie Moore** shares the stories behind some of his cuts:

Rodney Clawson and I co-wrote "May We All," and from the beginning we thought it would be a great pitch for Tim McGraw. When we played the song for Big Loud, they loved it and wanted Florida Georgia Line to record it. After cutting the song, Joey Moi, the producer at the time, called me with a surprise ... we had a feature on the track: Tim McGraw!

A few weeks later, I was just walking into Whole Foods when I spotted a guy with a baseball cap covering his eyes, looking like he'd never skipped a workout. And yes, it was Tim McGraw.

I approached him, introduced myself and said, "You don't know me, but you recorded a song of mine a few weeks ago, and I wanted to say thanks." He looked at me a bit suspiciously and asked, "What song are you talking about?" I replied, "May We All." He hugged me and said, "You wrote that?" He then said that song is a hit and is the next single.

This was a typical day at the office. Big Loud had just signed a new artist with an incredible voice from East Tennessee. Morgan [Wallen] and I had written several times, but never really found the right vibe. On this particular day, we were writing with Craig Wiseman. After popcorn and coffee, we walk into Craig's studio and Morgan says, "I think I have a title I wanna write today." I started strumming some chords and melodies start flowing through the room. Morgan started singing this falsetto melody, which is what you hear today. Craig walks out on to the patio for about 15-20 minutes or so and says, "How 'bout this: used to chase that Chattanooga freight ..." He had just about written the whole first verse. "Chasin' You" became one of Morgan's biggest hits and was recently certified Diamond.

I remember the day we wrote "I Wish You Would." There were four of us: Chris Tompkins, Mackenzie Carpenter, myself and Jonathan Hutcherson. We couldn't find a vibe and probably trashed two or three ideas. I walked out of the room and came back with an "ePeephany." Somehow something hit me walking down the hall, and I walked in the room and sang "I wish, I wish, I wish you would."

Everyone loved it and jumped in and started adding to the idea. We probably finished the song in 15 mins. The label recorded it, but there was something special about the demo we did that day. We went back to the demo version and added Midland as a featured artist.

Thank God for artists who still record outside songs. That's what makes Nashville unique, and what I consider the last standing songwriting community in the world. I wrote "Mexico" with Kat Higgins and Derick Southerland. It was fun making up a story about robbing a bank and escaping to Mexico, and Carrie Underwood delivered an amazing performance on this track.

I'm originally from Muscle Shoals, AL, and I worked at a music store called Counts Bros. Music. I would see Marty Raybon in the store from time to time and loved the band Shenandoah. After Brett Beavers, Kevin Griffin and I co-wrote "Every Road," I sent it to my publisher and they loved it, but we never really got any action on it. Six years later, Shenandoah released the song and featured Dierks Bentley.

mindful of the price of the entire experience is incredibly important."

Looking ahead, there's cautious optimism. "For stadiums, 2027 will be great," Weiser says. "There's a clean slate of major markets [post-World Cup]. Beyond that, it's about making smarter decisions. When was the last time we were in the market? Instead of playing 40 shows, can we look at 20 or 30?"

Spalding would like to see smarter decisions, as well. "Our tours are done for '27," he says. "I'm looking at support, but it's harder to get the right support because they all think they're headliners. Back to the point about Neon Circus. Would I be able to get Urban, Flatts or Paisley to go on before us today? [In this climate] acts like that might insist on headlining. But look at the careers those artists ended up having."

For Vollhoffer's business, "next year is looking pretty darn good." He adds, "And if you're a music fan, you need to get out and support your artists and events. If you don't, they will go away. You gotta go to the shows."
