Dave Dame Looks Back

Dealing with record people as PD/OM at KOWF/San Diego, I realized two things. One, I wasn't going to make a great living being in radio and, two, it seemed like the record people were having a lot more fun. If I was going to have some longevity in the entertainment business, it was going to be on the record side more than the radio side.

I thought Arista would be a great company to work for, so I pursued [then-VP/Promotion] Allen Butler for two years, keeping in touch with him monthly. One day I got a call out of the blue from [then-Dir./National Promotion] Bobby Kraig. They flew me in for an interview and, on Oct. 11, 1993, I took over as Midwest regional in Chicago.

In radio, I had a lot of great reps, so I knew what made me perk up and listen to their arguments. It also helped that my first day at Arista I was working an Alan Jackson record, a Brooks & Dunn record, and we





went for adds on the first BlackHawk single. To be able to work those artists when the format was so hot was just insanity. No industry was more fun than the country record business in the '90s. It will never be topped.

It was a privilege to work with Kenny Chesney and his team for 17 years, I have more respect for him than any other artist I've worked. He knows how to take care of his people, and he never got too big for himself. If we were in a fight, he was willing to jump in. He was the head of the team, but acted like he was part of the team.

The disappointments were few. The song I've always thought radio missed was BlackHawk's "Postmarked Birmingham." Artist wise, I think Shannon Brown had the most potential. She was a star and had an incredible voice; I don't think the right song ever came along for her, which is a shame. Whenever you put a new song or artist out, you think it's the best option, but it becomes what radio decides it's going to be. Your job is to edge them into seeing your way, but it doesn't always work out.

When I got into this it was either I got the record played or it didn't get played. Now it seems like there are a couple of radio stations you can affect, but decisions are mostly made at the corporate level. It limits the effectiveness of the local rep, which is sad. I'm not faulting anybody, it's just the evolution of the industry.

Now that I'm here, I'm going to figure retirement out and do the best I can for me and my family. They earned this too. As a rep, you miss a lot of anniversaries, birthdays, holidays and weekends, so they've earned the opportunity to do family things now.

There were a lot of people who helped me get where I am over 31 years, and none of it is lost on me. I am a very blessed guy who's worked with some of the best promotion people and artists in the history of the business. I don't know why God picked me to do it, but I'm very thankful he did.
