

#### **Chart Chat**

Congratulations to **Dustin Lynch**, **Carson James**, **Lee Adams**, **Shelley Hargis**, **Scotty O'Brien** and the **Broken Bow** promotion team on taking "Stars Like Confetti" to No. 1. This is Lynch's ninth chart topper and the 45th for the Broken Bow imprint. Songwriters are **Josh Thompson**, **Thomas Rhett** and **Zach Crowell**.

Two songs debut in the Top 35 this week

– "Rodeo Man" by **Garth Brooks** & **Ronnie** 

**Dunn** and "Take Her Home" by **Kenny Chesney**. The last time such a feat occurred was Oct. 26, 2020, when "Gone" by **Dierks Bentley** and "Down To One" by **Luke Bryan** debuted at Nos. 29 and 32 respectively.

Kudos to the **Warner/WEA** promotion crew on scoring 128 adds for Chesney's "Take Her Home." His 46th release to top the Add Board is also his third-largest ever, eclipsed only by 138 adds for "Noise" (3/28/16) and 130 for "Get Along" (4/9/18).

This was a really strong showing this year."

WNFN/Nashville Brand Mgr. **Ron Allen** watched the Nov. 8 show from inside Bridgestone Arena, and says, "Overall, it lived up to expectations ... The CMA does a great job of incorporating some of the older artists into the show ... from Wynonna and Tanya [Tucker], to the tribute to Jimmy Buffett with Alan [Jackson] on stage, it was great to see the respect and reverence these legends receive from both the current artists and the crowd."

Hosts With The Most: Second-year hosts Luke Bryan and Peyton Manning also received praise. Malone thought the two "seemed even more comfortable hosting this year." And Matthews asks, "Is there any better than the duo of Luke and Peyton? They are so fantastic. I really hope they can just sign these guys to a long-term deal."



**The King's Speech:** Among the night's favorite acceptance speeches were Jelly Roll's motivational, "Keep going, baby ... success is on the other side" recognition for New Artist of the Year, and Lainey Wilson's "it finally feels like country music is starting to love me back" Entertainer of the Year acceptance.

Washington calls Jelly Roll's words "the definite highlight of the night. Raw, real, and true to himself." Jackson agrees, saying, "Jelly Roll was terrific, and I appreciate that he is so authentic. Today's audience craves authenticity, and right now we have some very credible examples in our format."

Matthews says he "could listen to Jelly Roll and Lainey speak from their hearts for days. They are such a positive force in music that is needed."

Hitting The Post: Asked to cite their favorite performances of the night, radio programmers most often cited the Buffett tribute featuring Kenny Chesney, Zac Brown Band, Mac McAnally and Jackson, and the Joe Diffie tribute featuring Morgan Wallen, Hardy and Post Malone.

KSCS/Dallas APD/MD **Al Farb** is a fan of both. "Post Malone singing the late, great Joe Diffie – brings a tear to my eye every time I hear it," he says. "And yes, we immediately added it into rotation. Posty is from DFW, so of course we have to represent!" His runner up moment was Jackson's performance honoring Jimmy Buffett.

WFMS' Malone says of the Buffett tribute,

"Being such a fan of country music, I may have gotten a little emotional seeing Alan Jackson back on stage and performing with Zac Brown Band." He also loved Post Malone's performance, and says, "[Chris] Stapleton tore the house down, as always. And Lainey was amazing; a killer performance."

Matthews' favorites included Bryan's medley of hits ("he's a guaranteed good time"), Wilson ("she is so special ... what an artist, what a star") and the opening number with Jelly Roll and Wynonna. "So cool to see the both of them," he says. "Jelly exudes everything you would want in a rock star." He also thinks "Chris Stapleton was amazing, and Dan + Shay were awesome. Shay Mooney hit a knee slide that was about the coolest thing of the night."

**Room For Improvement?** Washington's sole critique is a preference for more in-format/genre personalities and artists. "Love Nate Bargatze and all, but there are dozens of artists that would kill to present," he says.

"I was very surprised that some of the mega stars of country didn't show up," Malone says, citing Kane Brown, Jason Aldean, Carrie Underwood and Miranda Lambert. Farb would like to see better representation for CMA Broadcast Award winners. "[Honorees] put so much time and effort into the nomination presentation and aircheck," he says. "It would be great to get more than just a few quick seconds of air time."

Lainey Season: While there was great enthusiasm for the choice of winners, including Wilson's first Entertainer prize, many would have also been happy to see Wallen take the title. "I hope Morgan Wallen filed a police report after the CMA Awards ... that man was

robbed," wrote KPLX/Dallas APD/MD **Smokey Rivers** on Facebook. "No awards for the biggest star this format has seen in years."

"I understand the complex feelings some people have, but I think Morgan was robbed," agrees Allen. "After the year he's had, to walk away empty-handed [felt] wrong somehow."

Farb is also among those who think Wallen was overlooked. "He is one of the biggest artists in music, selling out stadiums, multiple nights, and to not get one award? No offense to any of the very deserving winners, but to completely shut out Morgan on a year that he took our format to the next level isn't cool in my book." Malone adds Combs to the list of snubs. "Chart success, single success, tour success, and the amount of extra audience that has been drawn to country music because of Morgan and Luke's crossover success ... I was shocked, but absolutely thrilled for the winners!"

Washington also says he was surprised at Wallen's shutout, but adds, "[I'm] thrilled for Lainey Wilson, as she is a force in our format and will be for years to come." Jackson adds, "Everyone in the EOTY category deserved to be there for sure, but Lainey has worked relentlessly. She has built this year one brick at a time."

I've gotten so many messages from people who have been through something like that, and to be quite honest with you, how they wished somebody would've done what the person did in the song. 

"I think what helps me with my mental health and it helps me be so joyous is: one, coming from where I came from which was the opposite of something, and two, just understanding the therapy that is involved with not only songwriting but music in itself, and the true power that music holds.
