Cumulus Takes AutoStage To Market

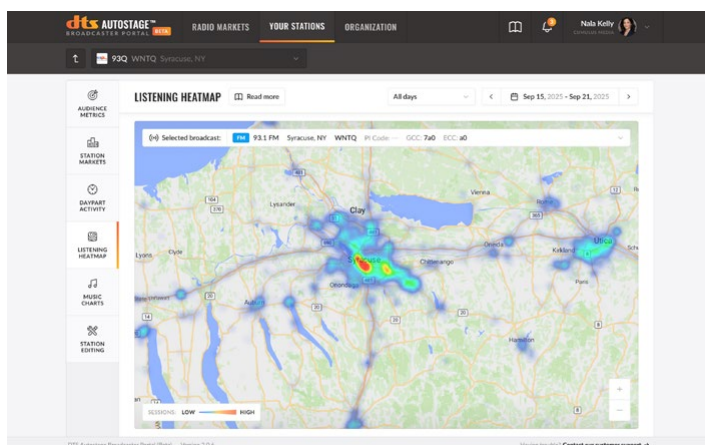
As the first commercial licensee of Xperi's DTS AutoStage radio listening data (CAT 7/15), Cumulus is on the forefront of what could be a digitally-driven revolution in broadcast metrics. The company's impetus in bringing the data to market is amplified by its lawsuit-related cessation of Nielsen Audio subscriptions. With Cumulus sellers taking the new methodology to agencies and local clients, Cumulus Pres./Operations **Bob Walker** spoke to **Country Aircheck** about what they're learning.



"The most gratifying thing is when we hear the common misperception, 'Well, no one listens to the radio anymore,' and we can say, 'That's really not true. Let us show you some data from yesterday,'"

Walker says. "In a market like Atlanta, we're not showing them a sample size from the previous ratings company we worked with. We're talking about 72,000 cars giving us data on what they listened to last week. So right out of the gate we are able to dispel that."

Showing clients the percentage of listening each station is getting (share), as well as cume and time spent listening on an exponentially larger sample than Nielsen is a big change. But wait, there's more. "We're then able to say, 'Not only can we prove they listened, let me show you where they listened,'" Walker says of DTS AutoStage's heat map feature. "We can show the entire geography of where the drivers who listen the most to each station are driving."



Changing the narrative is also about removing lag in listener data.

"Previously it was weeks – if not months – old," Walker says. "Being able to turn it into a real-time discussion puts us more on par with how some of the digital media companies are reporting engagement with their content."

Training Day: Walker calls training the company's sellers "an ongoing process," noting DTS AutoStage is still evolving. "There are continuous improvements to the product," he says. "There will be a portal for agencies and/or clients to be able to see and begin thinking about the data so they can make more informed and better media buys."

Beyond training, "We spend time as a leadership team sharing case studies and success stories and what we hear from clients," he says. "How can we listen to what our clients are saying and constantly evolve our go-to-market approach, and then take [what we hear from clients] back to the AutoStage team to evolve the product offering going forward?"

When radio pros raise concerns about the new technology, often it relates to the lack of demo information and the corresponding inability to ensure a representative sample of the market. "We anticipate that people will always be looking for ways to punch holes in it," Walker concedes. "But when you look at 70,000 cars in Atlanta and the massive difference that is compared to the previous service – plus [our ability] to marry that data with streaming engagement info about our brands that we get from our Triton logs – it creates a more fulsome picture of the audience. As to the demo

RB: But it's funny because I've been asked if he was shoved down my gullet, which is a phrase Palmer likes to say. Yeah, no. False.

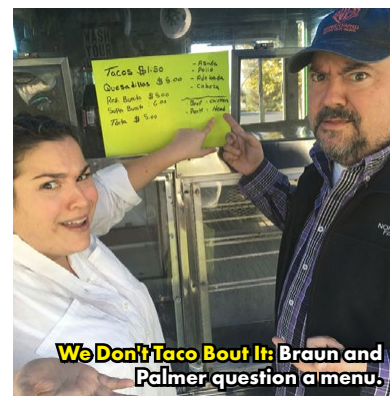
CP: Raffi and I have spoken about this opportunity for a long time now.

That happened at Warner, too, when Palmer was training me. He hired me there for my first promo job, so I figured I owe him.

So Palmer, you had to be pretty hard up to take a job with not one long-tenured promotion exec looking over your shoulder, but two. True?

CP: False. If I thought they were going to be looking over my shoulder, I would've gone to work somewhere else. In the four days I've been here, all I hear is, "You do you. Go get it done and we'll check back later. If you need us, we're there to help." Which is what I've told the regional staff too. "Think of me as your assistant who lives in Nashville. If you need a show covered, a call made, I'm your person." There's a great culture here of empowering people to get the job done, and there's support if needed.

conversation, people could say the same thing about Comscore on the video side. They can say the same thing about digital, which sells impressions and in many cases doesn't have first-party data for privacy reasons."

Scale remains the key, as shown in a marked decrease in volatility. "We're seeing a lot more stable, predictable audience metrics and nuances that were not previously available to us in big sports markets," Walker says. "If you're in Knoxville, and it's a home game weekend for the Vols, you can see [that impact on] listening. You can see a material lift even in communities like Nashville. You can see when people are in their cars on the weekend more than they would be typically. That adds credibility to the data."

Story Telling: Cumulus declined to share specifics on what they're actually showing clients, but Walker notes it's not one-size-fits-all. "It depends on the client and what their marketing objectives are," he says. "We try to deliver a presentation that addresses both the quantitative information that AutoStage provides and marry that with qualitative information from MRI Simmons data to give them a full picture."

Client interest and adoption of DTS AutoStage info when buying is mixed. "It's early times for us," Walker says. "We're much more encouraged than discouraged and have had most people say, 'Wow, I have never seen this kind of data before. This is really helpful. Can you help me understand X, Y and Z?' It's creating a really encouraging dialogue between our local clients and our local sellers. Presenting radio with near real-time updates is getting a lot of people's attention."

"Pick any community you want," he continues. "In Oklahoma City, it's over 12,000 cars. In a community like Charleston, SC, it's almost 8,000 cars. So it's a dramatically bigger sample size that shows exactly what they listen to and where they listen to it. Continuing that evolution, we can add, 'And here's what they listen to by daypart. Here are the songs we're playing on the station.' There's a lot of insight for our content team and for our sales team."

Over the past few decades, the radio industry's efforts to reset its narrative have had mixed results. At best. Cumulus is betting that the exponential increase in listening data offered by DTS AutoStage will be a key difference maker. "Radio is a very, very important part of people's daily routine," Walker says. "Despite what others may think, radio works and helps clients grow their business. This new data really helps tell that story."
