SOURCE Honors Groundbreakers

While the 21st annual SOURCE Awards got serious about honoring trailblazing women in the music industry, the comedy stylings of co-hosts **Brenda Lee** and **Jeannie Seely** kept the tone light and the attendees laughing at their banter throughout the Aug. 27 ceremony at Nashville's Musicians Hall of Fame and Museum. Lee lost her place in the script at one



point and muttered, "Am I on the right page." Seely shot back, "There's a lot about you that isn't right." The close friends, described by SOURCE Pres. **Kari Barnhart** as "a true embodiment of music's magic," had an easy rapport. That cast this year's third co-host,

Mandy Barnett, in a "straight man" role to keep the ceremony moving along as the group inducted **Teena Scogin Camp**, **Marty Craighead**, **Leslie Fram**, **Kathy Harris**, **Judy Seale** and **Sheree Spoltore** into its Hall of Fame. But the first order of business was honoring Seely with the Jo Walker-Meador Lifetime Achievement Award.

Briefly playing it straight while paying tribute to her fellow *Grand Ole Opry* star, Lee said Seely "gives so much and asks for almost nothing in return which, in this industry, almost never happens," calling her a rare "real" person in the industry, unlike other artists she's been a fan of, only to meet them in

person and discover that they're "shitty." Lee also noted that Seely has performed on the *Opry* stage 5,375 times.

Fittingly, Seely's honor included a congratulatory video message from Opry SVP/Exec. Producer Dan Rogers, and Opry members **Carly Pearce** and Rhonda Vincent. Pearce shared a story of first meeting Seely as a neighbor while Pearce was still an unknown "with country music dreams." Seely invited her backstage at the Opry on a night



Tour Launch: Long May Jelly Rain

"[Jelly Roll's] Beautifully Broken Tour is aptly named for a guy who does not shy away from his past, but embraces it, stays true to himself and can relate to people from all walks of life through his vulnerability and song lyrics,"

says KIZN/Boise APD/MD/morning host **Alana Lynn**, who attended the tour's Nampa, ID stop Wednesday (8/28). Lynn and KUBL/Salt Lake City middayer **Matt Ramone** tell **Country Aircheck** what to expect when Jelly *Rolls* through the tour's other markets.

Reflecting Mr. Roll's blending of genres, the radio room was a blending of formats, with Country, CHR and Rock stations talking to the headliner for more than an hour in "Buddy's Lounge" prior to the show. "Let's not forget how lucky





Big Loud's Larry Fleet goes Off (The Record):
I have grown tremendously, both personally and professionally, between the releases of my first and latest singles. When I wrote and released "Where I Find God," I was new in my faith and was still figuring out who I was and what I wanted to say. I have kept the same style the whole time because it's what I like and what I'm good at. Now, I have a family with two little kids and that's what my world revolves around. I write and record songs about the things that matter most to me. I know who I am and who my fan base is.



I usually don't try to write for anybody in particular. Some are for me and some don't necessarily fit what I'm doing, so I pitch those songs. I have always wanted to be a songwriter, so I get as much satisfaction writing good songs for other people as I do writing a good one for myself.

"Things I Take For Granted" was actually the second song I wrote that day. The first one was "Man Made A Bar," which Morgan Wallen and Eric Church recorded. I had some buddies out on the road with me writing, and I told them that being away from my family was the hardest part of my job. It's the little things we take for granted that I miss the most, like, hanging out with my wife, playing ball with my boy or tucking the kids into bed. So the inspiration came from real-life stuff. I live it every day, and so do my fans.

My sobriety has helped me on personal and professional levels. I haven't drunk any alcohol for a few years now, and I like the feeling of being completely aware of my surroundings. I didn't want my kids to see me getting drunk and acting foolish. I wanted to set a good example for them as well as other parents and kids. Drinking and being drunk is glorified so much these days. Kids are growing up thinking you can't have fun or "you ain't cool" if you're not drunk. I am a way better singer, songwriter, entertainer and person being sober, and I like that feeling. It's made me a better husband and father, and I'm proud that they can count on me.

I still write songs about drinking and partying because I know from experience what that's like. There are a lot of people who come to my show to let loose and have fun, and I want them to do that, so I've got some drinking songs too.

The Highway Feet with Larry Fleet podcast came about because enough people said we should start one. The guys and I are always sitting around telling stories, and so many people have told us other people would want to hear them. We are having a lot of fun and have been surprised at how many people are listening and sending us emails.

We are still figuring it out because none of us had ever done a podcast, but we are starting to lock it in. We haven't had any guests because we wanted to get it right before we brought people in. I've got some buddies who are going to be on it soon, but I have quite a few people I would love to get on it. I want to get invite other artists, songwriters and everyday people who have a cool story.

Country radio can expect the same thing from me that they have known from the beginning: to continue to work hard, put out the best music I can and be myself. That's what's gotten us this far, so there's no need to change what's working.

we are that the artists in our genre are willing to open their tours to us, provide drinks and food, and then take time before their shows to chat with us; it just doesn't happen outside this format," says Lynn, who was asked by CHR and Rock staffers if this is how "Country does it," and if so, told, "you guys are so lucky!"



The show opens with **Alexandra Kay**, who later joins Jelly Roll onstage for "Friends In Low Places" and "Any Man Of Mine," and **Warren Zeiders**, who Lynn reports has "the shiniest hair in the business, by far." Of the opening sets, Lynn admits it's humbling to be in the audience and hear them singing every word to songs *not* on your playlist. She adds, "But, as a lover of music, that's what our country audience has: passion for the artists." One collab that was left as a question mark on the setlist was "Losers," a song Jelly Roll told Ramone he'd invited Utah resident Post Malone to join



him for opening night in Salt Lake City (8/27), though Malone didn't make an appearance.

Ramone describes the B-stage, where the headliner opened his set, as having "a frame in the air that looks like a



house" and the "house" is lit on fire for the opening ("I'm Not Okay") and closing ("Save Me") songs. Mr. Roll also made it rain during the closer ... despite both shows taking place indoors. The deeper meaning of the fire (judgment) and rain (cleansing) combo wasn't lost on Lynn, who cites the symbolism as one of many show elements inspired by Jelly Roll's faith. At one point, when speaking about that faith, Jelly Roll told the crowd, "I'm one of those people who loves God ... but says f*ck a lot." Lynn asks, "Is there anything more relatable?"

While Ramone's highlight was the end of the show, Lynn notes the beginning as hers. She explains, "While most artists would choose an upbeat banger to grab the attention of the crowd, Jelly stays true to the formula that got him here: raw vulnerability, speaking his truth while simultaneously tapping into the often unspoken part of all of us ... 'I'm not okay, but it's all gonna be alright.'" Additional songs on the setlist included No. 1s "Need A Favor," "Son Of A Sinner" and "Halfway To Hell."

When leaving the show, Lynn and Papa Roach drummer Dave Buckner, who was also in attendance, asked, in unison, "What just happened?" Ramone calls the tour a "must see," and Lynn describes the experience as a "big hug for your soul." Reach Ramone here and Lynn here and Lynn here.

when Carrie Underwood was performing so she could experience it. Opry member Mark Wills also took the stage to recognize Seely, saying she was the first to welcome him when he made his Opry debut 27 years ago.

Seely began her acceptance speech by quipping, "They told me I had three minutes, but Brenda just took two-and-a-half."

Darryl Worley, Linda Davis, members of the Oak Ridge Boys and the Bellamy Brothers were among the luminaries on hand

to support the night's inductees, and several others appeared on screen. The Oaks sent a congratulatory message to Harris, with the band's **Duane Allan** noting that it was Harris' idea for the band to pose with a live cougar on their 1985 Step On Out album cover. Crystal Gayle offered a video message to Camp, and actor Gary Sinise sent one tributing Seale.

Industry execs also shared video messages. Producer and former label



head **Tim DuBois**was there in person,
but also sent a
video for Craighead
saying he once told
someone asking his
advice about what
was needed to start
a label, "You might
get an Alan Jackson,
but you're also going
to need a Marty
Craighead." Cumulus'



Brian Philips spoke in honor of Fram, calling her "a soulful, gracious collaborator" and "empathy personified," also saying Fram has "always made it possible for [marginalized] voices to be heard above the fray."

Fram, CMT's SVP/Music Strategy, spoke for all of the honorees when she said, "To be in a room with all of these women who have paved the way ... is a huge compliment and a highlight for all of us." Seale, who takes artists to visit U.S. troops overseas via her Stars For Stripes organization, joked that she was more nervous speaking in front of the SOURCE crowd that she ever felt in Iraq or Afghanistan.

Meanwhile Harris, a longtime member of the Oak Ridge Boys operations, management and marketing team, offered the night's best advice, noting, "Keep getting up every morning to do the hard things" and "prioritize the balance between work and family." She also added, "If you need to compete, compete with yourself, never with other women."


