### **DEBUNKING THE CORPORATE PLAYLIST**

How much centralized control over music is there at Country radio today? Have, as some suggest, playlist cramdowns resulted in identical playlists across a company's stations? A recent discussion with CBS Radio VP/Country and KILT/Houston PD **Jeff Garrison** centered on just that subject. He used Mediabase to compile an overview of the CBS Country outlets and was surprised at the diversity among the stations. That led us to this week's musical comparison of some of our format's top owners.

**Current Comparison:** Leading with Garrison's **CBS Radio**, only 13 current titles received at least 10 plays per week (light rotation) on all 13 of its **Country Aircheck** reporting stations during our Oct. 1-7 time frame. In an attempt to mitigate regional considerations or programmer prejudices that might prevent across the board unanimity, we also looked at how many songs got at least 10 spins a week on at least 10 of the 13 stations. At CBS Radio, 21 different titles fit that description. *(continued on page 5)*

"Since we spoke, September sales finally closed and in country Borders not only beat plan by double digits for the second month in a row, we also beat last year's sales," Snow says. "In an industry that by all reports is down-trending, [that] is a pretty big deal."

Additionally, Snow points out that Borders was the only



# **Corporate Playlists** (continued from page 1)

A selection of 13 **Clear Channel** reporters in top-ranked markets shows only eight titles had at least 10 spins per week on all 13 stations. There were 17 different titles that got 10 plays on 10 stations last week. That doesn't seem to be a lot of conformity among stations at a company many believe has its current music dictated by regional programming VPs. In fact, the eight common current titles among the studied group is the fewest consensus currents among all the companies.

A field of 13 **Citadel** stations selected from its largest markets showed 11 songs were on all 13 stations at least 10

times. A total of 21 songs were on at least 10 stations for 10 spins.

At **Entercom**, which has seven **Country Aircheck** reporters, 11 songs were on all seven of its stations at least 10 times last week while 19 songs got 10 or more plays on at least five of its stations.

At **Cumulus**, which has 11 reporters between our Country Aircheck/Mediabase and Activator panels, 14 songs got at least 10 plays from all 11 of its stations. There were 21 tunes that got at least 10 spins at least eight of its stations.

We also wondered how many different currents were actually airing on these group's stations. Using a threshold of 10 plays per week per station as an average, 23 songs got at least 130 spins last week at CBS Radio stations. At Clear Channel, it was 21 tunes getting a minimum of 130 plays while Citadel played 28 currents over 130 times. Entercom aired 24 songs over 70 times at its seven stations while Cumulus played 22 songs more than 110 plays at its 11 stations.

Dropping the screener to just one play a week for each company's entire group of stations in this study, CBS's 13 Country outlets aired a total of 150 different currents; CC's 13 aired 149 different titles; and, Citadel's baker's dozen had 142 tunes. Entercom played 87 different cuts on its seven stations and Cumulus offered up a total of only 81 different songs last week across its 12-station platform.

It's interesting to note that the fewest number of different current titles belongs to Cumulus, which has its stations located in the smallest markets from this select group of owners. That certainly implies more control from its programming hierarchy.

**Recurrents & Gold:** CBS Radio played 178 different recurrent titles and 881 unique gold cuts at least once last week. Thirty-five recurrents got five or more plays while

nine songs received 10 or more plays last week at each station. Of the 881 gold titles, 68 aired more than 39 times (an average of three times per week per station.)

Clear Channel's 13 selected stations aired 169 different recurrents and 1112 gold titles. Thirty-six recurrents got five or more plays while 16 tunes got 10 or more plays last week at each station. The gold breakdown shows 83 cuts got 39 or more plays.

Citadel aired 206 different recurrents last week while its gold category contained 1151 different titles. Thirty-seven songs received five or more plays while eight songs got more than 10 plays per station last week. Of its gold titles, 61 aired more than 39 times last week.


Entercom's library included 151 recurrents and 564 gold songs at its seven stations. Fifty recurrents aired five or more times last week while 22 tunes played more than 10 times. The gold rotation included 65 songs that aired three or more times last week.

Cumulus aired 170 different recurrents on its 11 stations last week. Twenty-five songs got an average of five or more plays per station for the week. Eight recurrents got more that an average of 10 plays per station last week. In the gold category, a total of 1352 different songs were played. Of that group, 73 songs got more than three plays at each station last week.

Overall, it's pretty amazing to see a relatively small sample of a company's Country stations combine for over 1100 combined gold titles, as is the case for both Clear Channel and Citadel – not to mention the over 1300 titles accounted for across Cumulus' 11 stations surveyed here. It really implies that stations are building their gold and recurrent libraries from local auditorium test results rather than delivering homogenous programming derived from national testing compilations.


