

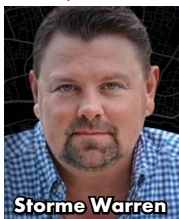

Radio Stories: Straight On The Air

Sometimes the music is so good, radio pros don't wait for a story to build, a call from the label or even an add date. They just walk in the studio and press play.

• The Big 615's **Storme Warren**: The first CMA Awards I didn't have to work in probably 25 years, my wife and I decided it would be fun to have a date at The Palm and watch everyone else dressed up in their monkey suits. SiriusXM wasn't doing red carpet or backstage that year (2015), so we got a bottle of wine and were enjoying ourselves when Eric Church's right hand man Marshall Alexander called. He goes, "Where are you? You're not backstage?" I told him I was at The Palm and he says, "Shit. I'm on the way." He races over in a golf cart and hands me a manila envelope. "Eric says to do whatever you want with this." I'm like, "What is it?" He looks at me and says, "You have about three hours to do whatever you want before the world knows." I could tell it was a CD so I asked if it's a song or an album. Again, Marshall says, "Eric says do whatever you want." So I told my wife to get another bottle of wine: "I'll be back in about 45 minutes. I think I have an unannounced album."

Our studio was right there at Bridgestone, so I ran across the street and saw the BBC's Bob Harris outside smoking a cigarette. I asked, "You want to do something fun?" As we ran upstairs I told him we had an exclusive album from Eric Church to premiere. I called my boss, who asked if I'd heard it yet. I said, "Nope. And I don't want to until we all hear it with the audience." He said, "We never had this conversation." I then called the mothership to tell them we're going live and they said I wasn't on their schedule. I said, "I know, but we're going live." They replied, "Okay, there's about three minutes left in the song that's playing." I said, "Fade it out. We're breaking in." And we did, with Bob and I playing Eric's *Mr. Misunderstood* track by track and adding our commentary along the way. The funny thing is, Eric didn't know until two years later when he asked if I ever did anything with that CD. I told him the story and he goes, "Holy shit, that's great." Those are the moments that remind me how radio is supposed to work.

NaSHOF: Every Song A Memory

The **Nashville Songwriters Hall of Fame (NaSHOF)** celebrated its 55th Anniversary Gala last week (10/6), honoring seven new members. The Class of 2025 — **Steve Bogard**, **Tony Martin**, **Jim Lauderdale**, **Brad Paisley**, **Don Cook** and **Emmylou Harris** — was joined by posthumous inductee **JJ Cale** in the Legacy category, recognizing writers who spanned generations, genres and decades of songs that helped shape the Nashville sound.

The evening began with a salute to the late Cale, whose "After Midnight" was performed by Americana artist **John Fullbright** following a presentation by Hall of Famer **Gary Nicholson**. From there, member **Tom Shapiro** took the stage to present Martin, opening with, "In the immortal words of Lizzo, *it's about damn time*." He praised his friend as a craftsman who "panned for gold" one song at a time before **Wendell Mobley** performed their Jason Aldean cut "A Little More Summertime."

Hall of Famer **Gretchen Peters** then introduced Lauderdale, calling

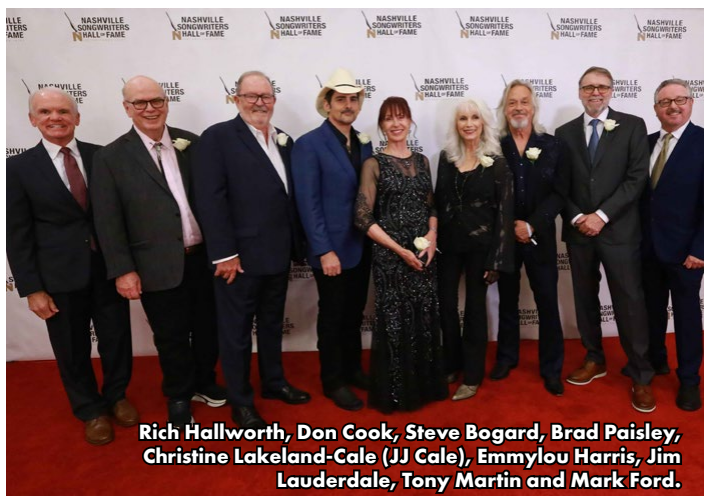

him "an original" and "prolific" in a world where "those words are probably thrown around too much." **Lee Ann Womack** honored Lauderdale with a performance of "The King Of Broken Hearts," after which he reflected on music's deeper meaning. "I've been sneaking in subliminal messages into songs," he said. "It's really important to get along better and love each other. You're a song, we're a song – music is in everybody, and our lives are songs, really."

Bill Anderson and **Steve Wariner**, both past inductees, welcomed Paisley, who deferred his 2024 induction so he could be present at the ceremony. Anderson presented, while Wariner performed "We Danced." Paisley joked, "You let an imposter in – I came to town because I wanted to be you." Calling himself "the best intern ASCAP ever had," he reflected on the full-circle moment from aspiring songwriter to Hall of Fame member.

Kix Brooks set the tone for Cook's induction, recalling a carnival slingshot ride gone wrong that resulted in a minor injury for **Ronnie Dunn**, a near panic attack for hypochondriac Cook and a mouthful of V8 for comedic effect. "Anyway," Brooks concluded, "Don is a great songwriter." Dunn joined him onstage for "Brand New Man," after which Cook shared a gratitude list that included family, friends ... and the teenage girlfriend who told him he looked stupid playing the trumpet.

Dierks Bentley honored Bogard with "Every Mile A Memory," after which **Rory Bourke** presented the longtime NSAI President. "The pay-it-forward humanity of our music community is like nowhere else on earth," Bogard said. "It's at the heart of why so many good songs come from here." The crowd applauded when he added, "I'm as dedicated as ever to making

Sony Music Nashville's **Karley Scott Collins** goes track-by-track through her debut album, *Flight Risk*:

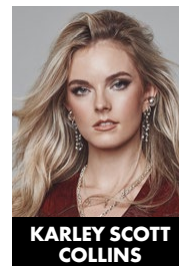
I was going through a difficult time when I wrote "Only Child" because my mom had just been diagnosed with cancer. I have always been very close to my parents, but something like that really gets you thinking about what happens if this doesn't turn out the way we want it to. How will that feel? I was talking about this with my friend, Alex Kline, who's also an only child, and she was going through something similar. We were talking about how nice it was to be only children growing up – we had all the attention, all the toys – but when you get older, and your parents are older, being an only child isn't as fun anymore. You wish you had someone there when you're dealing with the hard stuff.

I wrote "I Used To Love Him" when I was actually still in a relationship. I think I knew we were at the tail end of things, but I didn't want to admit it. He's a songwriter too and the first time I played this song for him I had to go in the bathroom while he listened to it. There are very specific details about this person in the lyrics, and I couldn't watch him hear it, but it was about processing the feeling of how I used to love someone I was still with.

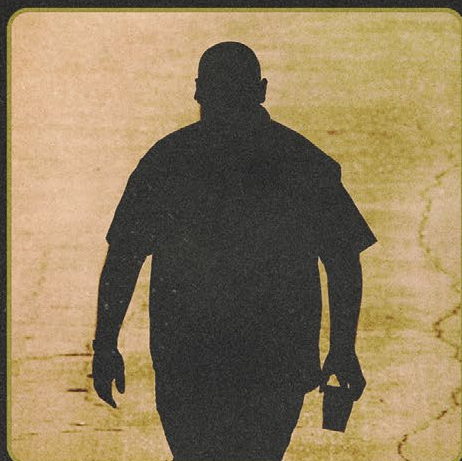
"Denim" was the last song we wrote for the record. I was getting ready for the session and my guitar was tuned down a whole step, which I don't normally do. I was just playing around and found the riff, so I brought it into the write with some lyrics I had already. I was dating someone for a while, and he really just changed overnight. I was mad at him, mad at myself for believing everything he'd told me. It can be summed up as loving a wolf in sheep's clothing, or, as we put it, a devil in denim.

Originally, I thought the album was going to be called "Music To Cry To." The title didn't end up fitting the final project, but this one's about all the sounds that you associate with a relationship that suddenly go away when something ends. Whether it's their tires in the driveway or the sound of them making coffee in the morning, the quiet that lingers when those go away becomes the music to cry to.

"Left Me Alone" is the first song I wrote coming out the other side of a relationship. In that particular situation, I made the unfortunate choice of sharing my favorite music with the person I was dating. I've loved Bob Dylan since I was born, but then it suddenly became "we love Bob Dylan." When we broke up, I couldn't listen to Bob Dylan anymore because it was so painful. One day I put my music on shuffle, and a Dylan song came on and I realized it wasn't hard to hear anymore. It was such a freeing feeling to take that first deep breath. Sometimes you go through the breakup and literally feel like you're going to die, but then one day you wake up and go "I'm ok."

sure new technology doesn't rob the world of the magical way a song can mark the moments of our lives and make us laugh, dance, cry and love."

NaSHoFamers **Vince Gill** and **Rodney Crowell** closed the night by honoring Harris. Crowell described her as "an answered prayer," while Gill performed "Boulder To Birmingham" and recalled meeting Merle Haggard the day he first sang with her, aka "the best day of my life so far." Harris called herself "an interrupter" and reminisced about once falling through the stage during Crowell's own induction years earlier. "The world needs songs," she said. "Nothing touches us more than a song that speaks to our humanity."

The evening also remembered **Troy Seals**, **Sonny Curtis** and **Brett James**, who passed since last year's ceremony. **Kenny Chesney** honored James with "When The Sun Goes Down," saying the loss "is still an open wound," but that he chose to sit in "gratitude instead of sadness."

As the night closed, the words of Bogard lingered, that "every song is like a pebble thrown into water, its ripple extending farther than we'll ever know," a fitting sentiment for a community built on stories, legacy and the unmistakable soul of Nashville songwriting.

Garth Brooks' "Friends In Low Places" came in about five minutes before my afternoon shift at WKKT/Charlotte. Garth had already blown up from "The Dance" and I listened to it one time, called Capitol head of promotion Bill Catino and said, "This is gonna be Song of the Year – maybe the biggest song of all time – and I'm playing it right now." That was 3:01pm when my shift started.

Another time, AM-FM programmers including the late/great Dene Hallam (KKBQ/Houston), Mac Daniels (WMZQ/Washington), Gregg Swedberg (KEEY/Minneapolis), Jeff Garrison (KMLE/Phoenix), Tim Closson (WUBE/Cincinnati), me (KSAN/San Francisco) and our SVP Mick Anselmo were all called in by Mercury label head Harold Shedd to hear the new Shania Twain project. He played us the video for "Man! I Feel Like A Woman" and we were all stunned. We knew immediately it was going to be beyond monstrous and added the song in heavy rotation the next day on all our stations.

• Former Top 40 WRVW/Nashville APD **Tom Peace**: Our PD, Charlie Quinn, was asking me if I'd heard anything I liked lately, and I told him the only thing I remotely was into was the theme song to the new TV show *Friends*. It was very catchy and didn't sound like a theme song to me, but I didn't know anything about it. I was videotaping the show and froze it during the credits to figure out it was The Rembrandts. I knew their music – we'd played their song "Just The Way It Is." Figuring this new song was on an album, I went looking but couldn't find it. So I took the VHS to the radio station and we tracked it. Playing it once was about 45 seconds, so we looped it, but

Charlie said it still didn't sound quite right. We added one more chorus on the end and he thought it flowed better. If I'm not mistaken, we added "I'll Be There For You" into power rotation at like 70 times a week. Charlie had people contacting him from other stations, so we mastered it down to DAT tapes and would send copies around. The label was not happy because the band had a new album in the can and this wasn't on it. But the song started blowing up and the band had to go back in the studio to record a full length version to add to the album.

[Ed. Note: Hat tip for this story to iHeart's **Gator Harrison**, who says, "So many stations were playing the VHS version that the band had to go in the studio and create a full song that they then took all the way to No. 1. It was all Tom Peace. Incredible to witness firsthand."]

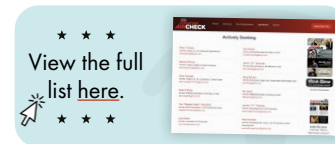

The Nielsen PPM September 2025 Survey (8/21-9/17) saw Country slip 1.3% on a same-station basis from the August survey, to 349.2 total shares. That's off 0.7% from last September. Cume was off 2.4% from 23.9 million to 23.3m; that is up 5.2% from the previous year. **WCTK/Providence** led the format for a second straight month, and the sixth time this year, with a 10.4 share.

KKBQ/Houston re-claimed the cume crown for the first time since May. Legend: A "+" indicates a Classic Country outlet; a "^" designates co-owned Country stations in the metro; a "t" indicates a tie; and a "*" indicates a station that is a recent subscriber for which ratings were not currently available. Ranks are among subscribers.

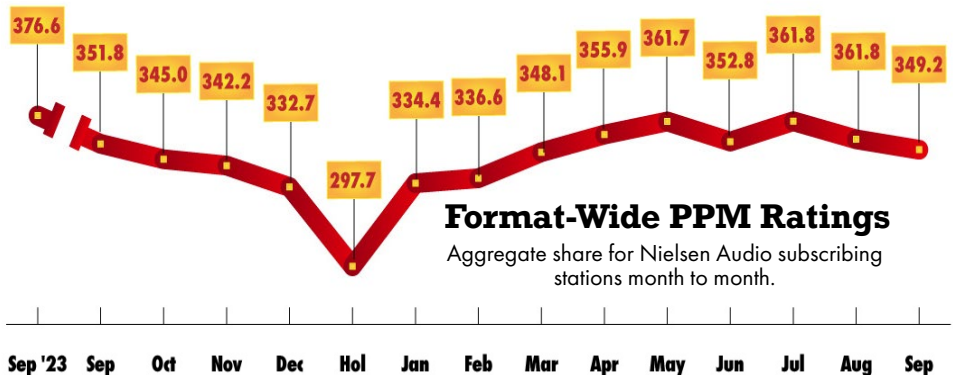

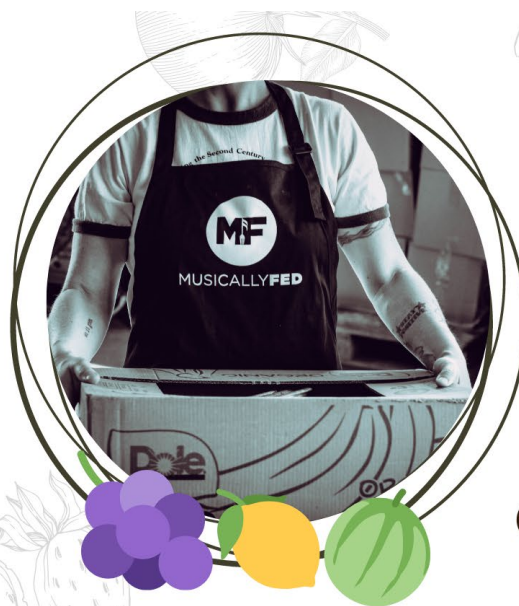

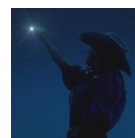
