### Power Gold: Combs Sweet Combs

Country Aircheck's semi-annual Power Gold Top 100 is dominated by one artist: Luke Combs. With another new entry, Combs now has 11 titles on the list. That number is even more remarkable considering he didn't debut

in the top 100 until 2020. Combs outpaces Jason Aldean's nine and Luke Bryan's six entries.



Perhaps the most noteworthy move at the top of the list is that of Darius Rucker's "Wagon Wheel," which falls to No. 12 - out of the top 10 for the first time since its 2015 debut. All the songs within the top 10 are now less than five years old.

A breakout of the PG100 along ownership lines (see chart page 7) shows only three titles have consensus top 10 airplay among the three largest

groups. Showing one of the greatest divergences among owners, Davis' "What My World Spins Around" finishes No. 6 overall, while ranking first among Cumulus stations but only 42nd across iHeart.

Six songs have appeared on each of the 20 PG 100s since it became a regular feature in 2009: Dierks Bentley's "What Was I Thinkin," Kenny Chesney's "I Go Back," Billy Currington's "Good Directions," Rascal Flatts' "Life Is A Highway," Carrie Underwood's "Before He Cheats" and Keith Urban's "Somebody Like You." The latter also holds the distinction as the oldest release on the list – now at 22 years since the song's peak. The August 2024 Power Gold Top 100 is compiled from Mediabase 24/7 and music airplay information from the Country Aircheck/Mediabase reporting panel for the week ending August 31, 2024. ### **Audacy Bows Nashville Space**

Audacy's new "Nashville Sound Space" was formally unveiled last week with two parties – one featuring a ribbon cutting and performance from Thomas

Rhett – that showed off the state-of-the-art production facility, performance stage, gleaming new décor and a burgeoning collection of bizarre taxidermy.

Located on the third floor of the Hard Rock Café on lower Broadway, the facility is home to Audacy's nationally syndicated Katie & Company midday show, heard on 37 stations. Decorated with country artists' guitars and other memorabilia from the Hard Rock vault, the studio is expected to also be periodically utilized by visiting talent from other markets. It is the third studio to open as part of Audacy's three-year-old partnership with Hard

Rock International, following spaces in New York and Miami. It also marks Audacy's first permanent home in Nashville, where it operates no stations.

Audacy Chief Programming Officer **Jeff Sottolano** calls the new build "a multipurpose space in the sense that it's designed not just for radio distribution, but video, podcasts – really multiplatform." The partnership also gives Audacy use of the Hard Rock's second floor Reverb room to host concerts and private events for contest winners.



The new studio has designated spaces for performances, "fireside chat" interviews (complete with an electric fireplace) and a green room. There are also artist-friendly touches, including an elevator that takes them right up to the studio without having to walk through the tourist-packed Hard Rock, a Polaroid camera in the green room and a guest book in the bathroom that Katie & Company host **Katie Neal** says artists have been having some fun signing. She calls the facility "cozy. It feels like hanging out in someone's living room, which has always been the way I approach the show."

Neal has been operating out of the studio since the spring, having

previously worked largely from home. "I'm thrilled to have a designated space to be creative," she says. "I didn't realize how bad I was missing that."

Sottolano jokes that the Nashville studio has been in development "longer than we'd probably like to admit." Originally planning for it to go above the gift shop that sits in front of the Hard Rock, the Audacy team ran into difficulties adapting that historic building for its needs and soundproofing it against the lower Broadway cacophony. "You would hear every bachelorette on Broadway," Neal says. The company eventually shifted focus to the main building and





an area Sottolano says was "underutilized" as a utility room and staff break room. The design team was able to uncover some exposed brick during the 18-month build-out, making the "industrial commercial" space "so much more warm and inviting."

### OFF THE RECORD

Big Machine's Jackson Dean goes Off (The Record):

We've traveled the world and played hundreds of shows over the last few years and learned so much. We've lived a lot of life and seen a lot of life be lived and these songs carry that in them. Greenbroke was my chance to kind of say "hello" and On The Back Of My Dreams feels like we're a few mile markers down the road.



The overall theme for the new album revealed

itself only after all the recordings were laid out on the table and a common thread was right there. There is a surreal ... somewhat existential undercurrent that runs through the whole thing and it's reflective of the last few years of my life where I keep having these moments questioning, "Is this real life?" It's been a wild ride.

I grew up listening to albums and have been inspired by countless bodies of work. Songs are singular thoughts or feelings, but an album is where they exist in one place — aside from myself — and tell a bigger story or take you for a ride. To me, the art of it is to create something that can transport one or 10,000 people to somewhere else. I wanted to create something like the records that have inspired me and hopefully spark something in others.

"Jane" is where the title of the record comes from. It was written in the back of a bus with Luke Dick and Ryan Tyndell. We wrote it about a witchy woman that kind of haunts your subconscious and it became a self-fulfilling prophecy because I could not get it out of my head after we wrote it. The tones were inspired by my Appalachian roots and it [was] so fun and challenging to get it to what we pressed on the record. Watching Fred Eltringham overdub percussion and drums and create those sounds was a real highlight for me.

I was born in 2000 and I will not physically see the next century. "Another Century" is me coming to terms with that. It is extra special to me because we did it in only one take so the pain and passion is really raw. I sat in a vocal booth with my guitar in an open tuning. I had the best players in Nashville staring at me through a piece of glass. I told them wait on me, then let's ride the rocket into the sun!

At the heart of this record is "Heavens to Betsy," it separates On The Back Of My Dreams right down the middle. Before it are the lighter, happier songs ... the dreams, if you will. After it are the darker, heavier songs, sort of the nightmares. We've been playing it live for quite some time now and I can't tell you how many times fans have come to me (often in tears) sharing how this song has helped them make some sense of something in their lives they thought [they] never could. To get to help anyone feel anything at all is why I do this and I'm so grateful that it's evolved to become the current single. I really appreciate Country radio supporting "Heavens To Betsy" from the jump and helping it get to the people that it might need to hear it the most.

While he says there's "nothing to confirm at this time" regarding an expansion of the Hard Rock partnership into other markets, Sottolano says Audacy execs "certainly could imagine a world in which we partner with them on more of these spaces across the country."

Neal is responsible for collecting the animal decor via her "Taxidermy Topper" initiative, asking artists who visit her show to donate items "their wives will not allow in the house. I want the really weird stuff." Thus far, Lee Brice has brought in a deer head wearing an eye patch and a Rambostyle necklace of bullets, Luke Bryan donated a coyote with a cataract and Brantley Gilbert's contribution – brought to Nashville from his Georgia home – was a squirrel on a saddle riding a ram.

Neal jokes that she went for "forgiveness rather than permission" from Audacy on the animal carcasses, while also crediting the idea to SVP/Promotions & Experiences Chad Fitzsimmons. Sottolano envisions a "budding rivalry" among country artists about who can bring in the most "unique or spectacular" piece. He also thinks the collection shows off Neal's sense of humor and her "organic authenticity."

"We're trafficking dead animals now, which is not something any of us ever expected to be doing," Neal says with a laugh. "But here we are in the music industry, getting paid to do this." – Phyllis Stark




### **August 2024 PPM Scoreboard**


The **Nielsen** PPM August 2024 Survey (7/18-8/14) saw Country slip 2.5% in share, from last month's 358.4 to 349.6 – the lowest August share in the PPM era. Share is down 4.9% from last August's 367.6. Total cume was off 1.5% from last month at 21.8 million and down 6.2% since last August. **WCOL/Columbus, OH** was tops in share for the ninth consecutive survey, while **KKBQ/Houston** regained the cume crown for the first time

since May. Nashville was the top market by total share, with 17.8 from its four subscribing stations, followed by Kansas City (13.1) and Tampa (12.7). Legend: A "+" indicates a Classic Country outlet; a "^" designates co-owned Country stations in the metro; a "t" indicates a tie; and a "\*" indicates a station that is a recent subscriber for which ratings were not currently available. Ranks are among subscribers.




