Fest Practices: Nissan Recaps

Stadium show highlights from nights two, three and four of CMA Fest 2024; see Thursday's recap here:

• No End In Night: Friday night (6/7) at CMA Fest offered an electric



mix of headlining artists and new faces for fans gathered at Nissan Stadium. Gretchen Wilson opened with, appropriately, "Here For The Party" and debuted "Little Miss Runner Up," which she described as a sequel to 2004's "Homewrecker."

Parker McCollum also shared new music. performing "Big Ol' Fancy House" among his string of hits: "To Be Loved By You," "Pretty Heart"

and "Handle On You." Before closing with "Burn It Down," he said, "I will remember tonight for as long as I live."

Jon Pardi's energetic set featured "Heartache On The Dance Floor," "Night Shift" and "Head Over Boots." He welcomed fellow Texan Clint Black to join him on "Killin' Time."

Kelsea Ballerini recalled attending the festival as a fan and waiting in line to meet her favorite

artists. Friday, her own fans sang along with "Love Me Like You Mean It," "Dibs" and "If You Go Down (I'm Going Down Too)."

Cody Johnson encouraged the audience to light up the stadium with



their cell phones for his performance of "Dirt Cheap." He covered Charlie Daniels' "Long Haired Country Boy" and brought out **Jelly Roll** to duet on "Whiskey Bent." He wrapped the set with "'Til You Can't," and told the audience, "'I'm so thankful this is my very first No. 1. I want you to help me sing this at the top of your lungs."

Luke Bryan took the stage around midnight, opening with "That's My Kind Of Night" and proceeding to entertain with

"Huntin', Fishin' And Lovin' Every Day," "Country Girl (Shake It For Me)" and "I Don't Want This Night To End." -Sarah Skates

The Legend Of WBEE's Billy Kidd

Audacy WBEE/Rochester APD/MD and afternoon host Billy Kidd recently celebrated 40 years on air in the market. He shares memories with

Country Aircheck, starting with a celebratory show on May 24, and a surprise video shown at the station's May 22 Stars & Guitars show (watch here).

It was a lot of fun walking down memory lane. People were calling in about stuff I did with them and for them that had completely left my brain. It was all very sweet. Nobody called in to say what a jerk I was.

Terry Clifford came out of retirement to be on the air and talk about how I interned for her and worked as a board op back in 1984 as a




squeaky voiced high school student who never got (continued on page 5)

her the right mix of coffee. She reminded me how my mom used to drop me off at the front door of the station, and asked Terry to walk me out to the car every day because I was so young.

At Stars & Guitars, they showed a video with Jason Aldean, Keith Urban, Kane Brown, Russell Dickerson and other artists saying congratulations. I'm the guy who usually organizes things like that, so for them to pull it off without me knowing was crazy. Some of the artists onstage talked about how supportive I've been of their careers – it was very emotional. To have people who've made it look at you and say, "Thank you for the help you gave me years ago" was very gratifying.

I may have the only photographs of the moment in Orchard Park when Kenny Chesney and Tim McGraw got arrested [during the 2000 police horse incident]. We were backstage for a George Strait meet-and-greet. The second he walked into the room, a bunch of sirens went off and security said, "Everybody's gotta go," and pushed us back into the stadium. As we're walking, I had a disposable camera over my head, backwards. I snapped five pictures, and you can see the cop car that Tim was sitting in. You can see the horse that Kenny was accused of stealing. You can see Ray Benson from Asleep at the Wheel standing there talking to 50 cops. Don't think I didn't think about trying to call the National Enquirer with that. [laughs] I did blow up the picture and give it to Kenny years later.

Another artist, who I won't name, but who had a couple of hits in the '90s/early 2000s came through town and played me a new song that was a smash. I think we were the first station to put it in rotation, and it went on to become a No. 1. He called to thank me at 3:00 in the morning, so drunk he could barely talk, and offered to buy me a Harley. I'm like, "I can't even have this conversation." Even in his drunken state he said, "I'm not a record label, so I could buy you one." I declined, and the next day he called me back and said, "Did I call you last night, because I have a 13-minute call on my phone that I don't remember making."

Taylor Swift played one of our *Stars & Guitars* shows when she was 14 or 15. At the time, she said it was the biggest crowd she's played for – 2,500 people. We see a lot of artists come and go, but you could tell there was something special about her. Backstage, she wasn't asking other artists about stuff you think a 14-year-old girl would be into. She was asking very pointed business questions. It's crazy to think about where she is now, but it all makes sense when you follow it back to that.

I've sometimes wondered if I was missing something by staying in the same market my whole career. Could I be in a bigger market and making more money? Probably, but I never had any interest in chasing a paycheck. This company has treated me really well. I didn't feel it was necessary to uproot and change markets every couple years because I love my life. I'm surrounded by my friends and family. I'm still in the same town I grew up in. It's crazy that people that I went to high school with hear me on the radio, text in and hit me up on the station Facebook page.

I'm hoping to do this for maybe another 14 years and then call it a day, but I love what I do. It's not like I've had the same job for 40 years. It has changed dramatically from the day I stepped in that building to where we are now. In the old days, you got hired to be on the air and that's all you did. Now, I do an air shift, social media, produce videos, help book concerts, create events and do marketing. I don't know that I'd still be doing it if it hadn't changed. There are so many challenges and opportunities to learn. Radio's still fun. Meeting listeners, connecting with people and hearing their stories is why radio is special.

Congratulations to **Jelly Roll (Jason DeFord), Adrian Michaels, Shelly Hargis, Scotty O'Brien** and the **Stoney Creek** promotion team on taking "Halfway To Hell" to No. 1. Two weeks ago, **Bailey Zimmerman** became the 13th artist in history to launch a career with four consecutive No. 1s; Jelly Roll is now No. 14. The song's 9,640 spins this week is the second highest total in Mediabase history, topped only by the



9,753 spins for Nate Smith's "World On Fire" earlier this year. Songwriters are **Jesse Frasure**, **Matt Jenkins**, **Jessie Jo Dillon** and DeFord.

Kudos to **Stacy Blythe** and the **Big Loud** crew on racking up 82 adds for **Hardy**'s "Six Feet Under (Caleigh's Song)" to lead the CA/MB Add Board. It's his third release to do so.

WBYT/South Bend, IN has been temporarily removed from the Activator panel this week due to technical issues.

Princess Cruise Line is the "official cruise line sponsor" for the **Academy of Country Music**. The partnership kicked off on the red carpet at last month's ACM Awards, and will continue with the August 21 ACM Honors. Princess will also be the presenting sponsor for the ACM Live from the Red Barrel Lounge series at the Academy's Nashville office this summer, featuring performances from emerging country artists, some of whom will be invited to perform on future cruises.

Mickey Guyton has added openers **Abbey Cone** and **Denitia** to her 22-city CMT On Tour Presents Mickey Guyton, which kicks off Sept. 18 in Atlanta (<u>CAT 4/29</u>). Tickets <u>here</u>.

The music specials Still Playin' Possum: Music & Memories of George Jones and All-Star Salute To Lee Greenwood each won three trophies at the 45th annual Telly Awards May 21. The Jones special won a gold statue for Best Music Performance, and bronze for Best Entertainment Program and Best Live Event & Experience. The Greenwood special won "non-broadcast" silver (Best Music Performance) and two bronze (Best Live Event & Experience and Best Entertainment Program).

Artist **Alexandra Kay** has partnered with outdoor furniture cushion brand **Arden** to launch the <u>"Favorites" collection</u> in several patterns.

 Wild Forces: Saturday (6/8) seemed to be Lainey Wilson night, as the reigning CMA Entertainer showed up in several sets. **Old**







Dominion, Keith Urban and Jelly Roll weren't about to cede the evening's title, however.

Opener **Terri Clark** ran through several of her hits, among them a crowd singalong of "Better Things To Do." She told the audience her first time at the event was 1987 "when it was still called Fan Fair." She joked, "I was three." She returned during Wilson's set for a duet of "Poor, Poor Pitiful Me."


The War And Treaty's performance was highlighted by new song "Called You By Your Name," and their wardrobe was punctuated by Michael Trotter, **Jr.**'s vest – emblazoned on the back with the words, "Pride Like

Charley." Platform stage performers were **Tanner Adell** ("Buckle Bunny") and Dylan Marlowe ("Boys Back Home"). The latter thanked the crowd for not leaving to get a hot dog. On the lower level main stage, Brittney **Spencer** performed a line-dance accompanied version of "I Got Time."

Old Dominion's hit-driven set only backed off the tempo for "One Man Band." They drew an audience assist on vocals with "Snapback" and brought things to an aggressively performed closing with "Memory Lane." Wilson opened with current single "Hang Tight Honey" and introduced "Country's Cool Again" by saying, "The whole world knows about country, y'all, and I'm loving every single minute of it." She ended with "Wildflowers And Wild Horses."

Exhibiting a perhaps underrated gift for presence, Urban acknowledged and thanked the evening's hosts - **Ashley McBryde** and Mr. Roll - as



- 2. "Clockworks," Inspired by my grandpa, "Clockworks" is about those moments when you feel life is moving too fast, and you forget to live in the moment. There have been times when I sat there and said, "Lord, I had it really good when I had it. I wish I could live that again."
- 3. "Weather In Tennessee," About a guy who can't make up his mind. Like the weather in Tennessee, it was always so back-and-forth, up and down, drastically flipping from sunshine to storm clouds at any given moment.
- 4. "Ain't About You," I wrote "Ain't About You" by myself a few years ago when nothing was going on for me in Nashville. I was asking God, "Is this what I am supposed to do? Is this my purpose?" I sat down in the floor and wrote this song in 45 minutes. I call it my 45-minute conversation with Jesus. It was supposed to be my leaving Nashville song, but it ended up being my staying in Nashville song.
- 5. "Bad Boy," About my questionable taste in men. If there is a mean-looking one in the corner ... he's got my attention. If he has tattoos, jaded, looks like he has a back story, I can fix him. If he looks like an extra on the Sons of Anarchy, I am all in. The flag is green to me. This was one of my favorite songs to write because it's so different from anything you've heard from me yet!
- 6. "Pretty Much," My own journey of being comfortable with myself. Growing up, you're always worried about what you look like and trying to be perfect. I feel like every girl has felt that way: insecure, worried. This song is for every girl who has ever felt like they weren't enough or didn't feel like they were pretty enough. I felt so empowered writing, "Who the hell decided what pretty was?" There are so many definitions of pretty, and I don't know why we thought it was this perfect complexion on social media with these filters that hide everything. That's not pretty. It's who you are as a person. It's your heart.

well as each area of the audience and CMA Fest volunteers. He brought Wilson back for "Go Home W U" and ran off into the audience during closer "Long Hot Summer" – perhaps without warning, if the chaos that ensued was any indication.

Finally, it was Nashville native Mr. Roll staking his claim to Nissan, noting, "My father brought me here 23 years ago when the Tennessee Titans came to town" and asserting his lifelong dream of playing the venue. He brought Urban on to accompany "Halfway To Hell" and, when he played "Save Me" – who joined but, of course, Wilson. – Chuck Aly

• Wear It Ends: Opening the close, Josh Turner was "Heatin' Things Up" with his new song, but also offered hits "Firecracker," "Your Man" and "Long Black Train." Graduated from last year's platform stage



performance, **Megan Moroney** sang "I'm Not Pretty," "Tennessee Orange" and new release "Man On The Moon." Noting she'd had her brother play with her during prior CMAF performances "because he was free," she invited him to join her onstage for "Indifferent."

This year on the platform stage, **Zach Top** did solo acoustic renditions of his single "Sounds Like The Radio" and "Use Me." **Wyatt Flores**' two songs were "Please Don't Go" and "Holes." And **Jackson Dean** offered a satellite stage version of "Fearless."

Brothers Osborne's **TJ Osborne** took the time to acknowledge an unsung star of this year's event – near perfect weather. "Break Mine" and "I'm Not For Everyone" set up "Stay A Little Longer," driven by **John Osborne**'s guitar solos. "It Ain't My Fault" had the crowd clapping in unison before the duo segued into Don Williams' "Tulsa Time."

Addressing the crowd, **Carly Pearce** said of her *Fan Fair* history, "Literally 34 years of dreams have gotten me to this stage." She opened her set with "Rock, Paper, Scissors" and added "Next Girl," "We Don't Fight

Anymore" and "I Hope You're Happy Now."

Echoing the CMAF journey stories of Pearce and Moroney, **Bailey Zimmerman** added, "I will always cherish this moment with you – right here, right now." His set included "Religiously," "Holy Smokes" and "Where It Ends," and he got the crowd's phone lights going with "Rock And A Hard Place." The latter ended with a spoken word breakdown as Zimmerman praised God, begged to be asked back next year, signed his hat and shoes, and threw them into the audience.

"Rockstar" wasn't just the first song for CMA
Fest's final performer, **Hardy**. It was his theme.
"Jack," "Psycho" and "Truck Bed" were among
the songs that led him to flatly say, "Thank you
for banging heads with us tonight." But he also
slowed things down for new song "Six Feet Under
(Caleigh's Song)," and brought out guests **Big &**Rich ("Save A Horse"), Pearce ("Wait In The Truck")
and Lauren Alaina ("One Beer"). —Chuck Aly






