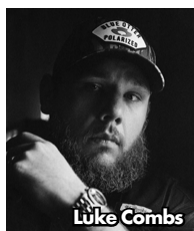
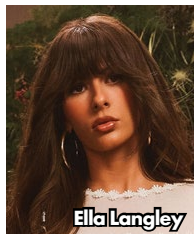

Q3 Airplay: Competition Heats Up

Rounding third and headed for home, 2026 may come down to a call at the plate in at least one category – Top Airplay Artist. To recap, **Ella Langley** held the top spot at the conclusion of the first quarter, only to be overtaken by **Morgan Wallen** in Q2. As it currently stands, Wallen has accounted for 6.95% of all Country radio airplay in 2026 thus far; Langley own 6.81%.



Adding to the intrigue, Langley & Wallen take the No. 1 slot this week with “I Can’t Love You Anymore” as Wallen’s “Don’t We” crests from its two weeks at the top. Meanwhile, his “Been By Now” and Langley’s “Loving Life Again” sit at Nos. 19 and 23, respectively.

Less dramatic but by no means over is the race for Top Airplay Label, which **Sony** leads again in Q3. With **Luke Combs’** “Be By You” currently in the on-deck circle (No. 2) and **Kane Brown’s** “Woman” poised just outside the top five, Sony’s lead may hold. But **Big Loud** still has the current chart-topper and titles from **Lauren Alaina**, **Hardy** and Wallen rising in the top 20 as the label seeks to defend its four-year run as airplay champ.

Breaking down the label race, Sony’s chart share comes from 14 titles, Big Loud boasts 12, and third place **MCA** has nine contributing. There are 115 songs that have spent at least one week in the top 50 this year so far. Wallen has been credited on six singles, while Langley and Combs have each had five. Those top three artists are joined by **Jordan Davis** and **Jason Aldean** in the top five artists (see the top 10 on page 9).

So far, 83 artists have received charted airplay this year: 61 males, 15 females and seven duos or groups. There have been 29 No. 1s.

As for the top songs of the year, no surprise that Langley’s “Choosin’ Texas” maintains its hold at No. 1,

Take Me Home, Country Radio

“Country music is a family,” **Rick Jackson** told the room last Monday night (8/3), and by the end of the 2026 **Country Radio Hall of Fame** induction ceremony in Nashville, every honoree had confirmed his point.

Jackson joined **Phil Hunt**, **Chris Carr**, **Michael J**, **Bruce Logan**, **John Marks** and **Marci Braun**, the Hall’s youngest-ever inductee, in the 2026 class, while **Lon Helton** received the CRB President’s Award. Dedicated to the late **Bill Cody**, the evening was hosted by KFRG/Riverside’s **Heather Froglear**, who stepped into the role Cody had long held. She quickly set the tone, joking that anyone who ate the salads could find the bathrooms “to the left and right.”

CRB Board Pres. **Kurt Johnson** introduced Helton as “one of Country radio’s great interviewers,” but Helton’s own remarks began closer to home. Walking up to Tommy Overstreet’s “Ann (Don’t Go Runnin’),” he recalled playing the song years ago to impress then-girlfriend Anne, before realizing

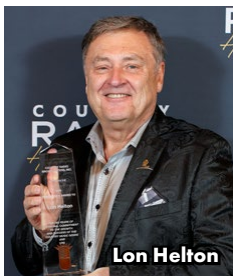

what it was actually about. He proposed soon after, and joked that everyone still likes Anne better than him.

Jackson opened with the "Howdeeeee!" he borrowed from Minnie Pearl and has used on-air for 40 years before reflecting on country music's "unbroken circle." "We don't discard our people when the hits stop coming," he said.

Hunt built his remarks around a fishing story and the mentors who helped him "bait hooks" and "untangle lines," declaring, "There is no such thing as a self-made man or woman." Minutes later, Logan provided the proof. "There would be no Bruce Logan without Phil Hunt," he said, recalling how Hunt helped him land another PD opportunity after he was fired from his first.

Logan walked up to Garth Brooks' "Much Too Young (To Feel This Damn Old)," also the first country song he ever added as an MD ... once it was safely inside the Top 20, of course. Houston and Louisville radio vet

George Lindsey recalled a young Logan repeatedly showing up saying, "I'm Bruce, and I just want to be in radio," before telling him, "Congrats, buddy. You helped define radio." Logan also finally answered the question his mother asked throughout his career: "There was never a backup plan."

Michael J recalled being escorted out of a station at 18 and told his radio career would be "very short." "Forty-five years later," he laughed, the prediction was "just a little off." His remarks turned to why radio matters, including more than \$30 million raised for St. Jude since 1994. "Not free concert tickets. Not awards. People."

Marks called his journey "a charmed life," tracing people who opened doors

for him and doors he opened for others that later swung back his way. Of artists he supported during his SiriusXM and Spotify years, he said, "I was just fortunate to introduce them to the people who did [make them stars]: the audience."

Introducing Carr, **Gregg Swedberg** said if you look up the definition of "DJ," you'll see Carr's picture. Carr's surprisingly dangerous career prompted his recurring phrase, "guaranteed" — guaranteed human, guaranteed dead, guaranteed medium-well, guaranteed home and guaranteed blessed — but his defense of radio was serious: "All mediums and platforms have a place, but radio was there first, and it's still relevant."

Braun brought the theme home, just like she brought WUSN to her home by illegally winning a contest under her mother's name. After recalling the women and mentors who built her foundation, she said, "There are a lot of doors that have been kicked open by women in our industry ... and it's important we leave them wide open for those coming behind us." Her simpler version summed up the night: "We don't need competition; we need community."

Or, as Braun told her fellow inductees: "We have a hell of a class, boys!" CRS 2027 is set for March 17-19 at the Omni Nashville.

WFRG/Utica, NY remains temporarily removed from the Activator panel due to technical issues.

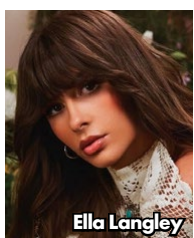
