
# What Condition My Position Was In

Once upon a time, radio stations were known simply by their call letters. Then came nicknames and, as competition increased, specific

slogans describing a station's benefits were added. The "positioning statement" was born. With the proliferation of audio sources beyond traditional AM and FM, has the positioning statement lost relevance, or is it more important than ever?



Looking at that same sample 10 years ago, 67% included geographic references, 33% referenced "New" and only 19% included "Number One." Go back 20 years, and geographic references were included in just over half the sample, while "New" and "Number One" each showed in less than 15% of positioners. Conversely, phrases like "All-Time Favorites" and quantity

positions like "12-In-A-Row" have seen their usage greatly diminished.

Beasley WXTU/Philadelphia has been consistent with the same basic position for the last 20 years – a shift from "Philadelphia's Country Station" to "Philly's Country Station" being the only change. "We are Philly, and we are Country," explains PD Mark Razz. "It says exactly what it is and what people should expect. It's by far the most important statement we can make." Citing examples like Nike's "Just Do It" and Apple's "Think Different," he adds, "Slogans are a company's impact statement, the first public communication."

One of the more unique positioners belongs to New South **WUSJ/Jackson, MS**, which adopted "Your Hometown Country" four years ago. "We felt like it would not only resonate with our listeners but was something we could deliver on," says PD **Traci Lee**. "We might not always be 'number one for this' or 'number one for that,' but we are always hometown. We can be consistent and always true to our listeners with that. We don't have to fake it.

# **Post Show Malone**

iHeartMedia KWNR/Las Vegas PD **MoJoe Roberts** was on hand Saturday (5/3) at **Post Malone** and **Jelly Roll**'s Big Ass Stadium Tour stop at
Allegiant Stadium, and he's got some tips: expect fireworks,
f-bombs and a melting pot ... both on and off the stage.

The Travelin' Tailgate was already buzzing when **Chandler Walters** hit the stage at 6:20pm, Roberts notes. By **Sierra Ferrell**'s 6:50pm slot,

"drink lines were long, and fans were still trickling in," but that didn't stop her from commanding the crowd. "Her cover of 'Me And Bobby McGee' was outstanding," says Roberts. "She had some elaborate costumes, and fans seemed to enjoy her bluegrass vibes."







Production-wise, Roberts says the angled back-of-house screens made even side-stage seats crystal clear. "They sold a lot of seats almost behind the stage, but the screens were tilted just right." The main stage features "a long, winding catwalk that looks like a twolane highway," while Post's set is framed by giant neon figures —"our own iconic Vegas Vick & Vickie" – lit up during the country numbers to "create that honky-tonk vibe." A tall staircase on the left, Roberts adds, "became Post's personal runway."

When Mr. Roll strolled onstage at 7:30pm, "he chest-thumped and soaked in the roar




Post's entrance was equally epic: "LED-lit catwalk, flares and the most fireworks I've ever seen indoors." He ran through hits from across his catalog: "Sunflower," "Congratulations" and 10 tracks from F-1 Trillion with no covers, but plenty of pyro.

Overall, "the crowd was a melting pot, singing along from hip-hop to country," Roberts says. "It was a fun musical journey – and either headliner could've filled this stadium on their own." With shows still to come, he advises: "Get there early, check out the tailgate and brace yourself for fireworks ... literally." Reach Roberts here. -Caitlin DeForest



"We are kind of a unicorn," adds Lee. "We are live and local; we want people to know this is their place to come. We care about the things they care about, shop where they shop, and we just want to be part of their lives. Everything we do goes through that filter and it's been really successful for us."

Opinions vary, however. "Positioning statements rarely mean anything to customers, especially anyone under the age of 40," says **Albright & O'Malley**

not be popular. "They are usually self-serving comfort blankets for marketing people. I don't choose my bank because they have 'the best and most money' or my grocery store because they are 'number one for frozen food.'"

While some stations avoid traditional statements and integrate their positions into their brands, like KSCS/Dallas and WKHX/Atlanta do with "New Country," others eschew them altogether.

One such station is **WTGE/Baton Rouge**. "We are '100.7 The Tiger," explains PD **Jimmy Brooks**. "There is no slogan and there is no official positioner. I used to be a huge fan of them back in the day. I mean, who didn't love saying 'Cat Country 100.7 with over 52 minutes of better country'? Now



even saying that wears me out. Listeners don't care if you play 52 minutes of music and they don't care about 'Today's Hot Country' because they resonate with the music you play, not what the talent is forced to say. In today's world of competing with streaming platforms, I believe that less is more and certainly less talk is more. I rotate over 50 stabs with different variations of my voiceover talent saying, 'The Tiger' or '100.7 The Tiger' because that is what we are."




### Ben Gallaher Bullet (Stone Country)
