#### Meet Radio Hall of Famer Lon Helton

Being Country Aircheck's Publisher/CEO affords Lon **Helton** a certain deference in avoiding self-referential stories. But his impending Radio Hall of Fame induction Tuesday night (11/1) in Chicago gives his staff a well-leveraged moment of override.

Lon Helton

Helton's radio origin story now makes its first and likely only appearance in this publication, including the almost random break that changed his career, if not his life.

Sweet Home: Hailing from South Side Chicago, Helton spent a teenage summer pedaling an ice cream cart with a transistor radio attached. "I listened to Top 40 WLS all day, every day," he says. "When I was about to drive, my dad bought a new car without a radio, because he thought it would be a distraction. So, I hung my transistor radio on the dash. Radio became ingrained without me even realizing."

During his first week at Monmouth College (IL), he signed up for the campus radio station. "They gave me the Friday 6-8pm slot, which I thought was the worst," he says. "That's the time you're supposed to be having a few beers and getting ready for a date. But

after a week or two on the air, I realized it was actually a pretty good spot, because everyone else was drinking a few beers, getting ready for a date ... and listening to the radio. So, people would talk to me, because they'd heard me on the air. I became as big a radio star as you can be at a school of 1,100 students. That was a lot more fun than chemistry lab.

"After graduation, a fraternity brother who was doing sports on a local station hooked me up doing 5pm to midnight on the Beautiful Music station in town," he continues. "Eventually, a station across town gave me a few more dollars to do middays. Then, one 16 miles away gave me a few more dollars. Then I got a job offer in Denver, and the next thing I know, I'm in radio."

Helton and Cumulus VP/Country **Charlie Cook** met at KLAK-AM/Denver in 1973. "He was always very smooth," Cook says. "He knew the music and the format really well. Going on to work for [now iHeartMedia Chairman] Bob Pittman at WMAQ/Chicago,



he learned a lot and did every shift as the full-time fill-in guy. That's where he really honed his personality." More on that Chicago gig later, as it was in Galesburg, IL, at the start of his career, where seeds of an artist-centric mindset were formed.

**Both Kinds:** A country night club in Peoria was booking national talent, and Helton saw an opportunity. "I loved the club and wanted to find a way to drink for free, so I talked to the owner about having the acts come to the station Saturday mornings to promote that night's show," Helton says. "I ended up interviewing The

Statler Brothers, David Houston, Jeanne Pruett and others. These were interesting people with fascinating lives, and people started listening to this weekly segment and calling in."

After radio stops in Denver, Chicago and Los Angeles, he was named Country Editor for *Radio & Records*, which was owned by Westwood One. CEO Norm Pattis told Helton about plans to start a countdown with Helton as host. "I spent days telling him reasons it wouldn't work," Helton says. "Finally, he said, 'You don't understand. We're doing this show. You're hosting. It signs on in a month."

Helton was skeptical about plans to have an artist as permanent co-host – Pattis wanted Tanya Tucker. "I knew it would be very difficult to do a weekly radio show with the travel demands of an artist," Helton says. "But I remembered an hour-long show Ralph Emery did asking artists about the artists they were friends with and playing music. It wasn't a countdown, but I liked the concept."

"Bob Kingsley was the king," Helton says. "A master storyteller on a tightly scripted show. I told the Westwood One folks, 'Let's give Country stations something that's 180 degrees away from what Bob does, so if they want to run two, they are totally different shows.' Artist interviews were a way to differentiate." Country Countdown USA was born.

Talent Booker Jo **Hunt** has been with the show since its inception. "Lon wanted the artists in the studio with him, which was really unique at the time," she says. "It took some convincing, because it's not always easy for artists to be in town." Helton adds, "I knew we'd be okay when artists started coming prepared with stories they wanted to tell about



other artists. They thought it was fun, I think, because artists are usually asked to talk about themselves."

Radio embraced the concept, too. "We had 75 stations right off the bat, including WYNY/New York and KLAC/Los Angeles," says CCUSA Producer **George Achaves**. "Norm put all his muscle to attracting more stations, and in three years we had more than 250 affiliates." Until this year's shift to Compass from Westwood One, the show's 30-year run has been largely uneventful ... but it all came perilously close to never happening.

My Kind Of Town: While working in Denver in March 1975, Helton learned his father had been diagnosed with terminal cancer. "My wife Anne and I decided we were going to move back to Chicago, even if I had to work at Kroger," Helton says. "The OM in Denver sent my tape and résumé to a friend of his in Chicago radio named Ron Dennington. Ron called and said, 'I wish I could help you out, but we're a screaming, standing-on-the-chair Top 40 station and ... you're not.' I told him I completely understood.

"Six weeks later, my first child – Amanda – was born at 1am and, hand to God, as I was walking back into our apartment at 10am, the phone was ringing," he continues. "It was Bob Pittman from WMAQ telling me they'd just gone Country. I said, 'You want me to interview?' He said, 'No, you're hired.' I couldn't believe it and asked how, considering I never applied for the job. Turns out, Bob lived in the same building as Ron Dennington and, on the elevator one day, mentioned he needed a jock. Ron told him he had a tape from a kid in Denver and took it upon himself to send it over. That's how I got hired in Chicago."

That improbable hiring changed the course of his career – and meant something to his father. "Being from far-southern Illinois, my dad was a country fan," Helton says. "We would fight over the radio in the one car we had that actually had one. He wanted to listen to the Country station, which I hated, and I wanted to listen to the Top 40 station, which he hated. So, there's a special irony in me coming back to Chicago for the last eight months of my dad's life and working at a Country station. That wasn't lost on either of us."


Looking back, Helton demures, saying he was "mostly just lucky." Those closest to his career see other factors. Achaves points to Helton's interviewing style. "Because it's a conversation, he doesn't like to ask typical DJ questions," he says. "He also doesn't think about the next question until he asks it. All of his attention is on that answer so he can follow-up based on what was said. Quite often, we'll find something in those follow-ups and skip to that when we put the show together."

Cook agrees. "He has a natural, inquisitive style that comes across as, 'I really care about and am interested in you, and I know the listeners will, too.' Because of that, the artists are comfortable with him and tell him things they might not tell others." Hunt sums, "He is a passionate defender of country music and Country radio; I'm not sure if he even sees a separation in those two things. Everything comes back to him wanting what's best for this collective industry."






