In the Arbitron ratings for Raleigh in the Spring of 1984, album-oriented Rock station **WQDR** finished in second place with a 10.8 share. However, those big ratings (mostly young and male) were difficult to turn into revenue.

Raleigh also lacked a full-signal FM Country station, while nearby WSOC/Charlotte and WTQR/Greensboro had both begun consistently hitting No. 1. "We feel like we've done a good job, and we've had a good time for the past 11 years," then-Station Manager **Laurel Smith** told the Raleigh News & Observer. "Basically, we feel the market has gotten older (and would respond better to a Country format)." So, on August 31, 1984, WQDR flipped.

The station saw slow but steady growth and reached No. 1 for the first time in 1989. Since then, WQDR has accumulated 59 more No. 1 books, won six Station of the Year awards from the ACM and CMA, and gave the format one of its most highly regarded programmers, the late **Lisa McKay**. Two longtime employees, morning host **Mike Wheless** and PD/afternoon host **Mike Biddle**, share their thoughts on the station's milestone.

it was Rock. I remember people badmouthing the change to Country. A lot of my friends didn't like it. I was one of the youngest guys when I started 36 years ago. I did news, then overnights, then moved to mornings in August 1992 and haven't looked back.

MB: Forty years and I've been here almost half of that. I'm from Richmond and worked with Lisa there. When she had the opportunity for me to do nights here, I said, "Let's do it." I'd only done Top 40 to that point, but leadership wanted to rejuvenate the station. During a staff meeting, consultant Rusty Walker mapped out what we're going to do to make sure WQDR turns into a legendary station. I still have the notes in my office.

MW: Rusty said he wanted us to be a Pop station that just happened to play country music. Lisa was great at executing the playbook and would not stop until it was done. She's a big part of the reason we got to the next level; she had her foot on the pedal non-stop.

MB: Lisa's presence will always be felt here.

Post Show Malone


Walking into view from the side of the stage barefoot and wearing a Billy Strings tee, **Post Malone** kicked off his F-1 Trillion show in Noblesville, IN Thursday (9/12) with the lead track from his debut country project, "Wrong Ones." "There was an energy at this show that's hard to put into words," says Radio One WLHK/Indianapolis MD/afternoon host **Cara Denis**, a longtime "Posty" fan who attended the show with PD **Sean Copeland**.

Also in the audience were Cumulus WFMS/Indianapolis PD/afternoon

host **Brooks O' Brian** and APD/MD **Matt Malone** (no relation), the latter of whom met attendees who were there to see openers **Muscadine Bloodline** first ... seeing Posty was just a bonus. Both Denis and Copeland noted it was the first time they'd seen the lawn completely full within 30 minutes of the gates opening.

"With the beginning of the show, and throughout the rest, you would've thought he spent half of the ticket sales on pyro with how many fireworks and flames rose from the stage," says Malone. The setlist included tracks from the new project, like "Losers," "Go To Hell" and "Missin' You Like This," as




well as pre-country Malone hits, like "Rockstar," "Circles" and "Chemical."

One thing missing from the setlist was filler. "The show itself was all killer, no filler, much like the album," says Malone. Adds Denis, "Something that really stood out to me was the amount of people singing every word to every song on the F1-Trillion album. Not just the radio hits, every song." The biggest reaction of the night came from his Morgan Wallen collab, "I Had Some Help." "It sounded like the entire place was singing in unison ... even the quick 'help!' line," notes Denis and Copeland. But, aside from the band, Post did not actually have any help (guests) join him onstage.

After he left the stage, slow chants of "Posty! Posty! Posty" began to build and an encore, featuring a country-fied version of "Sunflower," followed. Having seen Post Malone in the past, Denis was curious if his energy would change for this tour. "Not one bit," she says, adding, "He is so much fun to see live! He dances all over the stage and looks like he's having a great time ... the F1-Trillion Tour is such a vibe!" Reach Denis here, Copeland here, O'Brian here and Malone here. Print Preview: Long & Short Of It

Long-tenured radio pros Lorianne Crook and Charlie Chase, and still-hosting-at-86 personality Mary McCoy will be inducted into the Radio Hall of Fame in Nashville this week. Meanwhile, country song runtimes are at historic lows. Those stories, the reader-voted Power 31 and Radio One CEO David Kantor discussing the company's moves outside of Urban formats are featured in the September print edition of Country Aircheck.

THE INTERVIEW

First up, why are songs getting shorter ... what does it mean? Among the top 20 airplay songs of each year over the last decade, there's only one longer than four minutes. Luke Combs' "Fast Car" clocks in at 4:14 – but was written in 1987. Finding another top 20 song longer than four minutes means going back to 2014 for Eric Church's "Give Me Back My Hometown" (4:12) and Miranda Lambert's "Automatic" (4:07).

"Since 2014, the average song length has gone from 3:27 to 3:11," says Music Choice Head/Country Programming **Jim Murphy**. "On the surface that doesn't seem like a whole lot, except when you see that on an almost year-by-year basis, it gets shorter by one or two seconds. I now have about 250 more spins

in an average week than I had in 2014. I've had to add positions on my clocks in just the six years I've been with the company."

Songwriter **Ashley Gorley** isn't surprised. "We're cutting commercials out of the shows we watch," he says. "We won't drive to the restaurant to pick up our food anymore. And we're not going to listen to an outro for 45 seconds. I can't remember the last time my kids got to the end of a song they like. They just click back and start over. Or get 1:15 in and jump to the next one like a DJ."

Songwriter/producer **Jesse Frasure** says he hears the clock ticking. "You might have a catchy post-chorus and think, 'We need that on the first two because it's so good.' If all those things feel necessary to a song and it goes long, so be it. But if I'm just getting into the third chorus and I'm at three minutes, something is wrong."

Perhaps the trend will eventually shift the other way, but songwriter **Ross Copperman** isn't sure. "I'd like to think it's cyclical," he says. "With TikTok

extending the length of their videos it might move the other way. But our attention spans are so shot. I can't even watch a movie. A 45-minute show feels long."

What might feel even longer is the record-setting on-air career of KVST/Conroe, TX personality Mary McCoy. The soon-to-be Radio Hall of Famer was already a local celebrity when she met one of the biggest ever. "I was sitting on the steps on the back of the stage, and he walked up and said, 'I'm Elvis,'" she recalls. "I said, 'I know who you are.' He asked if I was hungry, I said I could always eat. He replied, 'Let's go across the street to that restaurant.'" Joining McCoy in the Hall are Crook & Chase, who also know a few things about famous singers ... and their fans. "We try to have mature conversations about life, but mostly just have a ton of fun and try to bring out the best qualities of each artist," Crook says. Adds Chase, "The important groundwork for whatever result we get is that we're fans, and look at things from that perspective. People pick up on that."

And in The Interview, Kantor explains Radio One's decision to add stations outside of its longstanding focus on African-American and urban audiences – including KKBQ/Houston and WLHK/Indianapolis – and the differences and similarities of the formats. "A mainstream Urban AC is very similar to Country," he says. "The way the playlists work, the way the currents roll up or don't roll up, the way you look at recurrents, the music testing – even the way your jocks operate. Very similar. I've always had the philosophy that all radio audiences are actually similar. They're just very targeted. And what you have to do is get to the psychographics and the demographics that fall into that particular audience and build on that."

Country Aircheck's September issue will be available this week in physical and digital versions.

Her hall of fame plaque is right outside the conference room we named after her. She was a big influence not just on me, but on everyone here, and our listeners, too.

MW: In the summers we do our hometown tours and go to McDonalds in different towns. One year we went to Garner and this kid [Scotty McCreery] was playing guitar in the parking lot. His father came up to me and said they were going to try out for *American Idol*.

MB: Some people could have let the success go to their head, but Scotty's not that kind of guy. Anytime we've asked him to help with

something – and we try to be respectful – it's an easy yes. "Are you in town? You want to come by the morning show?" Having some Bojangles' biscuits is his only request.


We don't act like a 40-year-old radio station. We come in every day going, "Hey, how are we going to make ourselves better than we were yesterday? How are we going to continue to evolve?" We set goals, we achieve those goals, then we set new goals. There's never a finish line.

MW: Biddle is so dedicated to this station. We joke that if I was to drop dead in the studio, he would make sure we were still on the air before he called 911.

MB: There's a lot of hardware in the trophy case and we want to keep adding to it, but I don't wake up every day thinking I want to win a trophy. It's about how are we going to make people's lives better? If Lisa were here today, she'd be very proud of the fact that we've been able to continue to do radio the way we want. While a lot of stations are devesting in people, we're investing. We're not curing cancer or solving the world's problems, but we can make an impact. Radio still matters.





The 12-track project – Urban's first new album in nearly four years features single "Messed Up As Me," a duet with Lainey Wilson ("Go Home W U") and "Wildside," a song loosely based on Joan Cusack's character in the movie The School of Rock.



Midland Barely Blue (Big Machine)

Recorded with Dave Cobb at Georgia Mae Studios in Savannah, GA and mixed at Apex Sound in Burbank, CA, the eight-track collection is an "exploration of loneliness, masculinity and resilience in the face of heartache."



Mitchell Tenpenny The 3rd (Riser House/Columbia)

"I want this record to be all over the place," says Tenpenny. "I want somebody to be able to find their song in the record, something that helps them or just something stylistically different from everything else. It just encapsulates everything I've done and all the genres I've loved."

"I'm proud of it. I've left no stone unturned," says Douglas. "I've been producing records for a long time, so I really, really put on that hat for this record. Usually, I like instrumentalists to have free rein in whatever they do. It's the way they speak. If anybody had an idea, we chased it down to the end. I feel like it's really finished. I'm really happy with the outcome of this whole experience."

The album features 15 tracks remastered from original production tapes, including her first No. 1, 1960's "I'm Sorry," "Sweet Nothin's" and "I



Drake White Low Country High Road (—)

The 13-song collection features early releases "Life, Love And War" and "10lbs of S#IT," as well as the Jonathan Singleton co-penned "Faith."



Christian Hayes Last I Love You (Capitol Records)

The five-track project offers Hayes' first three singles – "Leaving," "LILY" and "Cheyenne" – plus two new songs. "Last I Love You is the prequel to who I am now," he says. "It's a group of songs that tell a story about who I was and where I come from. I'm excited for this to be my first release with Capitol – this is just the beginning and I am so grateful."
