Q&A: Cumulus' Travis Daily

More than a year into his role as PD for WKDF & WSM-FM/Nashville, **Travis Daily** recently orchestrated airplay and personality changes on the



two stations. Big D & Bubba shifted to WSM mornings, Cumulus sister KUBL/Salt Lake City's Jesse James (who worked with Daily there) was brought in for mornings on 'KDF. Afternooner Tyler Reese moved to WSM, while Daily took the airshift at WKDF. Lucas Phelan joined WSM in middays, while WKDF's Amy Paige remains in the shift. Current and recurrent airplay have increased substantially on both (see box page 8). Below, he discusses the changes, as well as his role as Cumulus VP/Country.

CA: What's your vision for these Nashville stations?

TD: The short version is WSM will be a more traditional mainstream Country station, and on WKDF, we're not going to have any rules. We're going to be disruptive and do what we want.

We're hearing songs that aren't being worked as singles on 'KDF. What's your criteria?

We spend a lot of time listening to music. Our system is literally just: "Is that cool enough to be on the station? If so, let's put it in."

Who's part of those music meetings?

It's a collective effort amongst many. There are several ways we're identifying new music to play. Interestingly, nobody calls radio stations anymore, but our phones are ringing. Lainey Wilson's "Whiskey Colored Crayon," Hardy's "Girl With A Gun," Nate Smith and Hardy's "Nobody Likes Your Girlfriend" and Riley Green's "Jesus Saves" are driving a ton of phones. Looking at the top 20 things people call about, I get to number 17 before one of them is a single. I've gotten more calls for songs that we've spun six or seven times than I have for some that have a couple hundred. My show and Jesse's are phone driven, so that could be part of it, but we're not telling them what to call or talk about. Maybe it's because this is new. I guess if it keeps up, we'll know.

That's got to be exciting for you and the team.

Radio is supposed to be fun, and I don't believe that every station across America needs to sound the same. On the other side of this, they're going to say that we're a bunch of idiots and "I told you it wouldn't work." Or they're not. We'll see.



Chuck Swaney: Whiskey Guy


As side-hustles go, whiskey is an unlikely one for Red Light Head/Country Promotion **Chuck Swaney** considering his very shaky start with the spirit in high school. Decades later, Swaney has a website, email newsletter and hosts monthly tasting events as the Nashville Whiskey Guy. And it's all sort of Eric Church's fault.


"One of my friends was drafted in the first round by the Detroit Tigers – my hometown team," Swaney says. "The boys got together for a little Michigan baseball

party, and one of them brought a two-gallon bottle of Jack Daniels. We decided to have a shot contest. This was my first time drinking whiskey and I made it to about six shots before the room started spinning. I rolled out of the basement on all fours and tried to walk the mile-and-half home. I made it about four driveways. That's where they found me later in a puddle of my bad decisions."

Swaney didn't drink whiskey again for 30 years, but he did build a successful career in the music business that included stops with Capitol, Southern Ground and EMI Nashville. Enter Church. "I was doing two regions at the same time because we were a lean startup, so I had a lot of shows with Eric and we really hit it off. One day I got a text to come to the bus, where he challenged me. 'If we're going to work together, you need to start drinking whiskey.' It was a reverse intervention."

Having a relationship with Jack Daniels meant a master distiller taught Church the proper way to taste whiskey, a skill he imparted to Swaney. "That's the start of it," Swaney says. "During COVID there were no shows, my kids were grown and I suddenly had time. I got accreditation to be a bourbon steward and, when the pandemic lifted, took a weekend of classes in Louisville to become a certified bourbon professional."

Doing tastings for friends and family grew into something more when his wife Stephanie built a website. "That's in her bag of tricks, but people looked at it and were surprised how professional it looked," he says, noting his Whiskey Wednesday newsletter comes out every other week.

Drink In My Plan: When Church's downtown bar Chief's was under construction, Swaney got a hard-hat tour. "On one of the floors I told the GM, Heather Otto, it looked like a great room for a whiskey tasting. She'd worked wine tastings in New York and said, 'I want that here.' So we figured it out. It's the only monthly whiskey event in Nashville. We partner with distributors and distilleries and have some nice events."

Swaney hosted a tasting for VIPs during CRS – aided by MCA's Damon Moberly – and most recently did a Jack Daniels tasting in June. He's also building out a direct-to-you service that offers tasting events for groups at their short-term rental. He recently booked one for tourists from Amsterdam. "I guess I'm international, now," he jokes.

Fortunately, there's no risk of repeating his first foray into whiskey. "I'm actually a very moderate drinker and rarely have more than two drinks," he says. "Being in the whiskey business doesn't mean I'm a drunk. I'm very thoughtful about it. And while I'm nowhere close to wanting to retire, this is a fun side-hustle that doesn't impede on my job ... and I enjoy it." Thanks, Eric.



How do the airstaff changes play into this?

My dad was a baseball coach, and I was taught you put the right players in the right positions to try and win the game. We're trying. I don't mean to be simple or evasive, but that's really what it is. We've got really solid talent. Big D & Bubba are some of the best to ever do it. Lucas Phelan is amazing. Tyler Reese is amazing. On WKDF, which is the "don't have any rules" station, Jesse and I were built for that. If there are two guys who don't listen and don't want to play by rules, it's us. We've both had a lot of success, but we've both been fired a lot, so we're perfect for this scenario.

Some of this we're figuring out as we go. I just don't think radio has to be safe and boring, and we're trying to make both stations interesting in different ways.

How are you finding Nashville?

I didn't think I'd love any place more than Tampa, but I already love Nashville more. The only tough part is in Tampa, if I messed something up, nobody said anything. If I mess something up here, there's a songwriter, manager – maybe even an artist – calling to say, "That's not right!" That's a bit of an adjustment.

Is there more pressure with the labels here?

I don't feel any pressure at all. I respect that they have a job to do, but ultimately I work for [Cumulus CCO] Brian Philips. We want to be strong partners to everybody, and don't want to disrupt that part of it, but on 'KDF, if we think something's cooler than the single ... sorry.

Has any of that affected your role with the other Cumulus stations? Are these songs being given consideration on your PD calls?

Since day one, I've encouraged everybody to program their radio station for their market. When you pull into Dallas, Mike Preston's stations sound like they're in Texas. That should be everybody's goal. In the same way, I'm hoping one day when you pull into Nashville, you'll think, "Man, this sounds like Nashville. This thing's cool and all over the place." There's a lot of great art that never gets showcased on the radio here, and we're going to try and do that on 'KDF, while WSM will be the more traditional hit-driven station.

It's always bothered me that you could drive from Florida to Washington and hear the same radio station all the way across the country on different frequencies. I don't think that should be our goal.

You're a year into the format-wide job. Is it slowing down yet?

No, because back to my dad being a coach, even if you win a championship, two is better than one. It doesn't matter where we're at, I'll never be satisfied. Tomorrow we're going to try to be better than today. We're going to have a hell of a lot of fun and try to win some championships.

The recent Corey Kent No. 1 was languishing last year before Preston had success with it and the rest of Cumulus jumped in, so is that a model you'd like to see repeated? Is that kind of discovery a goal?

I have a team of smart programmers who care about music, and I feel very blessed about that. There's a difference in caring about the music and caring about the brand, and just trying to get through the day. My guys aren't trying to get through the day. They're really trying to do something great. We're going to make some mistakes, but I'd rather swing for the fence 10 times and hit two home runs than have four singles.

Are you enjoying being on the air?

I thought I was done with it, but I'm surprised at how much I'm enjoying this, even though it's a lot. I was going to try being an adult for a little bit, and now I realize that maybe that's not my thing.

Is there anything you want to say to the music business, your radio colleagues or the creative community that we haven't discussed so far?

Radio is not dead. If you do it right, it's still the most powerful tool on the planet. It's a hell of a lot of work, but it can also be a lot of fun. To the artists and songwriters: don't give up on us. We're going to prove that to you here





NEW COUNTRY AIRCHECK/MEDIABASE REPORTER WEIGHTS

A revised methodology has been implemented to calculate new weights for **Country Aircheck/Mediabase** Country Published and Activator reporter panels, based on audience figures from Nielsen. Weights for stations in PPM markets use a three-month average of January-February-March 2025 AQH Persons. Winter 2025 AQH Persons figure is used for diary markets. The weights are calculated using this formula: Market rank is multiplied by 10 and then added to the station's AQH Persons. A station's weight is determined by dividing that adjusted AQH by an average of the top five AQH Country stations.

For this period on the Published panel, those stations are **KKBQ**/

Houston (22,160), WUSN/Chicago (19,130), WXTU/Philadelphia (16,250), KKGO/Los Angeles (14,820) and KSCS/Dallas (14,440). The five-station average AQHP used as the divisor is 17,360.

For Activator weights, those stations are **WKSF/Asheville** (7,230), **WIOV/Lancaster** (6,960), **WQXK/Youngstown** (6,150), **WACO/Waco** (5,870) and **WFRG/Utica-Rome** (5,030). The five-station average is 6,248.

Station Weight = AQHP + (market rank X 10) divided by 17,360 (6,248 for Activator stations). These new weights are effective with this week's Country Aircheck/Mediabase Country chart.




