COMING SOON... COUNTRY MUSIC'S FACTOR

CMHoF: Medallion Stallions

Last night's (5/6) Medallion Ceremony at the Country Music Hall of Fame & Museum again proved itself as country music's best night of the year. Family, friends and colleagues welcomed new Hall inductees **Harold Bradley, Sonny James** and **George Strait**, and the evening was taped for future broadcast by GAC and WSM-AM/Nashville. Here are a few of my favorite moments.

Harold Bradley: As Trace Adkins took the stage to sing "Hello Darlin" in honor of Harold Bradley's performance on that recording, he said, "I don't scare easy. But I've never been more terrified in my life." He shouldn't have been concerned. He nailed it, shaking the radio antenna in the rotunda above when he opened the song with his huge voice. **Reba McEntire** sang Patsy Cline's first No. 1, "I Fall To Pieces," which Bradley also played on. She recalled taking every break in her '70s recording sessions to ask Bradley about Cline.

Brenda Lee presented Bradley's medallion. She remembered Harold and his older brother Owen closing the famed Quonset hut one night when she was 15 so she and her friends could have a sock hop. "They hung balloons and bought the burgers and fries. The Bradleys were my family," she said.

Accepting, Bradley said, "I wanted to be the greatest guitar in the world. Instead I became the most recorded. I guess God had better plans.... People thought I was good. But I was surrounded by the best musicians in the best studios in the world. I thought I should have done better."

Country Cares In Kansas

Journal's KFDI/Wichita, KS acted quickly following Friday night's (5/4) devastating tornadoes which killed at least 10 people, injured more than a dozen and virtually obliterated Greensburg, roughly 100 miles west of Wichita. KFDI OM/PD **Beverlee Brannigan** points to the efforts of the station's *Dan Tooker in the Morning* show. "Within 12 hours of the tornado hitting Greensburg [they] were busy arranging drop off points for contributions," she says.

Collections included much needed bottled water, sports drinks and snacks for rescue and cleanup workers, and more than \$5,000 in cash for victims. Supplies loaded into PODS were delivered almost immediately to the disaster site by the Salvation Army. KFDI put the call out this morning for pet food and other animal supplies.

Brannigan: "The relief process evolves hourly and we continue to work to ascertain real needs [like] fencing materials, barbed wire, stock tanks, and cash, of course, [while guiding] people away from donating unneeded items. Clothing, for example. Additional fund raising activities are in the works. Thanks to everyone who has sent their best wishes along to Kansas."



Stagecoach Rolls Into Indio

One week after hordes of teens and 20-somethings packed into the Coachella rock concert, thousands of country fans swarmed to the first-ever Stagecoach country music festival held on the same site.

KKGO/Los Angeles morning show producer **Jackie Stevens** attended Stagecoach and told **Country Aircheck**, "It was a *great* weekend! Local papers reported that 25,000 people were expected both days, but Saturday was great weather and there were closer to 30,000 in attendance. Sunday had to be double that, because the place was *packed* for **Sugarland, Brooks & Dunn** and **Kenny Chesney**.

"From the Mane Stage to the Main Entrance, it was wall-to-wall people. One of the greatest things to see was just how many people showed up early for the opening acts. Even in 100 degree heat, there was a crowd at 1pm. Alan Jackson and George Strait definitely were the highlight of Saturday's show. Jason Aldean was jumping off the stage; Sugarland was all over it. And the greatest sign of another Stagecoach was literally a sign backstage that said, 'That's a wrap. See you in 2008!!' Overall, two days of great music and one of the greatest crowds ever."



Sonny James: One of the night's highlights was the appearance by James' longtime vocal group, the Southern Gentlemen, who hadn't sung together for over 22 years. They were fabulous. Lin Bown, Jack Galloway, Glenn Huggins and Garry Robble backed Vince Gill on "Young Love" and an amazing Connie Smith on "A World of Our Own."

The house came down when, in a role perfectly cast, **Ray Stevens** entered wearing a horned buffalo headdress and Native American buckskin outfit to sing James' "Running Bear." Stevens told James that he, too, once had a song about running "bare." Stevens deadpanned, "We called it the Streak." More laughs followed when **George "Goober" Lindsay** made a cameo half way through the song as "Little White Dove."

Porter Wagoner presented James with his medallion, calling him "a wonderful showman and a great man." Unable to perform because of allergies, James was very emotional when speaking of the Southern Gentlemen. Acknowledging them and bassist **Milo Liggett** who was in the audience, James said, "We started out together as friends, and today we're even closer."

George Strait: Dean Dillon began the musical tribute to Strait, noting, "I came to Nashville in 1973 to be a singer-songwriter. After I had three or four cuts by George, I thought, 'Why sing anymore?'" Dillon, who's had more Strait cuts than any other songwriter, sang his first Strait No. 1, "The Chair." Lee Ann Womack sang "The King of Broken Hearts." Alan Jackson sang "The Fireman," and, while looking at Strait, revised the closing line to "They call him the Fireman, that's his name."

George Jones present Strait's medallion, noting, "We first met when he was playing Jones Country theme park in the '80s. Now he's King George. He never changed from being the shy, quiet kid from Texas. He still rides horses and gets to be a cowboy. He stayed married to the same woman, Norma, for 35 years. Hot damn, that's good, you know!"

Accepting his medallion, Strait looked at Jones and said, "You're the king, I don't care what you say." Strait thanked his father, John, who was in the audience in a white Stetson. With former MCA top execs **Jimmy Bowen**, **Tony Brown**, **Bruce Hinton** and current UMG Chairman **Luke Lewis** looking on, Strait thanked all the present and past MCA employees. He was greeted with laughter when he said, "MCA is the only record company I've ever been with. I've been there longer than most of you were."

An emotional Strait concluded, "From the day I started singing country music, I dreamed of getting into the Country Music Hall of Fame. It's the ultimate achievement you can have in this business, so that's what I wanted. I'm truly honored and blessed today to be in the Country Music Hall of Fame."






