

Radio: ACMs Are Best In Years

Broadcasters largely liked what they saw on the May 8 60th Academy of Country Music Awards, which streamed live on Prime Video from Frisco,

outstanding representation of country music. You could see the artists enjoying themselves in front of their peers in a way we hadn't seen before. The passion for country music was shining brightly."

WHKO/Dayton PD/MD Nancy Wilson also "loved" the show, and says, "My big takeaway was how they married veteran superstars with today's stars. The tribute to Alan Jackson, Reba McEntire hosting, and a huge number of the artists who performed learned from their pioneers and paved the way for today's artists. It was like passing the mantle to the younger artists."

WXCY/Wilmington, DE PD Charlie Maxx says, "The performances were the real highlight for me. Like most people, I bawled my eyes out watching Alan Jackson. Growing up on so many of his songs and then getting to see his life pass before our eyes was magical!

"Loved seeing the ladies take front and center," Maxx continues. "Kelsea Ballerini crushed it, Megan Moroney's Keith Urban tribute was on point, and can we talk Reba, Miranda [Lambert] and Lainey [Wilson]? Fun! Plus, add another few wins for Lainey. Dare I say it's a 'Pink Pony Club' at the moment in country music?"

Agrees WQMX/Akron PD Sarah Kay, "I loved that it was ladies night! Seeing the same women win multiple awards was refreshing, and also seeing Lainey,



2025 Q1 PPM Drivetime Leaders

Following the release of the March Nielsen PPM monthlies, Country Aircheck has analyzed Q1 numbers to determine the stations with leading shares and cumes in drivetimes. Quarterly averages eliminate the wobbles that can be present at a daypart level on a month-to-month basis. All figures are Persons 6+.

Mornings: The Q Morning Show with Andy "Riggs" Riggle, Katelyn Maida and Erica Rico gives KKBQ/Houston the largest cume in the format, as it has for the past year, with 354,200. WUSN/ Chicago and KSCS/Dallas swap the second and third place positions, with Melissa & Austin's 342,100 outpacing Hawkeye In The Morning's 277,500. Several new names debut in the top 10: fourth place KILT/ Houston's Tucker "Frito" Young and Katy Dempsey took over mornings there in January, while fifth place KKGO/Los Angeles' Bruce Scott started in March. Additionally, Niko Petrou joined incumbent



OFF THE RECORD

Mercury's **Bryce Leatherwood** shares the stories behind his self-titled, debut album:

"In Lieu of Flowers" is a song that just feels like '90s country. It reminds me of the sound I grew up listening to, and that's a big reason I decided to put this one at the top of the album ... so the listener knows what they are in for. It was written by Jacob Davis, Adam Craig, and Matt McKinney, and it felt like the perfect track to kick things off. Rather than a teary-eyed eulogy, just request



some Joe Diffie and a longneck toast when your time finally comes—something about turning that sad thought into a celebration of the moment sets the tone for everything that follows.

Written by Justin Wilson, Jennifer Wayne, and Trent Tomlinson, "What If She Does" is about love and the fear of losing it. I wanted songs that really challenged me, both vocally and as a performer, for this project, and this song does just that. The power and emotion of this song made it a must-have for the album. I loved the bluesy vibe and the electric guitar. It really creates this ache and a sort of slow-motion swirl of chaotic emotion just before the moment of no return. Imagining what it would be like to let love go and watch it move on without you ... heartbreaking!

It wouldn't be a country album if I didn't record a cheating song — you don't get more classic than that! **"Cheap Cologne"** was written by Jimmy Ritchey, Kevin Denney and Odie Blackmon, and I love how it channels so many of my classic country heroes. It is a really vibey, done-me-wrong kind of anthem. It has that timeless two-step presentation, straight out of country's golden era, but with a twist: it finds the not-so-smart player getting caught in the act. I loved that!

"Shenandoah" was the first song I wrote that I truly believed was meant for this album. I wrote this one with Jeffrey East and Josh Kelley about love and total romantic devotion. The production really captures those swells of emotion with these gorgeous string-and-steel elements. It kind of has this soaring, songbird melody that gives it this majestic feeling ... the same feeling you might have enjoying a breathtaking view of the Blue Ridge Mountains or gazing at the one you love. I hope folks take a piece of this song and carry it with them.

Cheyenne Davis in January on KMLE/Phoenix and landed in eighth. In terms of share, the Wakeup Call with Zuko & Kayla on WCOL/Columbus leads for the eighth consecutive quarter with a 7.7, edging out second place WCTK/Providence's Cat Country Mornings with Courtney Kelley and Brendan Sharp. Rounding out the top three is WQIK/Jacksonville's The Big Show.

Afternoons: Lauren "Lo" Sessions keeps her cume crown as The Lo Show nears the half million mark with 492,000 and lands KKBQ atop both cume lists. WUSN's Scotty Kay retains second place with 469,000, while KSCS' Al Farb moves up to third.


Jumping more than a share, WCTK's **Kevin Lawrence** leads the format in afternoons with a 9.3, followed by **WQIK/Jacksonville**'s **Froggy**, who had an even 8.0. In a testament to how close the battle is in **St. Louis**, its two afternoon shows, **KSD**'s **Dusty** and **WIL**'s **Marty Brooks** tie for third with a 7.6. 



Reba, Miranda, and Ella [Langley] perform multiple times was great!" WGH/Norfolk PD Karen

West says her favorite parts were when the women (Ella and Lainey) "cleaned up" and adds, "Keith getting his day with the Triple Crown Award was spectacular."

The Jackson segment was a highlight for WFMS/Indianapolis PD Brooks O'Brian, who says his "performance and acceptance speech were incredible

and moving." Like Maxx, O'Brian says the segment had her in tears, adding, "It brought back thoughts of his impactful performance of 'Where Were You (When The World Stopped Turning)' after 9/11." Also emotional over the Jackson segment was KSON/San Diego morning co-host Tammy Lee, who says, "Tears were shed in my living room," and Kay, who concurs that, "Jackson's performance and speech gave me all the feels and left me tearing up."

of entertainment," found the Urban tribute to be "well performed by the artists, and Keith was a class act in his acceptance speech. You could see how moved he was.

"With it being the 60th anniversary, it was fun to see the heritage embraced through songs and artists, with Ella, Zach Top and Megan Moroney on the same stage as Crystal Gayle, Wynonna and Clint Black," O'Brian continues. "They did a great job of highlighting both new and established artists."

Audacy Regional VP/Programming and WDSY/Pittsburgh Brand Mgr. **Mark Anderson** attended the show in person, and says it "felt excellently produced save for the audio issue around the Group presentation. I love the dual stages and back-to-back performances. Every performance was tight and on point and I enjoyed how engaged the audience was with all of them.

"I loved the gratitude and respect the artists effused throughout this year's show, especially how well Matt [Ramsey] and Old Dominion gracefully and graciously handled the audio issue and resulting confusion around the announcement of their win by shouting out the other nominees," Anderson adds.

KYGO/Denver APD **Shawn Patrick** also attended in person, and thought it was "the best show in years. There truly wasn't a performance I didn't enjoy. The fast-moving format thanks to Amazon, and limited

commercials makes it much more enjoyable in person than when you sit though long commercial breaks. Other than the technical issues during the Group of the Year presentation, it sounded really good live, too."

But Patrick, who works for this year's ACM Major Market Station of the Year, notes, "It makes me sad that the radio awards seem to be more and more of an afterthought each year. And I think Country radio may have received one shoutout







during an acceptance speech this year. That's got to be an all-time low."

Agrees Audacy SVP/Programming & Regional VP **Justin Cole**, "I have to thank Keith Urban for thanking Country radio. Unless I missed something, he was the only one." KSON's Lee also noted the lack of radio acknowledgement, saying, "This year, they reduced the radio winners to a quick mass crowd shot. Boo."

While he agrees that the acknowledgment of radio winners "was limited to an aside" during the show, Anderson notes that in the program book given to attendees, he "was thrilled to see every nominee in every category, including previously announced awards such as radio awards, listed." He also thought it was "nice to see radio award winners make it down to the floor this year" in the venue.

Cole enjoyed the Jackson segment "but was a little surprised no one performed any of his songs, whereas

three people performed Keith Urban songs (which I also enjoyed) for his Triple Crown Award win." But, he adds, "Two of country music's biggest stars [Morgan Wallen and Luke Combs] were noticeably absent and winless; that certainly stood out to me."

"The ACM Awards this year were fantastic, definitely one of the best I've seen in quite a while," says WNFN/Nashville Brand Mgr. **Ron Allen**, who particularly enjoyed the many collaborations and McEntire's "awesome" job hosting. Like O'Brian, Allen liked seeing many of country's heritage artists included. "From the perspective of someone programming a '90s-based Country station, it was great to see that era so well-represented," he says.

KUPL/Portland, OR MD **Danny Dwyer** gives the show a seven out of 10 rating, saying the "set-up was fantastic. The arena looked amazing; they managed to make it look like the biggest party on the planet. The show itself overall was good and the opening number was a great throwback





celebrating 60 years." But he notes that at times "the prompters were off, and the sound was off on Prime. Bobby Bones seemed lost at times, and scrambling." KSON's Lee was also not a fan of what she terms Bones' "jokey/hokey delivery," saying it didn't match the rest of the show. "He's better than the jar-of-jelly bit."

While not singling out Bones, Anderson says, "The awards vibe would be better if the comedy segments were replaced with recognition of all previously announced winners including those in the venue, production and radio categories. A win is ... a career moment for those individuals, and there is a way to feature those well in an engaging and entertaining manner."

Among his other critiques, Anderson thought the show could have used a proper "In Memoriam" segment, noting, "If country is the format that is brave enough to handle real emotions, there was an opportunity for us to do something greater there." Additionally, he says, "I get that everyone is eager to showcase exciting new music on this platform, but if this is country music's largest marketing vehicle, shouldn't we use it to celebrate and reinforce the ... best musical moments of the past year?"



As for overall tone, as set by host McEntire, KSON's Lee calls it "very straightforward without the silly jokes. Reba was great, and the opening was fantastic." Country Top 40 host **Fitz** adds, "The venue was perfect for an event of this magnitude – it really showcased country music's brightest stars in a space that felt both intimate and grand. Overall, the show was a perfect reflection of what makes country music so special."




