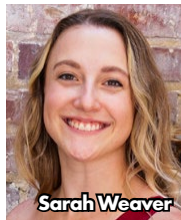

MIW: Ment(or) To Be

The first two women selected for the **Mentoring and Inspiring Women in Radio (MIW)** Country Radio Mentorship – Beasley/Fayetteville, NC OM

and WKML PD/morning host **Sarah Weaver** and KSON/San Diego MD and morning show Exec. Producer **Jessica Chenoweth** – didn't just go through the program. They used it as a turning point.

When Weaver applied, she was more than a decade into radio and already working as a PD. One of her biggest mentors was VP/Brand Strategies and Augusta & Fayetteville, NC Regional OM Tee Gentry, who encouraged her to take ownership of the station and advocated for her throughout her career. And on paper, she was established. In reality, she felt stuck. "I had goals of being an OM, but I didn't have a plan of execution," she says. "I needed guidance and, quite honestly, I needed support."

Chenoweth's turning point looked different. After 20 years in radio, she had achieved her original goal, but was asking herself a bigger question. "When I started, I just wanted to be a producer on a morning show, and I got it," she says. "Then it's like, okay, what's

next?" Both found their answer in the same place.

In Through The Out Door: The program's structure is simple but intentional. Each participant is paired with an experienced industry leader while also gaining access to a broader network of executives across programming, sales and digital. For Weaver, that meant monthly one-on-one conversations focused on leadership, operations and self-advocacy. "You get out of it what you put into it," she says. "For me, it was learning more about the sales side, leadership tactics and how to advocate for myself and my team."

Chenoweth had a similarly hands-on experience, meeting with a range of mentors across disciplines, led by primary mentor Becky Brenner (for Albright & O'Malley & Brenner) and including industry leaders like KKBQ/Houston APD/MD Lauren "Lo" Sessions. "I met with people from marketing, programming, music and digital," she says. "It really expanded my horizons and helped me learn parts of the industry I hadn't been exposed to before."

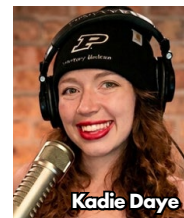

Meet SuiteRadio's Beanie Queen

In a world where major market talent typically gets the nod for syndication opportunities, **SuiteRadio's** decision to build a national show around **WLJE/Valparaiso, IN** morning host **Kadie Daye** (CAT 3/18) was surprising. Since debuting March 30, *The Kadie Daye Show* – available up to five hours a day, six days a week for multiple formats – has picked up six affiliates, including Country **KIKX/Maui, HI** and Country/Americana **WAMM-AM/W25OCR**, serving Virginia's Shenandoah Valley.

Daye hosts the new show from her bedroom in her hometown of Valparaiso, having joined WLJE parent Adams Radio/Northwest Indiana last year ([CAT 4/3/25](#)) after three years as morning co-host at WYRK/Buffalo and two years closer to home at Top 40 WNDV/South Bend, IN. She also hosts middays on AC sister WZVN. **Country Aircheck** recently got to know the talent being marketed as a “storyteller in a sock hat”:

I was drawn to radio at eight years old when my parents got a divorce. I was in my mom’s car listening to all the Chicago radio stations and I heard Angi Taylor [then morning co-host on Top 40 WKSC] talking about divorce, and I felt seen and heard. It was the first time I saw someone become a voice for the voiceless, and I knew I wanted to connect with and for other people in that way, even if I’ve never met them. From that point on, I became obsessed with radio. I knew all the personalities by name, had all the jingles memorized and would sing along with the imaging in the car. I used to actually change the station when music came on.

As a senior in high school, I went to the campus station at Valparaiso University and knocked on the glass until someone made eye contact with me. Even though I wasn’t a student there, they let me host the 7pm to midnight show three days a week because nobody else wanted to do it. I went on to study broadcasting at Goshen College.

When I lost my WYRK job in a round of budget cuts in 2024, SuiteRadio’s Rowdy Yates reached out and gave me some words of encouragement. He’s in the Country Radio Hall of Fame, so his words really made me believe in myself at a time I was feeling a little defeated. I couldn’t believe he even knew who I was, but I kept in touch, sent him airchecks and would ask for advice. He played one for the people at SuiteRadio and they loved it. They had me do some mock shows, and it turned into this cool thing. I was just in shock. If I’d seen an opening for this job, I don’t know that I’d have even had had the courage to apply. But like Wayne Gretzky said, “You miss 100% of the shots you don’t take.” I’m appreciative that Rowdy believes in me. He is a good teacher.

A lot of new technologies like ChatGPT might help people prep, but AI cannot live your life experiences. That’s the thing that sets you apart from everyone else, and the thing that sets great DJs apart from each other. That’s why it’s so important to be authentic, because that’s your spunk. That’s when the you comes out. If you’re you, people will recognize that and feel like you’re a friend on the radio and that you understand them.

I have an insane amount of beanies, and I keep getting more. I have to have them in every color, and just can’t have enough. Sometimes I even wear them to sleep. I don’t remember why I started doing the beanie thing, probably because I wanted to be on the radio so bad that I paid attention to how the personalities looked and what they wore. I saw a lot of people in headphones and beanies, so I just made it my thing. Beanies and red lipstick, that’s my image.

Don Schlitz was not much of a gambler, despite writing the quintessential gambling song. One of his rare forays into table games came around 1993, I would guess, when the CMA was holding its Board of Directors meetings in a hotel that was attached to a casino. One night after dinner Don asked me if I would teach him to play craps. With the admonition that craps lessons could be expensive, we bellied up to the green felt monster.

Not long after we began rollin’ d’em, snake eyes came up and the stickman started singing, “You got to know when to hold ‘em, know when to fold ‘em.” I shot a hopeful look at Don, and he just shook his head “no.” I was disappointed, but we moved on. Seconds later, Big Red (aka the number seven) showed up, and as he took our chips, a dealer finished the verse, “Know when to walk away and know when to run.”

This time I gave Don a desperate look and whispered “Pleeeeeease. This will never happen again in our entire lives.” He shrugged, and grudgingly nodded. I was as giddy as a kid at being able to tell the

dealers and the handful of railbirds that in their midst and countin’ his money at this very craps table was indeed the sole writer of “The Gambler.” No one believed me, but a driver’s license later ended up with a dozen autographs on casino chips.

That exposure translated into something both women say they had been missing in different ways: confidence. Weaver says one of the biggest shifts was learning how to make her work visible. "I've never been the 'look at me' type," she says. "But I had to manage up. I had to make sure leadership knew what I was doing and how I was stepping up beyond my role."

For Chenoweth, the shift was similar. "As a producer, I was always pushing my morning show forward. I never really pushed myself forward," she says. "This gave me the confidence to network and put myself out there."

Her confidence showed up in a very real way at CRS '26. Chenoweth admits attending the seminar for the first time could have been (very) intimidating. Instead, it became a highlight. "I think it was the best week of my career," she says. "I wasn't intimidated. I felt comfortable in the space and like I was actually part of the industry." Weaver points to a similar benefit: access to people and perspectives she would not have otherwise had. "Where else can you have someone focused solely on helping you achieve your goals?" she says.

Growth Through Sharing: In both cases, the growth was not just internal – it led to tangible career movement. During her time in the

program, Weaver was promoted to OM, a goal she had entered the mentorship hoping to reach. Chenoweth followed a parallel path. After beginning training in music scheduling, she was named MD at KSON earlier this year. Mentorship conversations helped her navigate both the technical and instinctual sides of the role. "I was able to ask other music directors what they look for, how they make decisions and when to trust your gut," she says. "That was huge."

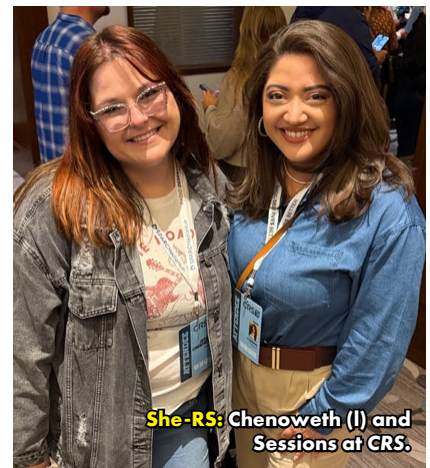
Both say their experiences also reinforced a larger reality about working in radio as women. Weaver recalls a moment early in her career when a listener asked if she was busy refilling her male co-host's coffee. Chenoweth says that even after two decades, she still sometimes feels underestimated. "I think it takes a little bit longer for us to get ahead," Chenoweth says. Weaver agrees that while progress has been made, gaps remain, particularly in programming roles.

Even so, both point to the growing network of women supporting each other as a sign of meaningful change. "There's such a strong community of women in Country radio right now," Chenoweth says. "And this program is a big part of that."

Looking back, both say they would encourage others to take the same step. "This is a chance to invest in yourself," Weaver says.
