#### **Unusual Paths To Radio**



The radio ranks seem to be populated with those who fell in love with the medium at a young age and/or college grads with communications degrees. But at least a few fell into radio in surprising ways, including three prominent Country morning show co-hosts. KKBQ/Houston's **Erica** 

Rico starred on a reality TV show; WQDR/Raleigh's Amanda Daughtry was a Nashville singer/songwriter; and KUZZ/Bakersfield's Vanessa "Ness" Heraldez taught at a prison.

Back On The Chain Gang: Fresh out of



Heraldez got hired for part-time work at KUZZ, where her learning curve included production, endorsements and the daunting studio board with "all the buttons." She admits, "On my résumé I said I do well under pressure. That's a complete lie." But within six months she was doing nights. Seven months after that, she was in mornings. "It's been

such a fast pace, but I don't take it for granted," she says, and laughs, "Brent likes to tell people he got me from prison."

In one unexpected way, teaching inmates helped her radio career. Entering the prison, she had to shake off her problems at the sally port to prevent inmates from sensing and exploiting personal issues. She now does the same thing at the entrance to the studio door. "If I'm having a bad day, it doesn't matter," she says. "My only focus is the listeners."



# Big Machine's Jackson Dean shares his ghost story: I was about 10, and my grandfather and my grandmother are buried at Sheltonham, a big military graveyard. He used to have a saying before he died that if he ever did anything for you, "Now, that'll be 25 cents," and it was just like something to make him chuckle. Well, we went to Sheltonham one day, my mom and my mother's sister and me. I took a quarter, and

those military graves are flat into the ground, so I took that quarter and put it in between the stone and the grass. I stood up, and I swear to God, we were all standing there looking at it, and it shot down into the ground. And it was just one of the craziest things I'd ever seen, and we all looked at each other. I dug down six inches in front of his gravestone. Never found the quarter. He took his 25 cents.



[but] it can really cost you later," she said. "It's okay to be Betty Badass. It's also okay to say, 'I have a fractured pelvis.'"

Manager **John Peets** of Q Prime agreed, saying, "If you're just going to put your highlight reel out, that's the fricking problem. I'm a fan of openness and being vulnerable with your audience [to build] genuine connections [that don't] dissipate as soon as you don't have a hit."

At a panel focused on artist wellbeing, **Gayle** and **Sam Williams** shared their own struggles, with Gayle noting she began therapy at 18 after having her first hit, "abcdefu," the year earlier, because she didn't know how to process negative social media comments. Williams said artists can feel "very deflated and gutted" when they're surpassed by other artists' streaming numbers, and also discussed the pressure on artists to upload social media content regularly.

Porter's Call's **Beth Barcus** said creators are also stressed by competition for awards, tickets sales and other measures of success. "When

something that is your therapy [songwriting] becomes a commodity," it can be very isolating, Barcus said.

Songwriter **Ashley Gorley**, who has been <u>open about his own</u> <u>struggles</u>, likened the inside of his brain to "a hot dog factory ... You don't want to see in there. You just want to enjoy the finished product." But he also said his "quirks" make him a better songwriter because he "feels things deeper and empathizes" with other writers. "If there's a question about sobriety that needs to [be addressed] that day instead of chasing a hit, we do it," he said.

Among the topics at an "executive roundtable" panel were setting healthy work/life boundaries and creating a culture that doesn't just offer mental health services, but encourages their use. Warner Chappell Music Nashville Pres. **Austen Adams** noted that some of the "arbitrary" ways we used to judge whether someone was a hard worker, like finding them still in the office 8pm, are no longer meaningful.




Kicks On Route 66: Rico was a radio vet who worked in sales, promotion and traffic departments, but it took a turn on television to get on the air. In 2009, she was a contestant on the short-lived NBC reality show Great American Road Trip, which featured eight families traveling the country on Route 66. Her family only lasted three episodes, but a promotional appearance on KKBQ made an impression. She recalls the sassy interview as "putting them in their place." The station's then-OM/PD, Johnny Chiang, heard the segment, invited her to lunch, and told her she was "made for radio." That was surprising news for Rico, who had overcome a childhood stutter. The morning show schedule appealed to Rico, who worried that her owned-and-operated advertising agency took her away from her children too much. After an on-air tryout, she joined KKBQ mornings in early 2010.

"That first year I think I did every concert, and worked every holiday," she says. "I was very lucky to have my first real radio job be in a top 10 market, so I knew I had to work up to where they were."

Still, there was a learning curve. Early on, she recalls "making a fool of myself" on the air during an interview with Garth Brooks. Attempting to reference wife Trisha Yearwood's recipe for peanut butter balls, she blurted out, "I have to tell you that I love your balls," getting a curt, "Excuse me?" reply from Brooks.

Wheelhouse's Alexandra Kay shares the stories behind Second Wind:

From the second I was pitched "Straight For The Heart," I knew it would be my first song at radio. Its hard-hitting melodies and emotional lyrics resonated with me instantly.



ALEXANDRA KAY put on Touch Tunes. You know you shouldn't, but pride fades, and all you want is the person you lost ... right now.

With quiet strength and steady love, "What He Does" tells a story that proves actions really do speak louder than words.

"Measure Of A Man" is a reflection on what truly defines a man: loyalty, consistency and showing up when it matters most.

A declaration that no one else can love you, see you, or understand you quite like they do, "Nobody" is a love song ... with an eerie twist.

Nearly 16 years into her on-air career, the mother of 10 and grandmother of six has made great strides since that on-air blunder, having recently been named one of the "Top 30 Influential Women of Houston 2025" (CAT 7/23). "The fact that we're in a position where we can help people is one of the greatest parts of the job," she says.

Ten Year Town: Daughtry moved to Nashville after high school with aspirations of making it as a country singer. Her first gig paid \$50 for the night, plus tips, but she rose through the lower Broadway bar

ranks, eventually earning \$100/night and a standing, 10-year gig at Legend's Corner.

There were nibbles of opportunity along the way, including a 2013 meeting with a major label that turned sour when the A&R rep bluntly asked if her "weight has always been a problem." She also had a four-night stint opening arena shows for Alan Jackson in 2019, yet her nonstop efforts to "keep my band fed" meant diminished time for songwriting.

Daughtry earned a real estate license to supplement her income, but after 10 years of grinding in the bars, she was "exhausted and burned out. I missed my family. I'd missed every Christmas, every 4th of July, birthdays, all of that for 10 years. They were some of the best days of my life, but also some of the hardest."

Returning to her native North Carolina and selling real estate, she got a call that changed everything. Years before, she'd played a birthday gig for longtime WQDR morning host Mike Wheless and the two hit it off. When he heard she was back in the state, he called out of the blue asking her to fill in as his co-host for a week in 2021.

After 40 minutes on the air together, Wheless left the studio for a bit, with Daughtry later learning it was so he could tell his boss he wanted her as his permanent co-host. Days later, she was offered the job. All of her years playing bars and going to sleep at 5am, she now had a gig that started at that time, but she took to it immediately. "I love being able to help people have a better day," she says. "I would have never in a hundred years guessed I'd be on the radio, but I'm thankful for the opportunity every single day." Wheless and Daughtry's The Q Morning Crew recently won the CMA Award for Large Market Show, a first-time win for Daughtry.
