

Next Opry Guest Announcer Is...

If you've ever dreamed of taking the podium as an announcer on the hallowed Grand Ole Opry stage, that aspiration could become an actuality. During its 75th anniversary celebration 24 years ago, the Opry



launched a guest announcer program in conjunction with a tagline, "Lend your voice to the song." Over the years, says Opry SVP/Executive Producer Dan Rogers, "We've had a lot of fun with it," putting guest announcers on the schedule for a night, often at their own request. But now, there are plans to 'up our game' for next year's 100th anniversary. "We want to really organize it, lift it up and get really interesting folks from the radio world and elsewhere," he explains.

Thus far, the guest announcers have fallen into two categories: current radio personalities of some renown, and celebrities from the worlds of film and television. The former group has included: Bob Kingsley, Lon Helton, Fitz, Big D & Bubba, Crook & Chase, Casey Kasem, Garrison Keillor, Elaina Smith, Shawn Parr, Devon O'Day, Sam Alex, Amazon Music's Amber Anderson, Sirius XM's Macie Banks, WGSQ/Cookeville, TN's Philip Gibbons,

and KYGO/Denver's Shawn Patrick. Both former WFMS/ Indianapolis morning host Jim Denny and Cumulus VP/ Country and WKDF & WSM-FM/Nashville OM/ PD Charlie Cook had the honor of guest announcing earlier this year after declaring their respective retirement plans. The latter group from

the broader entertainment world has included Robin Roberts, Nancy Grace, Pat Sajak, Dan Rather, CBS News' Bob Schieffer, and actors Susan Lucci, Robert Duvall and Billy Bob Thornton. Schieffer, an Opry fan, told Rogers that (continued on page 10)

O1 CDM Drivetime Leaders

Following the <u>analysis</u> of the format's Q1 drive-time leaders in PPM markets last month, Country Aircheck has also compiled Country's top performers for the quarter from the Nielsen's 45 Continuous Diary Measurement (CDM) markets. For the first time in more than two years, **WIVK**/ Knoxville leads in both morning and afternoon drive. The station's Joey Tack and Nancy Barger take first place with a 13.2 share - the largest for any morning show in two years. With a near three share jump to an 11.5, KXKT/Omaha's Steve Lundy and Gina Melton take second place, while WZZK/Birmingham's Rick & Bubba Show holds on to third.

In afternoon drive, WIVK's soon-to-retire Gunner leads the daypart for the first time since Q2 last year with an 11.2. As in mornings, KXKT takes the runner-up spot in afternoons, with Erik "EJ" Johnson just a tenth of a share out



Post Malone featuring Morgan Wallen: The song debuts at No. 15, making it the second highest in the monitored era of Country Aircheck/Radio & Records/Mediabase (dating back to July 1999) and the fifth highest since the Mediabase and antecedent R&R reported-playlist airplay charts were extended to 50 positions in October 1980. By both measures, it is the highest debuting song ever by an artist not named Garth.

OFF THE RECORD

Wheelhouse's **Dylan Schneider** goes **Off (The Record): My first Stagecoach appearance** was everything I could have wanted. Sunday was such a stacked lineup and getting to kick it off was an honor. I had the best time in the desert and can't wait to be back!

When I originally started writing [Bad Decisions], I wasn't sure where it was going to go. Then, "Ain't Missin' You" kicked it off, and we just went from there. I wanted to include some more personal songs with things that have been going on in my life over the last few years, as well as some good-time fun, summer songs given the time of release. I am so proud of this EP and think it's my best yet.



Social media gave birth to this whole project with the reception of "Ain't Missin' You." It was the foundation of all the songs to follow. It has given my career new legs using these platforms to get the new music out there. I'm thankful for all the new fans along the way.

"Daddy Drinks Whiskey" was a song I knew I finally needed to release, being a very personal story I had never told. I wrote it back in 2021 but needed the right time to say it. I hope it helps others who struggle with similar issues. On the other end of the spectrum, there's my song "Carhartt," written with my best friend, Gabe Foust. Every time we write together ... it's magic. We also wrote "Bad Decisions," "Buy That Girl A Beer" and "Daddy Drinks Whiskey." "Carhartt" is my song of the summer, and the one I feel every guy can relate to.

Getting to tour with my idols, Florida Georgia Line, and friend, Morgan Wallen, over the years has been more than insightful. I would watch their shows every night, just trying to soak in any and everything I could about the performance, stage presence and how to act on the road. I'm glad to have experienced that bucket list summer with them and thankful for their guidance and friendship. Proud to work with the best in the business.

Country radio can expect 2024 to be one of the biggest and best years as far as new music and touring goes! We have already hit the ground running this year harder than ever, and I don't see it slowing down. Things have never felt better as far as my world and career goes, so just be ready for more!

A high debut also comes with a massive add week. On Nov. 14, 1997, "Long Neck Bottle" by Garth Brooks was added by 202 stations on what was then a 202-station panel. That was the first song to ever close out the


entire panel in its first week. Today, "I Had Some Help" becomes the second with 158 out of 158 reporters.

Also worth nothing, last week's Most Added record, "Miles On It" by Kane Brown & Marshmello became just the third track in history to top both the Country and Top 40 Add Boards simultaneously, following Beyoncé's "Texas Hold 'Em" earlier this year and Taylor Swift's "We Are Never Ever Getting Back Together" in 2012. Look for "I Had Some Help" to become the fourth this week.

Finally, kudos to the Average Joes staff who take Bryan Martin's "We Ride" into the top 10 this week. The imprint has only cracked the top 10 once before, with 2011's "Where I Come From" by Montgomery Gentry.

he was more nervous guest hosting on that stage than he had been moderating a presidential candidate debate.


Rogers' favorite guest announcer so far has been Kasem, "just because of the questions he asked in advance and because I had not thought



about how amazing it was going to be to hear that voice reading copy I'd written." He also recalls Nancy Grace being a bit nervous before her stint onstage, noting, "As confident as she is on camera, she just wanted to make sure she got it right for the Opry."

In recent years, the Opry has begun enhancing the experience for its guest announcers, housing them backstage in their own dressing room, and gifting them with a framed Hatch Show Print commemorating their night at the mic.


"They have it down so well that it's just easy," Cook says of his April 23 Opry experience. "They take care of you and don't let you step in it." Even





as he pulled into the parking lot and gave the security guard his name on the night he was guest announcing, Cook recalls, the guard immediately knew who Cook was, and told him, "Have a great time tonight." He says, "They make sure everyone knows you're coming, and that you should be taken care of."

Cook took pictures and video of his dressing room to send to his daughters, both of whom got to listen to his Opry debut via wsmradio.com from California and Arizona, respectively. As a Country Radio Hall of Famer, his onstage experience was a little different. First, he was the subject of a Q&A onstage with the Opry's Kelly Sutton before he introduced Janson to the stage. Unexpectedly, Janson pulled Cook into the



wooden circle at the front of the stage and spoke about him for a few moments. From that experience, Cook says, "I could see the rush it gives artists to be standing in the Opry circle and having all those people applauding for you. It's pretty heady."

Country Top 40 host/Chief Imagination Officer and KPNW/Seattle

morning host Fitz guest announced on March 28, and says he went to the Opry and watched the show the night before his stint on the stage "just to understand their live format." Upon arrival, he was assigned to Porter Wagoner's former dressing room with its amusing "on air" light above the bathroom door that illuminates



when occupied. He was given a tour he calls "truly magical," and recalls that when he arrived at the famed wooden circle, "I just leaned down and touched it. You really can see all the scuffs and scars where all those legends stood."

He FaceTimed his parents back home in Texas and shared his Opry experience with them, something that was especially significant for his mother, a former country singer whose "dream was always to be standing on that stage." Says Fitz, "Thank God the WiFi was good inside the Opry and they got to see and experience it just like I did."

Once onstage, the pressure was on. Says Fitz, "You look out in that audience and there's people who have traveled from all over the world to be there. They're expecting the experience of their life, so you have to give it to them." He told the audience that night they were sharing a "bucket list" moment with him, and sums up the whole event as "mind blowing" and "a goosebump moment."

Adds Cook, "If you're ever offered that moment, grab it, because they treat you so well. It was first class all the way." Inquire about becoming a guest announcer here.




