McShay Departs KRMD





Congrats to all the folks at Lyric Street, Turner-Nichols management and the entire **Rascal Flatts** organization on the band's eighth No. 1, "Stand." It's the third No. 1 single – joining "My Wish" and "What Hurts The Most" – from their "Me And My Gang" CD, which has sold more than four million units since its April 2006 release. The trio's next album is set for a Sept. 25, 2007 release.

By the way, just in case you haven't been keeping up with the Pop charts, the Flatts' "What Hurts The Most" is No. 4 on this week's Mediabase AC chart. The former No. 1 AC hit – which of course spent four weeks at No. 1 on top of the Country Aircheck/Mediabase chart – actually grew from No. 5 to No. 4 with a bullet in this, its 49th week on the AC chart!

More On Music's Post VT Role

The Wilkinsons' song "Nobody Died" has struck a poignant chord with radio listeners following the Virginia Tech tragedy. Written by **Tony Hazelton** after the Columbine tragedy and recorded by the Canadian trio for an RCA/Nashville album that was never released, the song was re-recorded by the band following the Amish school tragedy last October. Featured on their new album *Home*, the song's video was shot as planned two days after the Tech massacre and carries an anti-bullying message. Broadcaster, executive and country music pioneer **Irving Waugh** passed away (4/27) after an extended illness. He was 94. A native Virginian, Waugh worked in radio and television, became an executive at WSM-AM/Nashville, helped form the Country Music Association, Fan Fair, and the first and longest running annual music awards show on television, the CMA Awards. A remembrance service at Nashville's St. George's Episcopal Church is scheduled for May 1 at 11:30am. (CAT 4/27)

- Clear Channel/Charleston, SC OM and Country WEZL PD Scott Johnson left the station (4/26).
 Johnson joined the cluster from CC/Greenville, SC in November, 2005, and started with the company in 1998. (CAT 4/27)
- Inner Banks Media swapped frequencies for Country WWHA & WWNK/Greenville-New Bern-Jacksonville, NC and CHR/Pop simulcast WRHT & WRHD. The Country station, formerly at 94.1 & 94.3, now lands at 96.3 & 103.7 and is being re-positioned as "Thunder Country." Mike "Mad Dawg" Biddle, previously with Curtis Country WQDR/Raleigh, is programming the station and hosting mornings. They were among the few hundred friends who were part of the fourth annual "**Toby Keith** & Friends Golf Classic" held last weekend to benefit Ally's House. While the final figures aren't in yet, this weekend's donations will add greatly to the \$1.1 million raised in the first three years.



The end result was *two* people each spending \$30k to join the party. The live and silent auctions included dream vacations, Dallas Cowboys football tickets and a team-signed football, huge OU packages and a number of items signed by **Garth Brooks, Sammy Hagar, Bob Seger** and a host of country artists. **Restless Heart** performed and sounded better than ever.

Not much to write about Saturday's golf game, which was severely affected by Friday night and the golf-cart mounted margarita machines that seemed to show up every third hole. It was ugly. The coolest thing was 20 players taking a swing from 112 yards – with the shot closest to the pin winning a gorgeous Ford truck loaded with gifts from the tourney's sponsors. 


