# **Ultimate Honor For Harris, Stoneman**

Last night's Country Music Hall of Fame Medallion Ceremony inducting **Emmylou Harris** and **Ernest "Pop" Stoneman** proved once again why this event has become Music City's best night. Surveying the assembled celebrants, songwriter **Jim Lauderdale** remarked at one point, "Undoubtedly, this is the highest concentration of greatness in the universe."

Making Sunday night especially remarkable was the juxtaposition of the two artists and their music – the Stoneman family's mountain/bluegrass roots and Harris' pop-rock-folk infused Country that blazed new trails for the genre. It's an amazing format that welcomes both artists under one umbrella.

The Stoneman ceremony was more family reunion than induction. Daughters **Patsy** (the eldest at 83), **Roni** and **Donna** led a large brigade of grandchildren and great grandchildren. On autoharp, banjo and mandolin respectively, the women were joined by **Cowboy Jack Clement** for Stoneman's 1925 hit, "The Titantic." Clement returned to sing Stoneman's "Blue Ridge Mountain Blues."

The musical tribute to Stoneman concluded with **Jim Lauderdale** and the Hall of Fame **Jordanaires** singing the hymn, "Are You Washed In The Blood." Patsy, with her father's Hall of Fame Medallion around her neck, said it all on behalf of the family: "This is the biggest thing that's happened since water."

The biggest issue was getting 10 ISDN lines run to Vassar's expansive residence where, as of a celebratory meal and short performance last night, tables stacked with remote equipment were lodged in seemingly every corner. A partnership with the Nashville Convention & Visitor's Bureau helped defray costs via donations from Southwest Airlines and Holiday Inn. Carl Black Chevrolet provided cars.

Vassar, who faced a 4am-7pm schedule, and his radio invitees provided fun. "Everybody releases albums the same way," says US VP/Promotion **Teddi Bonadies**. "The satellite tour, the radio tour, a few shows. We wanted to find a way to entertain listeners and do good radio. Phil really loves radio and radio certainly loves him. They bought into the idea instantly."

a show in Kandahar, Afghanistan. Moving on to Iraq, Keith performed for several thousand soldiers at Camp Liberty in Baghdad -- perhaps his largest show ever in the region.

Most recently, Keith's 18-show tour has been bogged down as much of Iraq was enveloped by a massive sand storm. His agent, Paradigm's **Curt Motley**, reports that Keith and company were stuck in Fallujah for 36 hours. "We were covered with dirt and dust, even in our rooms," Motley says. "We're covered in a fine, moon dust-like powder and the hallways appear to be smoking because there's so much dust and dirt in the air." Motley reports that the temperature gauge in one of their escort vehicles read 131 degrees in direct sunlight.

Clark told the crowd he didn't think he contributed anything to the song, but was more a "cheerleader" as Harris came up with line after line.

An amazing quintet including former band members **Sam Bush** and Buddy Miller, along with Patty Griffin, **Vince Gill** and **Jon Randall** followed with "Green Pastures" from Harris' landmark 1980 LP, *Roses In The Snow.* During her remarks, Harris revealed how in awe she was of the honor, closing by quoting Minnie Pearl, "I'm so proud to be here."

The night ended in what has become tradition, with all of Hall of Famers in attendance on stage singing, "Will The Circle Be Unbroken." **Tom T. Hall** and the **Statler Bros.**, who were on hand for last night's event, will be inducted in a ceremony set for June 29.




