Temps Rising In Hotlanta Battle

Country listeners in Atlanta are the objects of what's shaping up as one of the most hotly contested radio battles in the format. And this one has it all – chess-like strategy, larger-than-life personalities and enough controversy to make some labels wary of venturing into the market at all.

Citadel's **WKHX (Kicks 101.5 FM)** & **WYAY (Eagle 106.7)** had their hold on the market challenged in December 2006 when Clear Channel signed on with **WUBL (94.9 The Bull)**. Last month, The Bull got a sister when Clear Channel flipped AC WLTM to Classic Country as **The Legend**, which took aim at an opening CC VP/Country and Regional VP/Programming **Clay Hunnicutt** saw in the market. Hunnicutt programs The Bull and The Legend, the latter with Bull APD Lance Houston.

"The opportunity was there for it because [they] adjusted their playlists," Hunnicutt says. "The Eagle walked from a lot of that material. The Legend is a smaller frequency, but serving a niche that clearly isn't represented."

The new station's signal is centered southwest of Atlanta. "It's a good area – Fayette County, Peachtree City – places with high Country listenership and a high level of income," Hunnicutt says. "It's not about downtown Atlanta."



Mark Richards, OM/PD for the Citadel combo, says Kicks and Eagle have continued to provide what Atlanta listeners have come to expect. "We remained focused on the adult audience targets [both stations] have owned over the years," he says. "We feel confident we know the Country listener here after years of interaction with them and having the benefit of long-term research."

"The only musical change we made was to Eagle in 2006, introducing a broader current playlist. And we are very pleased with Eagle's ratings performance since that change."

Richards says competition is nothing new in the market. "As we talked about last year at this time, there are more than seven stations on and around Atlanta programming country music, so there have always been a lot of choices."

Choice, however, is becoming a challenging concept for Nashville labels and artists as they approach an increasingly delicate situation. The controversy's roots may go back to October, when rumblings began about **WQYK/Tampa** morning host **Cledus T. Judd** moving to The Bull. That deal was cemented in December, and was certainly noticed by the competition.

Acree Still Fighting Through Stroke

"A few people in the business have been in to see him, but it has kind of been few and far between," Lyric Street's Dale Turner says of Country Radio Hall of Famer Les Acree. "His eyes light up when he sees someone he used to work with."

Acree suffered a massive stroke last April, and Turner recently visited with him on a trip to Memphis. "He's in a wheelchair and can't communicate, but he's completely alert and hears everything," Turner says. "I worked in radio with him twice, and he was such a mentor to me. When I got in the record business he always drove me crazy because he was so opinionated and stubborn. But that could work to your advantage, too. He was like having a sixth regional when I was at BNA because he was so passionate about Kenny Chesney."

Chances for a dramatic improvement aren't great, which saddens Turner. "I always envisioned him as a perennial golfer, which he can't do. And for someone who spent his whole life communicating and now not to be able to is pretty tough. But I don't think he's lost hope at all. If anyone who knows him is in there for the St. Jude Radio Seminar and has extra time, it would make his day to see someone from the business."

According to several label sources, a Dec. 19 email from Citadel's Richards to more than 20 label heads and promotion executives made an issue of artist appearances on The Bull's new morning show.

The bulk of the email addressed ratings for Kicks, Eagle and The Bull. Richards then wrote that he knows Judd will request access to artists, but that such a move will "interfere" with acquiescing label and artist's relationships with Kicks and Eagle.

Asked for comment, Richards downplays concerns about an "us or them" policy. "I continue to reach out to our label partners to share news in the market and provide them with truthful ratings information, as we do with all of our clients," Richards says. "This is how we have built the strong relationships we have, [which are] part of why Atlanta is such a good country market for radio and music consumers."

"Kicks and Eagle continue to own the same share of Country audience in Atlanta this year as we have enjoyed over the last several years. I think our performance speaks volumes. Some [labels] want to create a controversy over something that was a reminder of what we are and how we have always operated."

Still, the note has some labels choosing to avoid station visits in Atlanta altogether. Asked point-blank if Kicks and Eagle won't work with artists or labels who venture to The Bull, Richards replies, "We encourage everyone to work with our stations in Atlanta, the stations that have introduced country acts and played all their hits for years."

Hunnicutt worries labels perceive the email as an ultimatum. "When artists and our listeners are made to suffer because we have a ratings war going on, that sucks for everybody," he says. "Win and stand on your own feet. Win by being a great radio station. Don't do by it threatening."

"We want to make the community better, do good radio, and increase revenue and ratings. It's an unusual climate, clearly because of the battle."

In summer Arbitrons, WKHX held a 4.1 share, good for fourth in the market. WYAY was at 2.4 and ranked 16th. WUBL stood at 2.2 and ranked 18th. Fall ratings for Atlanta are due Jan. 17.
