Raul Malo performed "Til I Can Make It On My Own" in tribute to the late Wynette. Toby Keith, Taylor Swift, and hit songwriters Craig Wiseman and Wynn Varble also took home awards at the Sunday (10/18) event. "It's the most prestigious thing that I've ever been given," Keith said of his Songwriter/Artist of the Decade honor. "To have your peers, songwriters who are the lifeblood of this industry, recognize you is unbelievable." Swift, too, acknowledged the significance of the evening. "Songwriters are my heroes ... and the fact that these are the people who vote on awards like this, and the fact that they would pick me, it really makes me happy," she said of her Songwriter/Artist of the Year award. Wiseman ("The Good Stuff," "Believe," "Live Like You Were Dying") thanked his main collaborator, wife KK, in his Songwriter of the Decade acceptance speech. "Waitin' On A Woman" received Song of the Year and cowriter Wynn Varble also took home the Songwriter of the Year title.

House's acceptance led to some comedic sparring with the diminutive Williams. "It's good to see Paul back in men's clothing," House quipped. "He's the last one to know it's raining." A touching video tribute was played in honor of industry vet and longtime ASCAP Awards producer **Danny Petraitis**. **Love & Theft** ("You're Only Lonely"), **Lee Ann Womack** ("Faithless Love") and **Rodney Crowell** backed by **Sarah Buxton** ("New Kid In Town") performed in tribute before **Jackson Browne** presented the Golden Note honor to **JD Souther**, who added his own performance of "Best Of My Love."


#### Summer No. 1s: WGNA, WCTO, WYRK and KIIM

The Summer 2009 diary-based Arbitrons began to roll-out last week, and our first overview of Country ratings is led by an almost three-point leap by WAMZ/Louisville and a two-share jump by WUBE/Cincinnati. Also enjoying large bumps were WCTO/ Allentown and WYRK/Buffalo.

We re-cap the markets as they come in each day in Country Aircheck Today, and provide this weekly overview of how Country stations have fared. As part of our weekly market-by-market offerings, with a few exceptions, only stations achieving at least a 1.0 share are included. Legend: A "+" indicates a Classic Country outlet, a "^" designates Country stations in the same market owned by a single operator and a "t" indicates a tie.
