Kooky Listener Stories: Part Two

Country radio personalities share more stories about their offbeat encounters with overzealous fans.

Don't Even Know Who I Am: WHKO/Dayton PD/MD **Nancy Wilson** remembers a listener named Larry who "who would come to every one of my remotes and appearances and stalk me from a distance. He was never really a threat, but I'd see out of the corner of my eye him sneaking pictures of me. Then he'd bring them to the remote table and show them to

me. It was a little ridiculous how many he had. He'd then try to sneak behind the table to stand next to me while wanting a hug. Eventually, our head of security had to ask him (nicely) to keep his distance. The craziest thing? He always brought his wife with him!"

Wilson has also been part of a case of mistaken identity. "At one time, there were three prominent radio stations in town. Many times I would get called 'Kristi' or 'Kim' (the other stations' morning show female leads) and I would gently correct them. One lady kept giving me the eye at Home Depot. I would smile and nod at her, but she'd look away. In the parking lot, she mustered up the courage to come up, calling me 'Kim' and saying how she loved our station. I explained that I was Nancy, and while Kim was a good friend, we're on different stations. She started to get angry, calling me rude for lying to her. I

pulled out my driver's license to show her who I was, and even showed her a picture of Kim and me. Kim is significantly shorter than me, so once you see us together, you get it. But not this lady. She was really pissed, and huffed off, saying, 'I am never listening to B94-5 again,' which was okay with me, since we're 99.1!"

Don't Blink: WFMS/Indianapolis PD **Brooks O'Brian** recalls a super fan they called "no-blink-Brad" who came to anything her station did with artists and "somehow made his way into meet & greets. He always had a photo he'd taken at a past show that he wanted signed. As you can tell by the nickname we gave him, it was truly amazing (and somewhat creepy) how long he could go without blinking. And he was stealthy. All of a sudden, boom, he was standing next to you trying to get a picture autographed ... and not blinking!"

Source Honors Six

Poking a little fun at how loose and casual Source was in its early days, and recalling that its meetings were sporadic, agenda-free and even a bit boozy, City National Bank's **Lori Badgett** said she helped bring a bit of structure to the trade group early on, creating its very first spread sheet of member email addresses.

Badgett's remarks came during the 22nd annual Source Hall of Fame Awards at Nashville's Musicians Hall of Fame and Museum (8/26), where she was among the six honorees for the group that has long been better known for its professional reputation.

The non-profit, founded in 1991, seeks to unify women executives and professionals working in the Nashville music industry; its membership is by invitation only.

Badgett was one of the six "women behind the music" honored this year, along with **Cheryl Harris, Gina Keltner, Pam Russell, Mary Self** and **Kay West**. Inductees are women who have made a significant impact on the Nashville music industry.

A surprise appearance from **Garth Brooks** and **Trisha Yearwood** celebrated Harris, while George Strait, Reba McEntire and Gene Watson sent video messages honoring West, Russell and Badgett, respectively. Brooks joked that he told Yearwood he'd love to have a Source Award, and she retorted that to earn one, "You would have to work harder than any man ever has."

Artist **Mandy Barnett** and radio/television personality **Kelly Sutton** hosted, the latter for the first time following the Aug. 1 passing of longtime co-host Jeannie Seely. A video tribute to Seely included poignant footage of

her singing "Happy Trails" with co-host Brenda Lee, who was sidelined this year due to illness.

Honoring O'Neil Hagaman co-founder Harris, Brooks said he's worked with her for 37 years, where she's been part of some of "the most groundbreaking business deals." Yearwood, also a longtime client, called Harris "the person who has always had our backs when it came to business, but also the person who made us family." Harris spoke of her "amazing journey" and said, "God has truly guided me through my life, bringing so many special people and unbelievable opportunities."

Journalist and author West, who was Strait's independent publicist for 15 years, shared a story of the artist's late manager, Erv Woosey, approaching her to take on that job after she left MCA. She told him, "I don't really want to do publicity anymore," to which Woolsey replied, "That's okay, neither does George." A few years later, she added the equally press shy Alan Jackson as a client, and joked, "I've made a good living" learning "a lot of ways to say no" to media requests.


West also acknowledged early Nashville music industry pioneers Frances Preston, Donna Hilley and others, all of whom started as receptionists and secretaries, then "put on their big girl heels, worked really hard and never complained" until they were running the town.


Keltner, a 26-year Grand Ole Opry veteran who is responsible for booking more than 2,000 appearances there each year, was introduced by her boss, **Dan Rogers**, whom she called "my George Bailey." In a message to her daughter with a universally inspirational theme, Keltner said, "I hope you find your people and your passion ... and run full force towards it."

Russell, a 28-year UMG/Nashville staffer who retired in 2018 recalled her job taking her to "countless concerts and endless in-stores," where she learned that "success is never a solo act."

Forty-year ASCAP staffer Self was introduced via video by company Pres./Chairman **Paul Williams**, who told her, "What you do directly affects American songwriters, including me." As the PRO's Sr. Mgr./

Membership & Administration, she noted that she has "always been proud to work for the place that supports the heartbeat of the industry: the writers and publishers," adding that the "true impact" of her career has been in helping others, especially the thousands of songwriters she's worked with over the years.

After her video introduction from family friend Watson, Badgett used part of her time to advocate for his membership in the Country Music Hall of Fame. She also got a laugh during her speech for noting how great it was "to grow up in the business in the nineteen hundreds."

Next year's Source Awards have been set for Aug. 25 at the Musicians Hall of Fame and Museum, which hosts a gallery of past Source Awards honorees.

Tramp On Your Street: WWWF/Nassau-Suffolk, NY MD Kelly Ford was doing a live broadcast from a festival when "a diehard Kelly Ford superfan - completely shirtless and grinning ear to ear - came running up and asked me to sign

Sharpie in hand and a split second decision to make, so I went for it. Instead of the usual arm or shoulder signature, I gave him a full tramp stamp autograph right across his lower back. The crowd went wild."

Toy Dive: WUSN/ Chicago & KMNB/Minneapolis afternoon host Scotty Kay had some unwanted visitors during a "stuff-a-bus" toy drive promotion,

where air staff would live and sleep on the bus at a mall for seven days. "Sometimes people would come by in the middle of the night to see if we were actually sleeping there," he recalls. "One night at about 2:30am two

women came by drunk and decided they weren't leaving until we let them come and sleep on the bus with us. When we told them we couldn't, they became unruly and threatened to take the toys. We had to call the police and have them escorted out."

In The Soup: When WCCQ & WXLC/Chicago Asst. Dir./Content/MD Drew Walker and his wife, Jill, adopted their son in 2007, he says, "I disappeared off the grid for about 10 days. Only my boss knew where I was. Our son was being born in another state, and we didn't want anything to get in the way. Eventually, we were granted guardianship and allowed to cross state lines to bring him home, but we had effectively been ghosts. A listener called me up the first day back saying that she'd been frantically worried," and had made several attempts to find his home address so she could bring him homemade soup "and hopefully heal whatever ailment I had. Thankfully, there's a reason we're not listed anywhere," he says, "but the sentiment was very kind."

Air Check: While this guy may not necessarily have been a listener, WJKR/Columbus, OH OM/ PD John Crenshaw once heard from the angry husband of a part-time jock he had reached out to looking to potentially re-hire. Perhaps misunderstanding the nature of the outreach, the

husband told Crenshaw, "If you text or call my wife again you will be buried in your own [excrement] ... You will meet with your worst nightmare, and you won't get away from it alive."





On a sweeter note, KCYY/San Antonio PD Christi **Brooks** recalls an autistic fan named Karen from her time at KKBQ/Houston. Karen would "call every single jock, every single day in Houston at the start of their show" to check in. "She knew when you were on vacation and who would be filling in so she could call them and make sure they knew she was listening. If you didn't answer the phone right away, she would call and call until you did. It was part of her routine that she could



not miss or it would throw her entire day off. If you had time and actually had a conversation with Karen, you always hung up with a smile. Karen passed away, and there were DJs from all over Houston that showed up to her funeral. I will never forget her and how just a simple hello made her day right."


