ACM Honors: Honky-Tonk Dream

While accepting the Festival of the Year trophy on behalf of Tortuga Music Festival, Live Nation's **Brian O'Connell** shared the organization's philosophy, saying, "We use the barricade as our standard. It has to be as good in front of the barricade as it is behind." Both sides of the barricade were celebrated during last week's (8/21) **Carly Pearce** and **Jordan Davis**-hosted 17th **Academy of Country Music Honors**.

Among the Industry Award winners, presented by **Tyler Hubbard**, were the very venue the event was held in, Nashville's Ryman Auditorium (Theater of the Year); Don Romeo Talent Buyer of the Year **Ed Warm**, who also accepted Club of the Year for **Joe's Live**; and Uncasville, CT's Mohegan Sun (Casino of the Year - Arena). Recently retired casino mainstay **Tony Orlando** accepted on behalf of the latter after being told by the venue's Tom Cantone to "make the last stage you walk off after 64 years in show biz the Ryman."

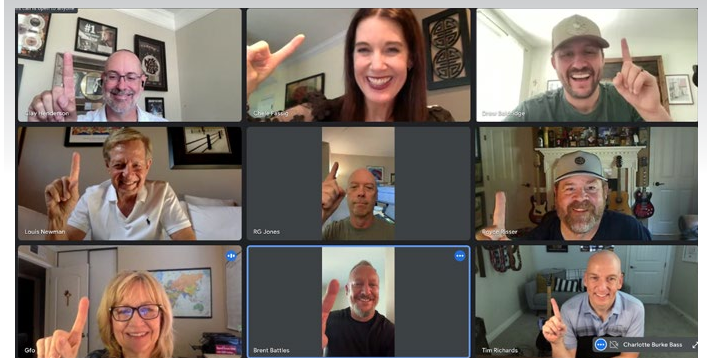
"Thank you to the Academy of Country Music for honoring those of us who spend a lot of time in the liner notes," said Acoustic Guitar Player of the Year **Charlie Worsham**, who used the rare date night for he and wife Kristen to announce they're expecting their second child (CAT 8/23). Additional Studio Recording winners included **Dann Huff** (Producer of the Year), **Paul Franklin** (Specialty Instrument Player of the Year) and **Rob McNelley**, who, despite picking up his fourth Guitar win, still has a hard time believing "the thing I love to do, that makes me happy, has a chance to go out there and make other people happy."

After a **Storme Warren**-led auction raised \$125,000 for **ACM Lifting Lives** (ACMLL), the special awards portion of the show began with **Terri Clark**'s performance of "Hang Tight Honey" in honor of "genuine badass and true original" **Lainey Wilson**, who was presented the ACM Triple Crown and Milestone Awards by **Post Malone**. 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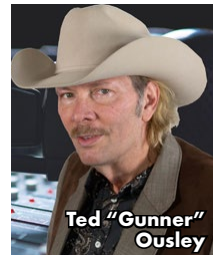

WIVK's Cowboy Rides Away

On June 20, **Ted "Gunner" Ousley**, better known to **WIVK/Knoxville**'s listeners as "Your Cowboy Pal Gunner," signed off for the last time. It marked the end of 26 years in afternoons on the station, and 40 years in afternoons in the market. One week later, he added another accolade to a long list of accomplishments, as he was inducted into the Tennessee Radio Hall of Fame.

Gunner says he learned of his induction in pure East Tennessee fashion, "Kenny Chesney called me and said I want to thank you for three things: your friendship all these years, for playing my music and for being inducted into the Tennessee Radio Hall of Fame." He adds, "My 97-year-old dad passed away a year-and-a-half ago. He didn't understand the ACMs or CMAs or anything like that, but he knew about the Hall of Fame, so that one's for dad."

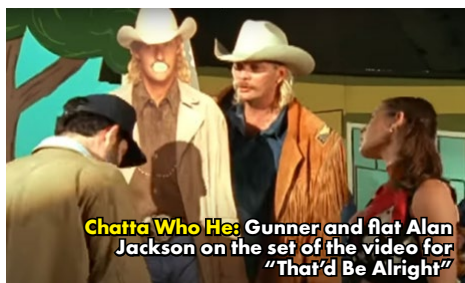

job was afternoons at WWZZ/Knoxville, which was a recent Country convert. There, a sales manager excitedly showed him a CD from a new artist named Alan Jackson. She exclaimed, "This guy looks just like you!"

"I had mistaken identity throughout my career," he admits. "It was weird, but it really helped with my visibility." The uncanny likeness led to an unlikely friendship, too. "The first time I met Alan, he had an idea for a video." That led to Gunner's cameo in the clip for "That'd Be Alright," featuring Jackson lookalikes. "He's been good to me over the years."

Gunner's next stop was at WOKI/Knoxville, again in afternoons, and just like WWZZ before, the station made the switch to Country. "Every time I walked into a radio station, they must have thought, 'It's gonna go country,'" he jokes. Five years later, WOKI was LMAed and subsequently purchased by its competitor, WIVK. Gunner then moved over to the station where he would spend the rest of his career. "Not many folks can say they only worked one shift their whole career."

There was more to Gunner's success than just having a famous lookalike. He also had Prince, his snow-predicting horse. "The horse forecast was 99.1% accurate and it drove the meteorologists crazy," he recalls. "It got so nuts, school superintendents would call me and ask what the horse forecast was."

Gunner's biggest passion – for the military – dates to his childhood. "In the second grade, I would write letters for soldiers," he recalls. It should be no surprise that when asked what the highlight of his 40 years in radio is, he doesn't hesitate. "Going to Iraq in 2004. I was the first radio guy to go there. I went with the 489th Special Operations and it was three months of intensity."

"I was doing breaks on a satellite phone – that's all we had," he explains. "Every star in the business wanted to talk to the troops: Chesney,

The "Cowboy Pal" appellation is not schtick. "I was still working on the farm throwing bales of hay" during his last year of college, when he got his first job in radio doing afternoons at AC WMDR-AM in nearby Alcoa. Gunner's next

Charlie Daniels, Reba – they all called in. I also had the opportunity to help Armed Forces Radio put a station on the air. They let me pick the frequency, so of course I picked [WIVK's] 107.7."

That outreach didn't stop once Gunner returned to Tennessee. In addition to organizing military appreciation concerts, he started *Voices From The Front*. "We had families of the 278th Armored Cavalry Regiment on for an hour a week talking to their deployed loved ones," he explains. "Folks overseas were lining up to hear the shows. It blew my mind."

Retirement has brought Gunner full circle. "I've got a 500-acre farm in Union County. I just walk around and pretend I'm farming. I'm a gentleman farmer," he jokes. While he's no longer behind the mic, his passion for the military has not subsided. "I do a lot of work with veterans, mainly dealing with PTSD. I worked with one veteran and brought him out to the farm. He got here and ran around yelling, 'I'm free, I'm free.' That was the best feeling I've ever had."

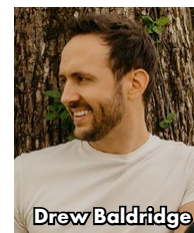

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relationships you build?" Somewhere between booking a convenience store opening at nine years old and playing sold-out shows to an audience singing her songs back to her, Wilson says she learned to "stop trying to prove people wrong, and start proving them right."

Keith Urban performed the **Jessie Jo Dillon** co-penned "Messed Up As Me" for the Songwriter of the Year, who urged the audience to protect and fairly compensate songwriters. **Lee Ann Womack** was joined by the **Fisk Jubilee Singers**

is one where creators can keep playing three chords and telling the truth," said Sanders.

Announced by a glass of whiskey on a stool, **Jamey Johnson** sang "Whiskey And You" for absentee Artist-Songwriter of the Year **Chris Stapleton**. "He's on a very important fishing trip," joked Johnson. Co-hosts Pearce and Davis performed "Hummingbird" and "I Ain't Sayin,'" respectively, and **Jackson Dean** channeled Glen Campbell for his performance of "Strong" to raise awareness of the [open grant cycle](#) for **ACMLL**, which received a \$100,000 donation from **Scott** and **Sandi Borchetta's Music Has Value Fund**.

Vince Gill recruited **Ashley McBryde** for a duet of his first **Tony Brown**-produced record, "When I Call Your Name" – a song a drummer once told Gill you can "count off with a calendar." While accepting his Icon Award, Brown shared the story of being recognized by a stranger in a Publix parking lot. "He said, 'Back in the day, you were really good.' If he's here tonight, you were right!" Brown was instrumental in the career of his fellow Icon Award honoree **Trisha Yearwood**, whose "The Song Remembers When" was covered by **Lauren Alaina** and **Emmylou Harris**.

"The heart of country music, the beauty of country music is good people," said ACM Lifting Lives Award recipient **Luke Bryan**, who Davis joked is so much more than "a charismatic guy who falls onstage a lot." **Jason Aldean** performed Bryan's "Someone Else Calling You Baby" and presented the award to his friend and colleague for, as Bryan's parents would say, "just doing what I oughta be doing."

The songwriting of ACM Poet's Award honorees **Walt Aldridge** and **Alan Jackson** was celebrated with performances by **Kameron Marlowe** ("Modern Day Bonnie And Clyde") and **Eric Church** ("Chasin' That Neon Rainbow"), respectively. Church put his own spin on the song and shared the story of a time he tried to do something similar with "Family Tradition" while touring with Hank Williams Jr., who told him, "Brother, don't paint on the Mona Lisa." "So," Church said, "tonight I'm gonna try to paint around the Mona Lisa."

Accompanied by wife **Denise**, Jackson dedicated the award to his father and that AM/FM table radio he won in a raffle. "Life gives you a lot of ingredients for songwriting," he shared. "I've been fortunate to pull a lot from my life and turn it into music over the years. That's been my biggest pride – to write a song and have people enjoy it and be touched by it, or moved by it, help through a hard time or enjoy a good time."

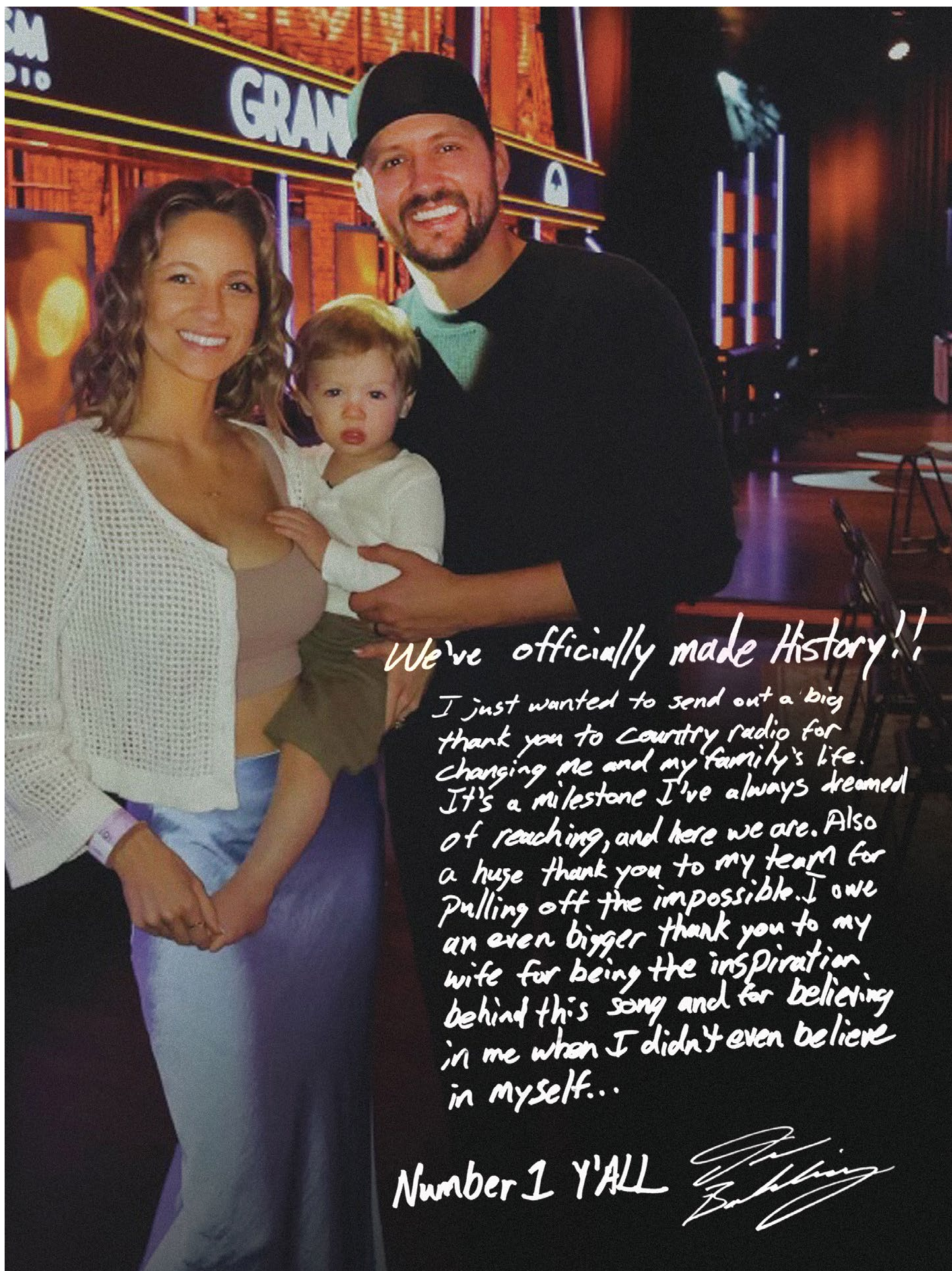
