and Kelley have had the amusing

experience of having a listener

who's also a client suddenly make the surprising mental connection that their therapist is also their morning DJ.

Another industry figure with an unexpected background as a Registered Behavioral Therapist is Sony Music Nashville artist **Zach John King**, whose current single, "Get To Drinkin'," is currently charted.

Copeland Mechanism: Copeland has been seeing clients for nearly six years since completing his Masters Degree during the pandemic. At the time, he was doing a morning show but not programming any stations, and found himself with free afternoons he wanted to use to "do something useful that makes the planet better while simultaneously creating a Plan B in case radio ever spits me out." Even now that he's significantly busier in radio, he still sees clients one afternoon a week, with most of his experience in couples counseling and trauma therapy.

America250 Is 80 Days Away

If that headline, the FCC's call to action, NAB resources and the official America250 campaign aren't enough to get Country radio and the broader country music industry into **Independence Day** planning mode, consider how long it will take to get comfortable saying "semiquincentennial." And while resources abound (see page 8), time is running short for those who haven't started preparations.

"We had stations start asking about this right around the first of the year," says Albright & O'Malley & Brenner Consulting Partner **Kenny Jay**. "There's a lot of promotion being done in the month of June leading up to every small town's fireworks celebration,

but in general, planning for this is overdue." He notes that stations would be smart to start promotions on Flag Day (6/14) and, among his suggestions, are limited edition shirts available only at T-shirt stops in the weeks leading up to July 4.

One of the key initiatives of America250 is to "transform July 4, 2026 into the largest single day of charitable giving in U.S. history," according to event Chair Rosie Rios. Volunteerism is being encouraged, and Jay notes, "The end of school until July 4 is a perfect time to activate families and kids to volunteer 250 listener hours for a local organization." He also suggest work with local chambers of commerce in hot zip codes that are planning celebrations. "Tell a deeper story of these towns and festivals – and put sponsor dollars towards the campaign."

Love To Bragg: Having Fort Bragg in her market puts WKML/Fayetteville, NC OM/PD/morning co-host **Sarah Weaver** at an epicenter of patriotic endeavors. "As we like to say, when the President dials 911, the phone rings at Fort Bragg," she says. "We're heavily involved with their celebration every year, which has hosted everybody from Chris Stapleton to Trace Adkins and, last year, Parmalee along with Neon Trees and Ludacris. [Morning

host] Don [Chase] and I have hosted the flag ceremony for the last seven or eight years. So our stations have a heavy presence right by the main stage throughout the day. There will be 70,000-plus on that parade field."

Station staff will hand out flags at military and veteran-owned businesses throughout the week prior. "It's literally thousands of flags," she says, though notes the war with Iran is already affecting upcoming events in the market. The 82nd Airborne Division's annual *All American Week* (5/18-21) has been cancelled, with the division's association website posting, "Due to operational requirements, we shift our focus to supporting deployed paratroopers and their families. Thanks for understanding."

"There's a lot of similarity," Copeland says of his seemingly divergent gigs. "I tell my air staff all the time we are really in the connection business. You're sitting in a room figuring out how to connect emotionally with this individual that is before you, be it your client or your listener."

The mental health background helps him be a better PD. "I've had my fair share of difficult conversations with people on the team," he says. "I hope in those conversations they feel heard and supported, and that I've been able to validate them, empathize with them and appropriately challenge them or

reframe something. Those are all things I'm also doing as a therapist." On his WYXB show, Copeland blends his two fields by hosting weekly mental health minute *Tune-up Tuesday*.

Buy Myself Flowers: A marriage and family therapy/mental health counselor, Flowers sees patients several days a week, including weekends. And while she and husband/co-host Nick Steele are actively looking for a new radio home ([CAT 3/5](#)) and still host a daily podcast, she got her therapy degree after realizing "radio might not be sustainable for me in the long run."

Her interest began while working as a suicide hotline dispatcher in Sacramento, finding it "really rewarding being there for people in their hour of need." She's spent the last five years juggling her radio and therapy careers, seeing about 15 clients a week, and more now that she's between radio jobs. One advantage of her side hustle is that if the couple finds a new radio job out of state, she has the ability to get licensed elsewhere, but can also continue telehealth visits with her current clients in Washington.

Learning to ask open-ended questions as a therapist has made Flowers better at on-air interviews and chatting with callers. "Sometimes we don't

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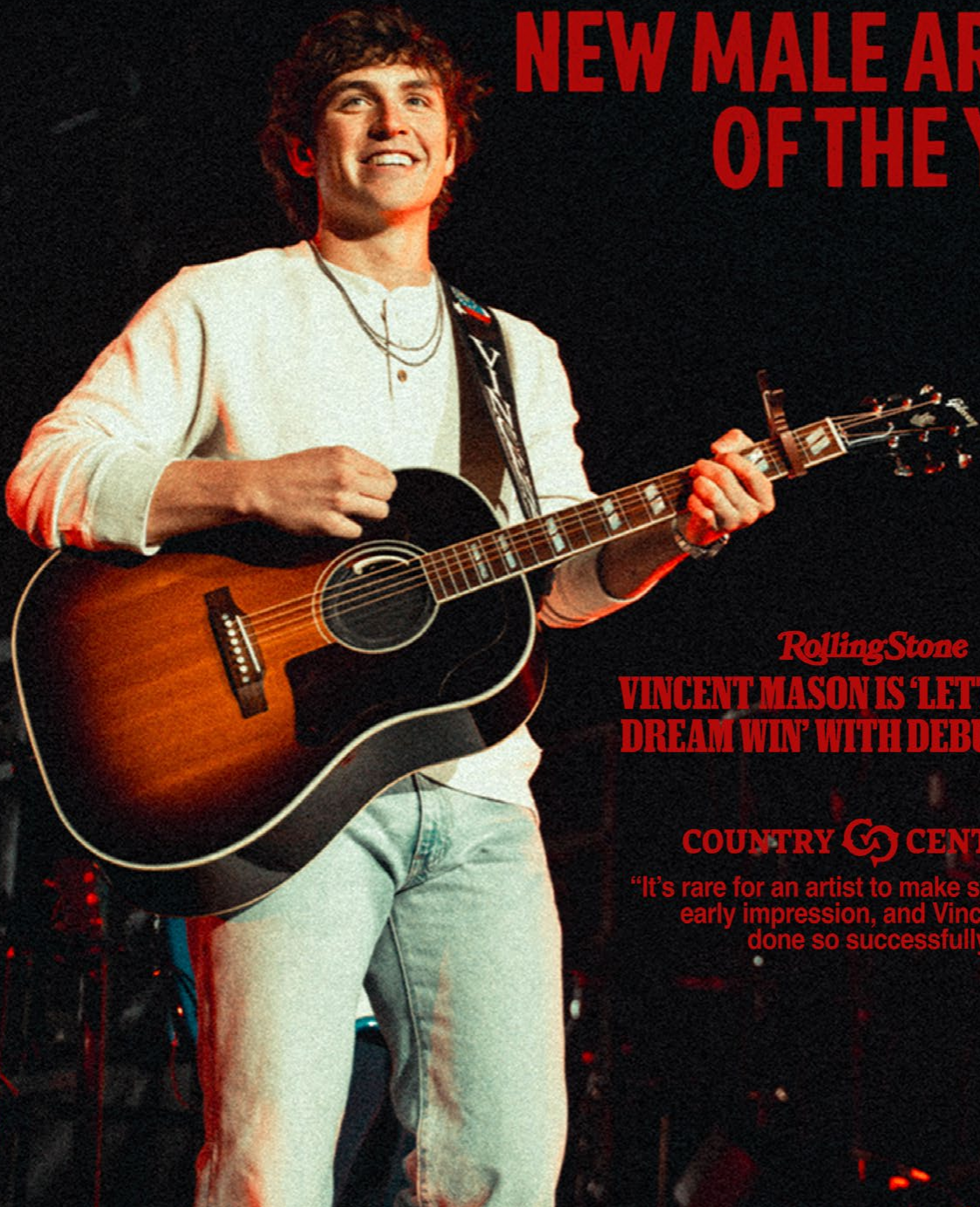

think outside of the radio studio," she says. "There are people out there having real challenges, and their lives are really different than ours. But at the core, we're all the same and want to be loved, part of a group, accepted, heard and understood. Knowing those core values has made for more interesting conversations on the air."

Flowers also believes it's important for radio professionals to have therapists of their own they can turn to if they're struggling. "This industry is volatile, weird and unlike any career out there," she says. "We're entertainers, yet we don't get some of the benefits, and it's really challenging. So having somebody to talk to who wants to know the real you, not just the radio persona, can be helpful."

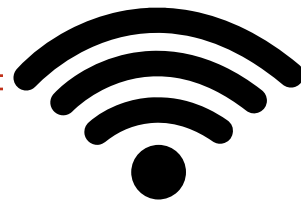
Girl On The Billboard: Outside of her radio job, Kelley has a private practice where she sees patients going through anxiety, depression, trauma and grief. She describes the balance of her jobs as "full-time radio and part-time therapy," seeing 15-20 patients a week in the afternoons. She developed an interest in the latter after starting off in the field as a life coach, eventually going back to school to obtain her advanced degrees and certifications. Her favorite part of therapy is being able to "help people live happier lives, go for their dreams, and really see their possibilities so they're not just living in a fear-based or anxious place."

In the past, she's combined the two fields with on-air features like *The Wellness 411* and a podcast called *Coping On The Couch*. She believes her background helps with her caller-heavy morning show and, like Flowers, it's made her better at artist interviews. "As a morning DJ, I can normalize therapy by slipping things in about coping, mindfulness, self-care and relaxation," she adds. "Listeners tell me they love it when I talk about these things. It helps to make them feel a little more supported."

She's even gotten some therapy clients because of her radio career, with a few telling her they found her therapy website because they enjoyed her on the air. Amusingly, one client who *didn't* know about her day job told her one day they were "driving down the road, and all of a sudden my therapist's voice came through the radio!" Other clients have said they've made the connection after spotting her face on a radio station billboard.

Good To Be King: After performing at CRS, King is finishing up his debut album and goes on tour with Morgan Wallen this coming weekend. He worked with autistic children for two-and-a-half years as a therapist at a clinic in Athens, GA before landing his record deal. He was drawn to that type of therapy because it didn't require a Masters Degree, and because of the satisfaction he got from seeing non-verbal kids progressing to talking, reading and writing. "We could literally change a kid's life," he recalls. When Covid hit, he had time to reflect and decided that while he loved the work, he felt "called" to a career in music.

But even in his artist career, King finds his therapy background helpful. "The music gets you in the door, but it's a business built off of relationships," he explains, which is where having learned about human behavior comes

in handy. "I can walk in a writing room with three strangers and write a super vulnerable song in four hours because I can hopefully make them feel connected and seen quickly."

Even for his own mental health, King says his background helps him "reframe a circumstance" if anxiety or depression enter his thoughts, and "break down those lies that your brain tricks itself into believing." King adds that his experience "helps in every facet of the business, and I'm so thankful for that."
