Meet Beasley/Tampa's Will Calder

Former Audacy Classic Hip-Hop WPOW/Miami Dir./Programming & Operations and Hot AC sister WOMX/Orlando Brand Mgr. **Will Calder** was



named OM for Beasley's six-station Tampa cluster, including **WQYK**, last month ([Breaking News 6/11](#)). Calder's prior Florida programming roles were at then-Top 40s WPYO/Orlando and WPOI/Tampa, as well as programming, production and on-air positions at stations in New York, Milwaukee and Chicago. Find out below what "enterprise" means to him.

CA: How is the job going so far?

WC: With six stations, the first few weeks have just been getting to know the people and the building,

but everyone has been welcoming. At first it was meeting after meeting, but I'm starting to feel like I'm coming up for air, understanding the process and moving on to the strategy piece.

Tampa is a market I know because I've worked there before, so a lot of the faces I'm working with today are people I've worked across the street from, although my previous time in Tampa was during the pandemic. This is a building full of battle-tested people, because these are heritage brands that have so much respect in the market. The audience pays attention to what goes on in radio here and they participate.

What drew you to this opportunity?

This is my second time working for Beasley; the first was at Power 96 [WPOW]/Miami before the station swap with CBS Radio [in 2014]. I did two years there under the Beasleys, and got to know all the players. With this offer, I thought I'd like to go back and live in Tampa again under normal [non-pandemic] circumstances and experience it a little differently. And it just felt like the right fit.

You've worked in some major markets. What's special about Florida?

Florida was never part of the plan. But my first run there really opened my eyes to how unique the culture is, especially South Florida. Being a kid from the Midwest, getting to know Cubans, Venezuelans, Colombians – you name it – gives you a different perspective on just how to connect with people, and everyone is bilingual. That has been one of the most exciting pieces about spending time here. You always have to consider the Hispanic cultures in everything you're doing in South Florida.

One Direction, Two Lanes

Thomas Rhett and **Niall Horan** opened Rhett's *The Soundtrack To Life Tour* Thursday (7/9) at Nashville's Geodis Park, the first of two stadium dates pairing the longtime friends. The second is set for July 18 at Hersheypark Stadium in Hershey, PA.

Despite temperatures in the mid-'90s and a heat index topping 100 degrees inside the uncovered stadium, the crowd's energy rose quickly when **Emily Ann Roberts** opened with what Music Choice Dir./Country Programming **Jim Murphy** called a "too-short" 20-minute set, followed by **Kashus Culpepper**. Rhett's Middle Tennessee roots made the show a natural hometown event, but Murphy said Horan matched him in fan enthusiasm and likely won over listeners who were less familiar with his solo work.

The stage setup was notably simple for a stadium production. A thrust stage ending in a "T" extended nearly to the back of the pit, giving each performer room to connect with the front of the house. There was no B stage, video wall, stage elevator or elaborate backdrop. Instead, the show relied on two 30-foot screens flanking the stage, a deep catalog of No. 1s and the personalities of its co-headliners.

Rhett opened to dramatic music as images of his band flashed across the screens. A burst of light at the rear center of the stage faded to reveal him emerging through fog for "Make Me Wanna." Pyrotechnics accented "T-Shirt" and his solo-set closer, "Crash And Burn," but the production otherwise remained uncluttered.

"No disrespect meant for production-intensive shows, but the Rhett/Horan experience proved there's more than one way to entertain a stadium-sized crowd in 2026," says Murphy. "This was a highly engaging country experience in the most traditional way, leaning heavily on big hit songs and the talent and personality of the headliners."

One of Murphy's biggest takeaways was learning more about Horan's relationship with Nashville's songwriting and recording communities. Horan made his *Grand Ole Opry* debut two nights earlier, with Rhett joining him onstage, further underscoring his connection to country music.

The collaboration extended beyond sharing the bill. Both artists spoke during their solo sets about a friendship stretching back more than a decade, then reunited for a five-song encore that highlighted their chemistry. They explained how the songs were selected, including Ella Langley's "Choosin' Texas," chosen because they thought it would be fun and quirky for two men to sing together.

The encore closed with duets on Rhett's "Die A Happy Man" and Horan and One Direction's "Steal My Girl," capping a night in which much of the audience sang along to nearly every word. Reach Murphy [here](#). —Caitlin DeForest

Pawn Stars

When you reach the level of stardom **Tim McGraw** has achieved, sometimes all you have to do to launch a concert is stroll onstage without bells and whistles. That's a moment WGTU/York, PA OM/PD **Scott Donato** calls "one of the biggest surprises of the night" when he caught the July 11 Hersheypark Stadium show during opening weekend of McGraw's *Pawn Shop Guitar Tour*.

"McGraw, a multigenerational superstar, simply walked out onstage with his band, waved to the crowd, showed off his specially made 'Chicks' tour shirt, and started singing 'Forget About Us,' an album cut that I hadn't heard in years," Donato recalls.

"The first six songs of his set were acoustic, something you almost never see at the front of the show in an arena, let alone a small stadium," says Donato, noting that it "created a very intimate feel as he reeled off a bunch of his beloved songs, including 'Just To See You Smile,' 'Down On The Farm' and 'Where The Green Grass Grows.' Once

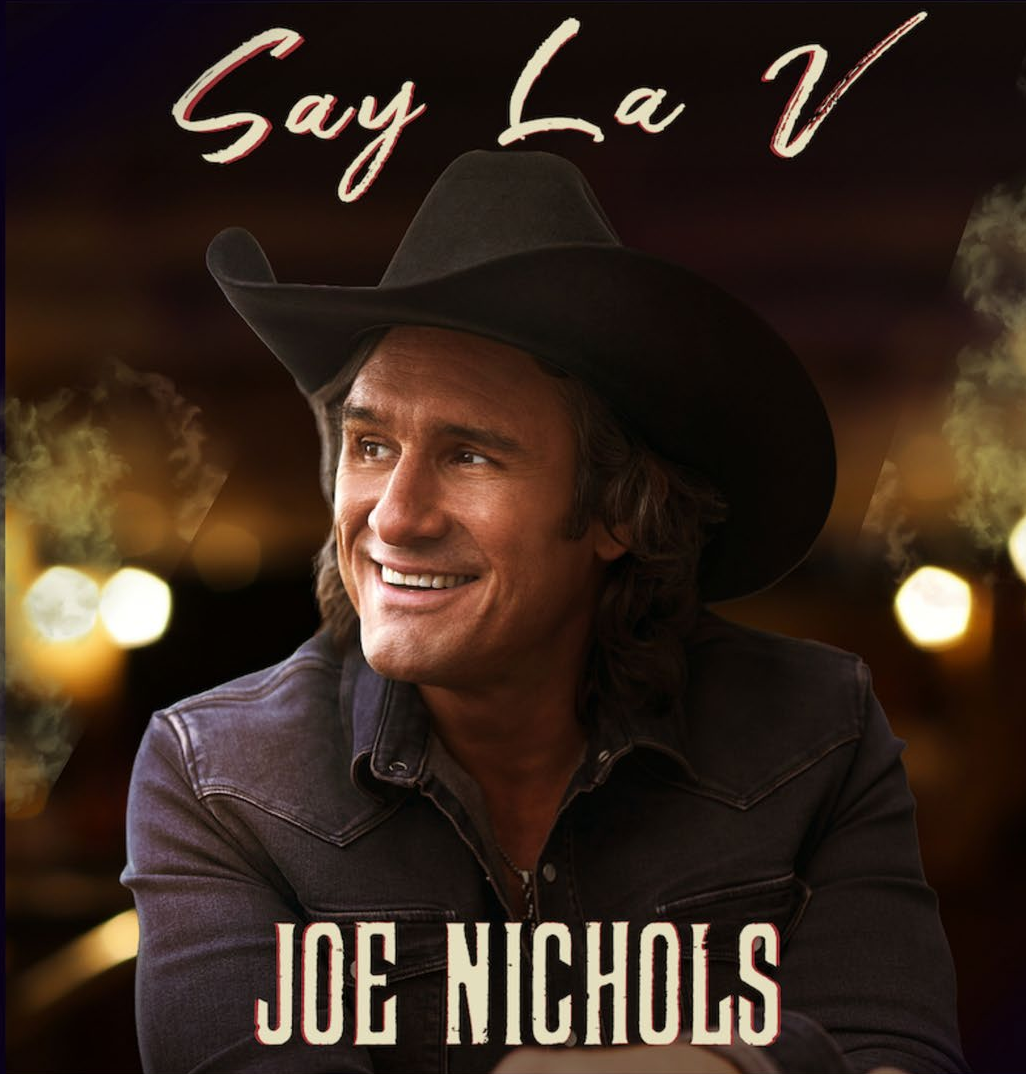

the lights went down after 'Don't Take The Girl,' the stage went black, and transitioned into a full band, full production bonanza, as Tim kicked that segment off with 'Real Good Man' to a stage that seemed literally on fire."

As McGraw's t-shirt indicated, support acts for the show included The Chicks, as well as Lady A, Timothy Wayne and 49 Winchester. Donato says, "The Chicks' set was phenomenal, and featured a mix of classics and more recent material. It seemed like everyone was singing every word of 'Travelin' Soldier,' 'Wide Open Spaces' and 'Landslide.' But nothing compared to their swan song, 'Goodbye Earl,' which had the crowd in a frenzy. You can probably assume that a lot of the crowd hadn't seen The Chicks in a while, but they were welcomed back with open arms."

Donato also calls Lady A's set "fantastic," and notes that they returned to the stage later in the night to perform "I Like It, I Love It" with McGraw. After the show, Donato heard from several listeners that seeing McGraw, The Chicks and Lady A in succession "was like seeing three headliners in a row."

While he says "I Like It, I Love It" got the biggest crowd response, Donato thinks "Live Like You Were Dying" provided "a huge moment, especially listening to every soul singing along. Tim also spent time on his two newest songs, and even though they weren't familiar with everyone, the crowd was eating up the video montage that accompanied 'Pawn Shop Guitar,' which featured a slew of footage of a very young McGraw. Shortly after sharing a story about one of his starter guitars when he moved to Nashville in 1989, he sought out a young musician in the crowd and presented her with a brand-new guitar of her own."

The show closed with "Humble And Kind" and "Truck Yeah." And while Donato says McGraw has had far too many hits to fit them all into one show, he still provided "the ultimate fan experience. Based on the hundreds of [listener] comments on our social media, this show was a highlight of their summer."

original Hot 102 [WLUM]/Milwaukee and B96 [WBBM]/Chicago. Those stations not only made me fall in love with music, but also inspired me to become a nightclub DJ, which I've been doing since the '90s. I always loved that connection that radio had, the ability to create a shared experience for thousands of people at the same time. And I loved figuring out what made people listen.

My first job was at a Dance station in Chicago, Energy 92.7/5 [trimulcast WKIE/WKIF/WDEK]. It was owned by Big City Radio, and in the late '90s was auctioned off to SBS. I was just an intern and was having so much fun, but the new owner firing everybody quickly made me realize this is a business. You can have all the fun in the world, but people still want their money!

Is the Country format new to you?

While doing Country doing day to day is new for me, there are fundamentals that great brands are built on, regardless of format. It's understanding your audience, creating that emotional connection, building great talent and staying relentlessly focused on your listeners. [WQYK] morning hosts J.R. [Jaus], Launa [Stringfield] and Kevin [Ebel] have been walking me through what really makes the Country listener in Tampa click. It's been a lot of fun learning from them, and also sharing my knowledge when it comes to strategy and building great radio. Country is a lot like Top 40 used to be, where it's all about relationships. That's why I'm really excited about getting into this space day-to-day.

What are your first priorities for WQYK?

The Tampa cluster is in an excellent position. My job is not to come in and break things, it's to elevate everything they were already doing. Of course, we'll sit down and kick the tires on strategies here and there, but it's a great sounding radio station. I just want to put my fingerprints on it to elevate it, not change it.

What do your fingerprints typically look like?

It starts with understanding the audience, listening to the talent, listening to the data but also trusting your instincts, balancing the art with the science. The best radio stations know exactly who they are and execute that identity consistently day after day.

One of my strengths is being able to present a roadmap to my talent so we're going into this with the same understanding. But we're all learning things every day from each other, including from the brand ambassadors who are out on the street, putting up the tents and spinning the prize wheel, or whatever that looks like in 2026 and beyond. We all have different touch points that connect with the community.

How will you define your success over the next six- to 12 months?

Does my team feel like they made a difference? Does the audience feel that difference? Are we making them feel something to the point they'll pull out their pocketbook and spend money with our clients and partners? Are we moving the needle with ratings and revenue? That's how I'll define my success.

What would you like the country music industry to know about you?

I am a firm believer in communication and understanding, and I will always have my door open and my phone on for people that want to make that connection. I'm kind of a quirky dude, but it's what helps me connect with people from all different walks of life. I like to understand people's goals and strategize together. And I enjoy radio when we all feel like we're having fun.

Any Will Calder fun facts to share?

I'm still active as a disco club DJ once a month on Sunday nights. It gives me another touch point with the audience and a way to see how trends are moving. I also grew up on *Star Trek: The Next Generation*. Last year they re-built the Enterprise-D set at Universal in California. I immediately booked tickets out there and had an emotional moment standing on that bridge. So, if you want to talk *Star Trek*, I'm a big geek and will do that, but it has to be Picard's Enterprise, not the original series.

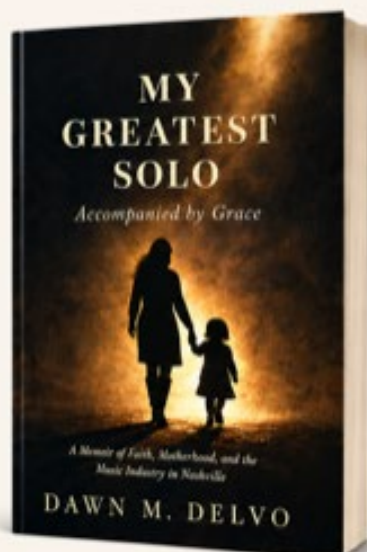
