Inside The CMA Awards

Exec. Prod. Robert Deaton tells the behind-the-scenes stories from the 59th Annual CMA Awards.

CA: What was the first thing you did when you started putting together this year's show?

RD: Figuring out who the host was going to be, and that was simple. We had three great years with Peyton Manning and Luke Bryan who, by



the way, we would love to have back some day. But the era of spending 12 years as host - which is what Vince Gill as well as Brad Paisley and Carrie Underwood did – we don't have that luxury anymore. The world moves much faster; every three or four years, it's time to take another look at it. It was not lost on me that Lainey Wilson would be the third solo female host after Reba McEntire and Dolly Parton. With her historic rise and everything she represents for

country music and women - everything she said in her acceptance about how Reba, Miranda Lambert and others have poured into her, she's doing the same. She's passing that down to Ella Langley, Megan Moroney and the next generation coming up. We were in a place to contribute to history so that was the first ask.

How did you land on the musical medley for the open?

I'm always giving credit where it's due and people have asked many



times about how I put together Chris Stapleton and Justin Timberlake, but they were friends already. All I said was yes. In this case, I'm actually able to say I had the idea early on. We have plenty of negativity in the world and the idea for the overall arc of the show was positivity around our artists, songs

and community. For a three-hour show that's about loving country music, a musical open – which we've never done – was a good fit.

Gosselin's 'Almost Famous' Career

With Valory Dir./Northeast Promotion **Don Gosselin** retiring this month after what he says were "two marvelous careers" in radio and records (CAT 10/23), Country Aircheck caught up with him to share his best stories from both.

CA: What drew you into your radio career almost 40 years ago?

DG: I lived the movie Almost Famous with J. Geils Band, who are from my hometown of Boston, I was about 15 or 16 and wanted to meet them, so I made up a newspaper - The Hingham Times, which doesn't exist - called the record

label for their support act and said I'd like to interview them when they came to town. It worked! I picked up my credentials, and using the same tape recorder they had in Almost Famous, did the worst interview ever. Just awful.

After the interview, I found myself hanging with the cool kids wondering how they all got [backstage,] and realized they

were all in radio. I was blessed

with a pretty deep voice, so I

thought, "Easy. I can do that." When I went to Curry College, I started working at the campus station, WMLN, and just fell in head over heels. There was nothing else I wanted to do.

What's a favorite radio prank or promotion you pulled off?

At WHJY, we closed the city of Providence as an April Fool's joke. We reported on the air that the [fictitious] Committee For A Greater Providence had announced that the city would be closed that day, including schools,

banks and libraries, and there would be no mail delivery. We gave listeners a number to call to find out if their business was open, and it was the hotline of our competitor, WPRO. The news media went to them to get their side of the story, and they said it shut their switchboard down.

At WIOT/Toledo,



we did a promotion for Valentine's Day called "screw over your ex" that involved putting the winner in a helicopter with their new significant other to hover over their exes house and enjoy some private time in the backseat.

Any memorable stories from your record career?

I'm less than a year into the job at Valory, and Thomas Rhett is opening for Kenny Chesney at Gillette Stadium. I don't know what I'm doing yet and open the suite door where I'm supposed to have 14 local radio guests, but there's 40 or 50 people inside. So I announce, "Whoever's coming to meet Thomas Rhett, follow me right now." Of course everyone followed. I'm handing out passes like candy. We're coming down the runway to the dressing rooms,

Play It Again Music's **Faith Hopkins** takes **Country Aircheck** track-by-track through her Love & Insanity EP:

"Dodged a Bullet" is about losing someone you know was bad for you, and how it can still hurt anyway. It was inspired by ex-boyfriends who weren't good for me and old friends I needed to walk away from, yet I still felt heartbroken even knowing I was better



off without them. The song opens as a ballad, then the second verse hits with a surprising emotional shift in both the production and the lyrics, which I love.

The title track started with the word "insanity" itself. I was drawn to it. It made me think about all the times I've felt like I was going insane over heartbreak, and how you can only feel that way when you've loved someone deeply. That's the feeling I wanted the song to capture.

I had the line "I was an open book and you were illiterate" sitting in my phone for a while. When I brought it to a session with my favorite co-writers, Emily Landis and Evan Cline, they immediately started laughing, and I knew we had to write it. "Open Book" is inspired by the people I've poured my heart out to who gave nothing back. It's simple, direct, and it makes me giggle, which is why I love it.

"Break It You Buy It" came from a moment watching the TV show White Lotus, actually. There was a T-shirt with a broken heart that said "you break it you buy it," and I instantly knew I needed to write that song. It's about someone who won't fully commit, who leads you on because they're unsure. Dating can feel so unfair, and I've watched myself and so many friends go through situations like that. I wanted to make a sad, upbeat track you can cry to or scream along with.

"Get Away With Murder" was one of those ideas that popped into my head out of nowhere. It made me think of the feeling of having a crush, and the heart-drop moment when you see that person. It's flirty and fun and exciting but mid-tempo and meant to be an easy listen. This one was written so fast, and it was actually one of my favorite songs to write. We got to take chances with production and lyrics, and it was one of those times that pushing myself out of my comfort zone a little really surprised me in the best way.

right on time, and I think I'm the conquering hero until Thomas Rhett's tour manager starts screaming. I didn't know what to do, but Thomas came out and said hi to everyone.

When I got back to the pit to meet [bosses] George Briner and Ashley Sidoti, I found myself on the wrong side of the stage. TR's manager, Virginia Bunetta, tells me to just cut across the empty stage in front of the drums real fast, but I took two steps onto the stage and the tour manager practically tackled me. I never lived that night down. It has been re-told a hundred different ways and morphed into a version



where I pushed TR aside and took a couple of licks on the drums $\mbox{\it myself!}$

Why retire now?

I wasn't tired of the job, I was just tired of working. I'm going to be 66 in January. I've run my course, and thankfully, financially, I'm able to do it.

What will you miss the most ... or not miss?

I'll miss not having to pay to see live music. I won't miss the 4am wake-up calls, five-hour drives, cancelled flights, time sitting in airports and the rental car returns.

Other than golfing, what are your retirement plans?

I'm thinking about umpiring baseball, which I used to love to do, or being an assistant golf coach at one of the high schools here in New Orleans. But my hashtag is #ValoryForLife, so I could see myself down the road, if we're in a tight No. 1 battle, coming back for a couple of weeks to help push something over the finish line.







One of the important things opening monologues did in the past was let the viewer know who's in the room. In this case, Lainey would walk down and go around to each person. At first I thought about doing the hits of the past year, but I realized this could sort of be Lainey's playlist with "You Look Like You Love Me" next to "Redneck Woman."

I took a day and went over to the home studio of the show's music director, Danny Rader. We started playing with the music and figuring out the order. The biggest thing was to have surprises. We're going left ... okay, we're swinging right. One thing to the next. Once we established that and the audience thinks they know what we're doing, let's do a misdirect and have Little Big Town holding microphones stand up to sing the chorus of "Girl Crush." And then one more misdirect back to the main stage as Keith Urban walks out.

You did have a comedic monologue of sorts with Lainey and Leanne Morgan.

We wanted to pepper the entire night with guests. My wife Susan became friends with Leanne six or seven years ago, and Lainey is close with her so that made perfect sense. The idea was for each guest to bring their own brand and personality to the moment. So it's shifting, fresh and bright all night. We were



going to do separate bits with Leanne, but decided to have an entire meal at the top of act two as almost a second monologue. You put a superstar in there with Luke Combs and a brand new artist in Zach Top, who has never been on the show, and the tone is now set for the viewer. This show is about the love of country music, it's unexpected and it's fun.

Has Luke Combs ever had the opening performance before?

That's the question I asked his manager, Kappy, and I said I think this is the year. There's about eight of us on my creative team – the best in the



world – and we get together for two or three days in one room and it's a great time. "Alright, Luke Combs." We press play on the song and start coming up with ideas. "Back In The Saddle" had us thinking about rodeos, leather, dirt and horses, so we wanted to build a chute to remind us of that. It's the open, so it had to

be grand and have fire in it. That's the process for that and basically every performance we have.

You can't be sensitive in that room because we don't have enough time. If the idea doesn't work, even if it's mine, we have to move on. The good thing is we've done this enough that we understand the artists' brands. We're normally able to come to those decisions rather quickly.

When did you know Stephen Wilson, Jr. was going to have a moment?

The first time I streamed his music. All I needed is for him to get one nomination and that moment was going to happen. When you book the



show, you have to go by the nominations and popularity. Sometimes, and it is not every year, something is so great that to not give it a shot would be a crime. The first time I heard him I was like, just give me a nomination. I was hoping he would want to do that song and [my pitch] to management was to have him on the satellite stage with just a backlight and a key light. There was nothing else like it in the show. And now it's viral.

How did the moment for Vince come together?

His longtime manager Larry Fitzgerald helped me immensely. I wanted this to make Vince cry, of course, but I didn't want a bunch of artists playing

snippets of songs.
Larry was in complete agreement. I wanted to go back to the beginning with "When I Call Your Name" and do the entire song. That was before we knew who was going to do it. Larry suggested Brandi Carlile and then we thought it would be great if we could get Patty Loveless to



do harmony. Vince sang that song pretty high already, then you put it in a female voice and it was even higher. We had to figure out how it would sound to have harmony underneath the lead vocal.

Beyond that, this was special because when I first started as a CMA [board member], I was the Television Committee chair, and Larry was my co-chair. He was the one who said I should be producing the CMA Fest show when we launched it, so without him, I'm not sure how that would have played out. To be doing this tribute with Larry, to be with him in rehearsals in what may be the last thing he does with CMA, was extra special.

There were fewer out-of-format collaborations this year. Was that intentional or did it happen organically?

That's just how it landed. I don't look at the show and think we need pop artists. There has to be connective tissue; it has to be organic. This show has to represent country music, the CMA board, voting members and the audience. It's not about what I want.

What didn't end up in the show that you thought might happen?

There were several things that got cut out, but I don't want to name names. What I will say is we have great managers in this format and a couple of times specifically where someone said, "Let's stand down this year because we just don't have a good idea." Superstar artists, but we drew a blank on what to do. So let's stand down. We'll do something next year.

But I loved how many new artists we had. From Zach to Ella, Riley Green with a big performance, Stephen, Tucker Wetmore and The Red Clay Strays. We had so many hits and a great range of superstars to newcomers. I think we accomplished what we set out to do: Keep the negativity out of the room and enjoy being together. How lucky we are to be part of this. —Chuck Aly
