## Purcell, Cerda, Adams: Organ Ballin'

Country music and kidney transplants go together like mashed potatoes and trombones, but here we are. Over the last few weeks, Em.Co's **Jack Purcell** (CAT 4/8) and KTEX/McAllen, TX's **Jo-Jo Cerda** (CAT 4/27) shared their need for a donor kidney. Late last week, KFDI/Wichita's JJ Hayes announced he's donating a kidney to a stranger in honor of his late wife. Meanwhile, Broken Bow's **Lee Adams** is 19 years removed from donating one of hers. **Country Aircheck** asked her, Cerda and Purcell to share their stories.

### CA: How'd you get here, Jack?

**JP:** I've got hereditary polycystic kidney disease that's been chasing me for about 30 years. I knew there was some probability I'd eventually have to be searching for a kidney, but for a while we thought I could outrun it. My [kidney function] was holding right around 22%, but after a couple rounds of COVID – which is hard on your kidneys – I'm down at 15%. So it's time to start looking. Asking for help was the hardest thing about this. Making that Facebook post ... it took me five months to hit send on that. But then being on the receiving end of what our community does and who we are – it's an epic feeling. I couldn't be more thankful and appreciative.

### How did you get to this point, Jo-Jo?

**JC:** I don't know, specifically. There can be any number of reasons – high blood pressure, high blood sugar, a medication or genetics. We don't know why, but I had to have a transplant back in 2015. My wife at the time donated her kidney. After the divorce, she wanted it back, but she didn't get it. It's okay to laugh.

That's a joke. Anyway, I'd been doing fine up until about a year-and-a-half ago when I went to do labs and they said, "Hey, you might want to take it easy on a couple of things because we're starting to see a deterioration in the kidney." Sure enough, in December of '24, I started dialysis at home, which is seven days a week but not as taxing on me as going to the center three days a week.

## Shelia Shipley Biddy Reflects

After 50 years in the music business, including becoming the first woman to helm a major Nashville label, **Music Health Alliance** (MHA) Chief Administrative Officer/Certified Senior Advisor **Shelia Shipley Biddy** retired in March (CAT 3/18). Her career included stints at Monument, RCA and MCA (the latter as SVP/Promotion) before being named SVP/GM to head Decca. She also worked as an artist manager and served as president of indie labels Stringtown and Flying Island before joining MHA in 2013. **Country Aircheck** caught up with the Source Hall of Famer ahead of a retirement party planned for tomorrow (5/5).

**The record I fought** the hardest for in my promotion career was Waylon Jennings' "Rose In Paradise" [in 1987]. We lost the bullet three times and got it back. It was unheard of. We were fixing drops and patching holes, and some of the regionals were waiting for me to give up. I never did, and we got it to No. 1. Waylon called to thank me, and told me it was the first No. 1 he'd had in 10 years.

**When Roger Miller did** the soundtrack for the *Big River* Broadway musical, we brought in 80 or 90 radio programmers to see it, and had to scout out walking routes from the hotel to the theater to avoid the prostitution district. Later, back at the hotel, [then MCA executive] Tony Brown did the "baby buffalo" at about 2am. You have to see it to believe it.

**My five years at Decca** were magic. There were showcases every night. At restaurants, waitresses would recognize me and slip cassettes or CDs into my pocket. And artists from other labels would come to me for counsel, because it's hard being a female artist in this business.

**The early days at nonprofit MHA** were lean. When I joined [founder] Tatum Hauck Allsep, I worked for 18 months with half pay and no benefits out of a conference room taking meetings in coffee houses as we were trying to fundraise. One week we weren't going to make payroll. Whenever our mailman brought us a check, we'd give him a beer. That day, he walked in and handed me a \$30,000 donation from Reba McEntire. I sat down and just flat-out cried. We never got that low on funds again. From that point on, we turned the corner.

**I had a learning curve** in those early days, too. I remember that first phone call with Tatum she was talking about advocates and navigators, and I'm like, "Holy crap. The only navigator I ever wanted was a Lincoln." I had a lot to learn about insurance, Medicare, health care and the Affordable Care Act. But the work I did at MHA was life-changing.

**I wasn't planning to retire**, but after losing my husband and my son within four months of each other [in 2024], a lot of the end-of-life stuff I dealt with at MHA weighed on me more. Over my 13 years there, about 150 clients passed away, so it was like a light switch went

off saying I need to go. And I'm 73. I've never been good at balancing my time – when Decca shuttered, I had about 16 weeks of accumulated unused vacation. But after my 52-year-old son died suddenly, I realized we've got one itty bitty life. Nobody knows when it's going to happen, so we just have to enjoy each day, play with our dog, garden, read and do whatever brings us joy.

**I had the greatest career** anybody could have. I got to stand backstage watching an artist perform that, two years before, no one knew; see people sing every word to a song I'd worked; see that young artist grow into a superstar and help them accomplish their dreams. Music was never just a product to me. And I made lifetime relationships with my radio friends. I got to do so many things and see so much of the U.S. I worked over 139 No. 1 records, and every one of them was important for different reasons. And I never asked for a single promotion. They always came to me.

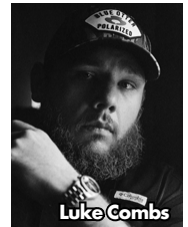

## Chart Chat

Congratulations to **Luke Combs, Dennis Reese, Mallory Michaels** and the **Columbia** promotion team on taking "Sleepless In A Hotel Room" to No. 1. This is Combs' 26th visit to the top and his 22nd consecutive No. 1 as a lead artist, which puts him one shy of tying **Luke Bryan's** all-time No. 1 streak. Songwriters are **Randy Montana, Jonathan Singleton** and Combs.

By replacing his own "Days Like These" at No. 1, Combs becomes the first artist in the 52-year history of CA/MB/R&R charts to succeed themselves at the top with non-collaborative singles.

Not content with another No. 1 and a chart record, Combs also lands this week's Add Board leader with "Be By You." With 77 adds, it becomes Combs' 18th release to top the board.

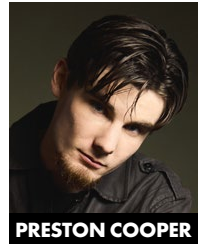

**OFF THE RECORD**

Blue Highway's **Preston Cooper** takes "One For The Road:"

**We actually didn't set out** to write "One For The Road" – it just kind of came together while we were working on another track called "Dark Places" for my debut album, *Toledo Talkin'*. I was in a writing session with Brad and Brett Warren, and we were winding down after finishing that song. Everyone was a bit wiped out from the day, but I started messing around on guitar and casually throwing out a couple lines. The Warrens shot me a look like, "What's that?" Next thing you know, we were all tossing out lyrics. What was special about writing this song was how every lyric really meant something specific to us. Not everyone interprets them exactly how we intended, but the fact that people still connect with it in their own way is amazing.

**Brad had come up with** the title "One For The Road" a while back, and it just clicked with what I was playing. It worked perfectly with the vibe we were building so we ran with it. That little detail of using numbers for the lyrics adds something satisfying to the song. There's a certain flow to it – like every line just follows naturally from the one before. The lyrics came from a mix of personal experiences and the inspiration of the moment. For example, one of the first lines, "I got a highway running through my backyard, 'cause Uncle Sam had somewhere to go," actually refers to the road that now cuts right through my family's farm in Ohio. A lot of people think the "four on the floor" part of the chorus refers to a car's transmission or cans on the floor, but it's actually about a drum pattern. We used a lot of musical lingo throughout because that's exactly what was on our minds at that moment. There are also a lot of references to my faith and the way I was raised. It's a huge part of my life, so it always finds its way into my music.

**I love writing with the Warrens** and this track really shows the kind of creative connection I have with them. We just click and it came together so naturally in about 45 minutes. We recorded a work tape on acoustic guitars, then took it to some musicians who added the energy it needed to really bring it to life. The demo turned out so well that we didn't even re-record it. We just kept it as is, turned it into the master, and rolled with it. That made the song feel so organic and authentic to me.

**I played "One For The Road"** for the first time at CRS last year, and the response was amazing. I actually got my first standing ovation after playing it for that crowd. So many people asked when we were sending it to Country radio, and it was incredible to see others connect with it the way I did. That feedback really pushed us to make it a single, and I'm so glad we did. It's such a true reflection of my sound and the kind of music I grew up with. It means a lot to me that people are embracing it just like I hoped they would.

I've had other issues, including low blood pressure, and have been in the hospital three times over the last 15 months. So it's been one struggle after another. And like Jack was talking about, it's hard to ask somebody for help, especially in the Hispanic culture. The first time I was very lucky. This time, I was talking about my story on the radio, one of my listeners heard it and took it upon herself to post it. And it went viral. So a lot of people have been reaching out and that's where we're at.

### How did you end up donating a kidney, Lee?

**LA:** First a couple of stats: The United Network of Organ Sharing puts people on the transplant list, and it's a three-to-five year waiting list [for a cadaver kidney], which is why they probably told Jack and Jo-Jo, "Go find your own." That's what they told my brother-in-law, who was probably born with the immune disorder that took 50 years to manifest.

I'd like to say that I'm altruistic, but I am not. I signed up because I didn't think I'd match. I thought my blood type was A-positive, not O-positive. And I'm a hypochondriac. So when they called and said, "Good news, you're O-positive," my thought was, "Good news for whom?" But they asked if I was willing to move on, and what was I going to say? No? If he hadn't been the father of my niece and nephew, I don't know that I would've done it. It's a lot. But I've never once regretted it. Best decision of my life. I've become very involved with the National Kidney Foundation to the extent that my name is on a plaque at the University of Maryland Medical Center because I've raised so much money for their transplant system.

### What was that journey like?

**LA:** You have to be so healthy and I spent the next several months going through tests before I was deemed a match. Most likely if you're healthy enough to donate, you don't have a ton of bad habits. I don't smoke. I don't drink. I've never tried an illegal drug.

**JC:** Look at it this way: No doctor's going to pull anything out of you that they may think you would need somewhere down the road. Let's say Chuck is healthy as a horse and donates a kidney. If something happens to your other kidney down the road, your name goes to the top of the transplant list. Another cool thing is as a donor, you don't pay anything. The procedure is taken care of by the recipient's insurance.

**LA:** They really cater to the donors. My room was better than any fancy hotel you've ever been in. I had fruit baskets. I had plants. As for what I had to change, I was a 37-year martial artist and had to give up sparring. Can't risk a hit to the kidney. But I still waterski, hike and bike. I did have to give up my Mountain Dew habit. They let me keep chocolate. I can't take ibuprofen, which can be hard on the kidneys. So I take Tylenol. Otherwise, my life hasn't changed.

**JP:** One of the things that's interesting is the hospital systems have paired matching programs. Even if you don't match with the person you're being tested for, if you match with someone else in the network and that person has a donor who matches your person, they'll line that up. [Ed. Note: This is what Hayes is doing, as noted above.]

**LA:** They pair them up and do the surgeries on the same day because they're not going to risk somebody backing out. They've done upwards of 24 that way, and I actually met the doctor who did the very first matched pair at Johns Hopkins.

### Why did you become so involved, Lee?

**LA:** I'm an advocate ... not necessarily for living organ donation itself, as that's a very personal decision. But once you've decided to donate, they pair you with someone who has done it because it can be hard to be the donor. Someone else is sick and you're the healthy one, but you're about to go through

major surgery and it's okay to be scared with your donor buddy. Mine said, "After you heal, it's a non-event. You won't even think about it again."

**Jack, you said something about being on the receiving end of what the country community does ... what did you mean?**

**JP:** This is where it gets emotional, right? Hang on ... (long pause). The hardest part is asking for help. In this industry, you don't want to be too vulnerable. We're all entertainers on some level and we want to be perceived as strong and viable. We're competitive on the charts and between companies, but when somebody needs something ... geez. The outpouring. And from people I would have never expected. People I don't even know that well are asking for the donation form. Even being willing to find out if they're a potential match is mind blowing.

**LA:** Jack gets emotional about it because it's a difficult thing on both ends. When I matched, I sat in my living room and clear as we're talking I heard God say, "Be still." I had to tell everybody on the medical team to give me a couple weeks so I could pray about it. Now I'm 19 years in and live my life normally. If any potential donors want to talk to me, just reach out.
