# **Q&A: WSOC's Cameron Moore**

Promoted last month from APD/MD to PD at Beasley's **WSOC/ Charlotte** (<u>CAT 9/4</u>), **Cameron Moore** also programs Top 40 sister WNKS and tracks midday shows for Top 40 stations in Charlotte, Las Vegas and Augusta, GA. Born in Charlotte and raised in Winston-Salem, Moore



returned to her hometown when she joined Beasley in 2017 (<u>CAT 10/9/17</u>), adding MD duties for WSOC in 2019 (<u>CAT 3/14/19</u>). **Country Aircheck** caught up with her a month into the new job.

#### CA: What drew you to a career in radio?

**CM:** I went to Appalachian State, majoring in theater. Broadway was my dream in high school, but I kind of fell out of love with it. I randomly came across a flyer for campus radio station [WASU], and

had no idea that App State has one of the best radio programs. I went to a meeting and immediately knew this was what I wanted to do. So, I studied broadcasting and worked at WASU as News Director. After graduation, I ended up at a Country station in Springfield, MO [KOMG, where she was Dir./Imaging and afternoon personality].

#### What was the appeal of country?

My mom listened to country a lot growing up. But at first I was more just passionate about radio, so it didn't matter to me what genre I got into. The job just happened to be a "'90s to Now" Country station in the middle of the Midwest. But while there, I not only fell in love with a lot of the older country, but got such a history lesson on the backbones of the format. It was like a crash course.

#### How do you juggle programming two active formats?

Everybody asks me how I handle it all, and I say, "I don't." There's always a list of about five things that I have to push off to the next week. It's a lot, but luckily, there's been so much crossover now that I'm playing Morgan Wallen songs on both my stations, and BigXthaPlug and Russell Dickerson, so that's been nice. I stay busy. I am constantly on the phone, doing logs or sending emails. It's a lot of work, but it's fun and exciting to be in two genres that people are really passionate about.

There is less volume from Top 40 record reps – about a fourth the amount of the Country reps. I actually did the math, and I talk to 45 people a week total; about 10 of them are Top 40. There's not as many [pop] labels, everybody's signed to a major or kind of a major, and all of the reps I talk to are working seven songs or so.

I grew up very poor in a large family, and as I looked around, I thought, "I've never seen a poor doctor." But I also loved business and entrepreneurship, and was open to anything that made sense. I started doing a podcast and a daily radio show about how to start and grow a business on KFAQ/Tulsa until the station was sold and went in a different direction.

# What other experience had you had with radio prior to ownership?

Radio built my business and made me famous. That was the girl that brought me to the dance, so to speak. I started [voicing] my own ads alongside station talent who had trust built up with the listeners and gave me endorsements. I found a parade and got in front of it. What I love about radio is you can build quite a story in 60 seconds when you have their attention, but you have to be compelling.

I knew I was always going to do radio to promote my businesses, so I thought, "If I'm going to use it, why not own it?" I actually tried to buy the Cox [Tulsa cluster] about four-and-a-half years ago, but after I found out they sold the Houston cluster I reached out again via a radio broker, and we made it happen.

#### Why that cluster, specifically?

They were the legacy ones, the gorilla in the room, the big boys, and my faves. KRMG-AM/FM dominates in Talk and News. K95.5 [KWEN] growing up here was always the top dog in Country. Mix 96.5 [AC KRAV] is the one I listen to personally, and I also started enjoying 103.3 The Eagle [Classic Rock KJSR].

# Are you now playing the stations in your optometry offices?

We're just getting ready to purchase and install the equipment to do that. I didn't have music in them before.

#### Any surprises so far as an owner?

I've been an advertiser for over 30 years, and have been in all the stations around Tulsa and met the players, so, thankfully, there were not a lot of surprises. My radio IQ was pretty high. I guess the biggest eye-opener was all the back-end software, computers and towers needed to run everything – the inner bowel workings where I had never been. It was like looking behind the curtain in The Wizard of Oz.

KWEN Dir./Branding & Programming Matt Bradley told me his station vehicle had been in disarray and he'd been trying to get it re-wrapped for a long time. After his first meeting with you, he had a new vehicle wrapped and on site in time for his guitar pull a week later.

It's a business, and if you're not proud of it, and putting your best foot forward, why would anyone else want to participate?

# **OFF THE RECORD**

Singer, songwriter and Shinedown frontman **Brent Smith** goes off the record ahead of the band's Grand Ole Opry debut (10/10).

We're going to play "Searchlight" during the Opry performance, which will be the first time anyone hears it publicly. When we wrote it, it was sort of a rock ballad. We went on to writing other material for this album we're working on, but when we came back to "Searchlight," something wasn't right. The song was telling us, "I'm something else." So I cut the vocal again. The whole time I was thinking, "Just sing it the way it's asking to be sung." When that was done, it sparked a different path for the rest of the band. Eric Bass — yes, our bass player's real last name is Bass and it's pronounced



[like "mass"] – added a banjo and a pedal steel part. Even before that, people we trust were telling us it was a country song.

As for the Opry, we got an email from Taylor Vaughn at our press company saying, "Are you guys into this?" We were like, "Are you kidding? Yes. Absolutely." You have to be very specific and realistic when you talk about country music. If you're trying to do a shtick or jump on a bandwagon, it's not going to happen. And it shouldn't.

**We're all southern born** and raised. [Guitarist] Zach [Myers] is 901 to the bone – Memphis. I grew up in Knoxville. My mother's mother was a massive fan of Willie Nelson, Dolly Parton and Randy Travis, so that music was always on in the house. In my teenage years, I was much more about the Man in Black. I always loved the fact that Johnny was the dangerous one.

**People see the rock band**, but that's not all we are. The last two years we've crossed into five different formats: Rock, Alternative, Top 40, AC and Hot AC. When Casey Kasem signed off the air, the No. 1 song on that final show was our "Second Chance." We've had two songs in the last two years break into the top 20 on Top 40. We also hold the record for the most No. 1s, top fives and top 10s on Rock radio, which is still insane to say out loud.

**Streaming will let people** find your music, but radio will give you a career. That's been my experience, at least. When you talk about Country radio, I know exactly what that means. I don't know everything, but I have a lot of friends who are country artists and they've been telling me, "Just be yourselves. If it's a great song, people will embrace it. If it's meant to be, it'll be."

**The test will be if** country listeners say, "Yeah, I believe them." We had to present this song the way it asked to be presented, and then the universe brought us this *Opry* opportunity. It fits because we've always been a bit of an anomaly. Shinedown is everyone's band, whether that means alternative, metal, rock or pop – every song doesn't necessarily attract the same eyes and ears.

**We're getting asked**, "Are you going to shock everyone?" We play live anyway, but I love that the Opry band is like, "No computers, boys. No playback rigs." Eric was on the phone with their musical director while they were in London. They've worked out who in their band can play various parts, but everything has to be live. That's badass. We're going to work with those incredible musicians and do something that's very authentic to the Opry.

**We've played in front of** five people and 500,000 people, but I don't think anything in my career has terrified me more than the prospect of stepping foot on the *Opry* stage. It's an honor we're taking extremely seriously.

Part of that is getting into the community, being part of the remotes, giveaways and promotions. I've even been on a few sales calls, which are super fun. The sales people are like, "This is crazy to have the owner of the station on a sales call," but I enjoy it.

I inherited an awesome team, but I tease everybody that I have a stick and am going the beat the "corporate" out of them, metaphorically speaking. If they're used to getting an answer in six weeks, I'm right in front of them and can give them an answer in six seconds, then make it happen.

# OFF THE RECORD

Songwriter/Gatsby Records Founder/Pres. **Jessie Jo Dillon** shares the stories behind a few of the songs she's co-written:

Hardy's "Bottomland" – We wrote this on a retreat for Hardy and his publishing company, Relative. I love Michael so much and those retreats are always so fun. We were in this little sun room by a pond and Hunter Phelps had some title that had "Bottomland" in it, but we ended up going strictly with that as the title alone. The song really embodies Michael and so many

country boys I know. In fact, one of my uncles was buried exactly how it is described in the song – in his camo with my great-grandpa's rifle. This is one of Michael's most epic vocal performances and I am so proud of him and his producer Zach Abend for how the song turned out; it is perfect. I think the lyric "Lord just take me as I am" speaks for all of us.

Megan Moroney's "Am I Okay?" – This was such a fun day out at Luke Laird's cabin. The three of us have such a great time together creating, whether it's a ballad, pissed-off song, happy song, or bop. At the time, Megan had just started dating a new guy and we dove into that feeling of when you've been in emo cowgirl land and then bam somebody shows up out of nowhere and sweeps you off your feet. I'm so proud of this No. 1 and CMA nomination for Song of the Year.

**Russell Dickerson's "Happen To Me"** – Man, I love the guys I wrote this with so much. Dickerson, Chris LaCorte and Chase McGill are all so talented and just great people. We had a blast the day we wrote it just trying to do something fun. If I remember correctly, this song almost didn't get recorded, but thank God it did! Two-week No. 1, baby! It's been incredible to watch it take off like a rocket and become such a big song for Russell.

Carter Faith's "Burn My Memory" – This song is absolutely true! I had an ex-boyfriend do me pretty dirty in a multitude of ways, and one of them was burning a lot of my stuff. Carter, Brock Berryhill and Jessi Alexander all wanted to go there with it and so we did. I love how it's slow and then speeds up, slow and then speeds up again. Tofer Brown crushed the production and, honestly, I can't wait for my ex to hear it. Hope he feels great about himself.

Jon Pardi's "Friday Night Heartbreaker" – I'm always such a fan of Jon and getting to be part of a song on his album is so exciting, especially a single. We wrote this in Daniel Ross' studio and it started based around the guitar parts and vibe. I had the title "Friday Night Heartbreaker" that I had wanted to write about a baddie, and the guys were all down. I love the way it turned out. Jay Joyce is one of my favorite producers in the world and I definitely think it stands out on the radio.



# **Q&A: WSOC's Cameron Moore**

#### Where do you stand on crossover artists?

There are pros and cons. With streaming and DSPs, the genre-specific stuff can be outdated. I don't think people live with such strict guidelines anymore of what a song falls under. I'm more open to things not being [format] exclusive because I work in Top 40. If you think about what Top 40 even means, it's just the biggest songs, so that could be country, hip-hop, whatever. I know there's so much protection on the Country side of what falls under that genre, but we in the industry get wrapped up in that more than a listener ever does.

# Was it hard having a six-month gap between when your predecessor, John Reynolds, left, and when you officially were named PD?

No. I'd been doing the job for [those] six months, and [before that] always worked very closely with John, and had been doing the music logs for five years. I'm very familiar with the station, the staff and what our brand is. So, when John left, it was more about making sure nothing fell through the cracks and that nobody would be able to tell anything was happening behind the scenes from an output perspective. It was a lot of making sure all of our imaging and sweepers were up to date and fresh, making make sure our rotations are fresh and just keeping the train moving and the momentum up.

Country 103.7 is such a heritage brand, so it's not like I want to come in and make a bunch of changes on something that's worked for so long. But long-term, I want to expand the audience. Without alienating our upper demo, there's a huge opportunity to bring in a younger audience that isn't necessarily listening to radio because it's not playing the artists they're hearing on their social media.

#### How do you do that?

[Playlist slots] are hard to come by, so it doesn't necessarily have to be playing their music. You can do it through imaging, by mentioning the artists' names, getting liners from them, or bringing them in for a show. We have Gavin Adcock for our guitar pull this year. Last year we had Zach Top, who we got right before things really started with him.

Being aware of what's happening online is your first clue of what will happen in a year. As much as I respect and love the labels, I can't just believe the stories they're telling me. I have to do my own research and be really in tune with what's happening organically through the listeners. Anybody who is not paying attention and looking into what's happening outside of just terrestrial radio and Mediabase is doing a disservice to their audience.

### What's your leadership style?

People want to work harder when they're happy with their jobs. So, if I can bring a happy atmosphere with teamwork, collaboration and energy internally, that's going to help the product externally. That's what my first 30 days on the job were about. The most important thing to me was making sure the staff knew I was here for them. It was about unifying the team again.

#### Tell us three fun facts about Cameron Moore.

I have a six-month-old puppy named Pepper Roni. I love cooking and baking, and I was in an a cappella group in college during the Pitch Perfect era.
