## Meet Connoisseur's J. Love

Joining **KBAY/KKDV/San Jose** and Hot AC sister KEZR as OM shortly before their sale from Alpha to Connoisseur last year served as a bit of a homecoming for **J. Love** (call him "J."), who started his lengthy professional radio career in the market while attending college at San Jose State. Since then, he's worked in Greenville, New Orleans, Detroit, Providence, Oxnard, San Francisco, Reno and, most recently Las Vegas. He's also worked in nearly every format but Country. He returned to the Bay Area last summer ([Breaking News 7/24/25](#)) and he's loving every minute of it, as he shares with **Country Aircheck** below:

**I saw all these beautiful women** hanging around KDAY/Los Angeles' Greg Mack while he was doing a live broadcast from Venice Beach when I was 16. I thought, "Oh my God, that's the job I want." Even at 16, all my friends told me I had a radio voice.

So, I got an internship at KDAY. When I started college a year later, I worked at campus station KSJS, which was amazing. I had a morning show, and played Alternative music, then got my first major gig at [KHQT] Hot 97.7/San Jose.

**It's funny how my career** has come full circle. I did an internship at KEZR, and now

I'm the freaking OM. I mean, wow. Who would've thought that? I also do middays on KEZR. I never wanted to be an OM, PD or Brand Manager. I always wanted just to be a jock and party and have fun. And then I grew the hell up and decided to branch out ... and here I am.

**I knew Connoisseur was** going to be taking over these stations, and asked Alpha's Phil Becker to throw my name in because I know the market. He passed me along to [Connoisseur SVPP] Keith Dakin, who asked me to do a synopsis of both stations. Before I sent it in, I ran my ideas past my buddy, [KWNR/Las Vegas'] MoJoe Roberts, to see if I was on the right path, and his response was, "Dude, if I didn't know better I'd think you were



## Rumor Roundup: ACM's Whiteside

**Academy of Country Music CEO Damon Whiteside's** decision to step down later this summer ([Breaking News 3/3](#)) came a few weeks after news of the impending retirement of CMA CEO Sarah Trahern ([Breaking News 1/14](#)), initiating a storm of speculation. **CA: Rumor number one: You quit to go after the CMA job. True?**

**DW:** False.

**But there's no way this was a coincidence, right?**

It's a coincidence. I knew it was coming because Sarah and I had shared plans with each other and neither of us could believe the timing we had. Both are happy occasions for transition and growth in our careers and lives. I texted her the day my news broke and said, "Sarah, you're in all of my coverage!" Her response was something like, "We're kindred spirits forever." Very ironic, because we're super close and I think the world of her. I wouldn't be where I am in this industry or in Nashville if it wasn't for her. We have such a great bond. It's funny we're leaving at the same time, but I don't think I'd ever want to try to fill her shoes.

**Okay, but you're not retiring so clearly ACM must be struggling for you to want to leave. True?**

No. Quite the opposite. I would not be leaving if it was struggling, frankly, because what's motivated me in this chair has been wanting to win and leave the Academy stronger than when I came in. And that's where we're at now coming off our 60th anniversary, a multi-year renewal with Amazon Prime Video, financially stable and with a great leadership team. The time is right because we are in such good condition with a strong future.

**Final rumor: Having a departing CEO can't bode well for the May 17 show in Vegas, can it?**

We're not going to miss a beat. I'm in the seat till the end of June, and I am not taking my eye off the ball. If anything, this is going to be the last piece of my legacy at the ACM, so you better believe I'm going to make sure that it is an absolute home run. Everybody is going to have a great time and this will be a show to be remembered.

**Okay, so what are you going to do?**

My hope is to stay in this industry and in Nashville. I really haven't started thinking about it deeply yet. Whatever I do, it's going to be somewhere near the intersection of the music, film and TV industries. Yes, I've heard the rumors, but mostly there's been a lot of really nice outreach. I'm ready for the next challenge, and that's really it.

Congratulations to **Ella Langley**, **Raffaella Braun** and the **Triple Tigers** promotion team on taking "Choosin' Texas" to No. 1. This is Langley's fourth overall and second solo chart topper. 

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a veteran Country programmer." Keith introduced me to [Connoisseur founder/CEO] Jeff Warshaw, and we talked for 17 minutes on the Fourth of July. I'd never talked to a CEO about a job in my life so I was excited, which is why I remember the exact length of the call. We had a great conversation – 17 minutes of pure radio geek-ness. He made me feel very comfortable, and the rest is history.

**Seven months in, this job is great**, especially the staff. Morning host Danny Miller and I came up in the industry together here in San Jose, so we go way back. Midday host Tony Michaels used to work at [crosstown] KRTY, so he's a veteran, a great talent and a class act. I recently promoted afternoon host Emily Harlan to MD because she is freaking amazing. I saw something in her that you don't normally see in a person who's only had three years of experience doing radio. Add in Kelly Ford at night [tracking from sister WWWF/Nassau] – a bona fide superstar – and my lineup is a force to be reckoned with. They're all pros who just want to win, and I love the positive vibe that this building exudes. I haven't had that in a long time.

**My three Country besties** or mentors in the format are MoJoe, [Cumulus/Dallas'] Mike Preston and Bob Richards at KBUL/Reno. I blow their phones up with a lot of questions. I'm sure they get tired of me calling, but they've been very gracious in helping guide my philosophy in the Country direction. I've done Alternative, AC, Hot AC, Top 40, Rhythm and Rhythm CHR; Country was the last format on my bucket list.

**One way Country is different** from other formats is that I talk to a lot of local label reps. In Hot AC, you're dealing with Nationals all the time. But Country feels more like how radio used to be and should be. It's a lot more fun and engaging. You have more opportunities to have relationships with the artists than you do in other formats. So far, it's one of my favorite formats I've ever worked in.

**One of the things that's confusing** about the Country format is conversions. I'm learning what that means, because we never used that [term] in Hot AC, Top 40 or Alternative. And I'd never heard of a "push week" before. In Country, it's like you've got to follow along with the group. Still, the opportunities I have as a programmer to build relationships are

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better than any situation I've had in a long time.



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
