A lot of good. And this time of year is a prime example. Another slate of radiothons (see page 7) has brought the all-in total raised so far to more than \$20 million.

The majority of those efforts, of course, are centered on St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. Almost as if Country radio said, "One billion dollars so far, huh? Hold my eggnog and watch this."

Special shoutout to The Bobby Bones Show and its \$2.85 million, and – on a single station basis – KEEY/Minneapolis with \$1.25m raised. Meanwhile, KPLX & KSCS/Dallas also crested seven figures with \$1.33m for Cook Children's Hospital. Country truly cares.

But fundraisers are only part of the story. Toy, food and card drives, plus countless local efforts to brighten a day or fill a need take place throughout this nationwide small town of country music. As the year winds down, Country Aircheck salutes all these efforts and the people who make it happen. Happy Holidays!

Family Tradition: The Waughs Big Loud VP/Radio Promotion

Big Loud VP/Radio Promotion **Tyler Waugh** follows in the footsteps of his industry vet father, **Butch** (Studio 2 Bee, Sony).

TW: I had two occupations in mind when I was a kid. One was to be an architect – I've always loved houses, the design element and drawing floor plans – but I also wanted to be in a band and had fantasies of touring and playing music.

Oakes Looks Back On Five Decades

As SummitMedia/Springfield, MO OM and **KTTS** PD **Tom Oakes** prepares to retire this month, the radio veteran of nearly 50 years reflects on his career, and a changing industry.

The fact that I'm in radio is surprising enough, because when I was in elementary school, I spent two or three years in speech therapy. I started in radio on a 1,000-watt FM in Wisconsin, and I'm sure the campus chancellor prayed to God I would never do the opera broadcast ever again. I have a hard enough time with English; trying to say French and Russian composers' names just complicates life.

While working in Alaska years later, I was diagnosed with a form of tongue cancer, which could have been career-ending. I lost a little of my tongue to surgery, and had to learn how to enunciate again. A year-and-a-half after the operation, a Sunday morning part-timer called out sick, and there was nobody else but me to do the shift. I've been on the air ever since.

My first commercial job was at KAOH/Duluth, MN, doing weekends on a 500-watt daytimer. I had carts, albums and 45s, and I was checking things off the playlist as we played David Houston, New Riders of the Purple Sage and Barbara Mandrell. We answered the phone, took the meter readings and followed the log. Today, it's all on a screen and, if you're live, you're essentially starting and stopping the automation to do breaks. We've gone from turntables to CDs to a hard drive. Portable radios, clock radios and a stereo is now down to apps on a phone.

That changes the dynamics of what people want from radio. We have to fight against the streaming platforms because we make money through commercials, but we are a free service. If we don't offer rich content that's interesting to people, we lose.

There's a lot of excitement and opportunity in smaller market radio. It's more fun because there's a bit more leeway, plus more reliance on radio for information in markets that aren't in the shadows of a big city.

One of the best promotions I've ever been involved with was at WWQM/Madison, WI. Garth Brooks had just blown up and a couple of weeks prior there had been an incident in Tulsa. The on-sale blew up the phone system and a husband hadn't been able to get a call through for an ambulance for his wife, who ended up dying. That, of course, went on the radar of every phone company in the nation. So when we announced we'd be giving away Garth tickets, a representative from Ma Bell called to grill me.

The first tickets were given away without incident, but after the next giveaway the gentleman called back and said, "You must stop this contest immediately. You blew out the phone system from Capitol Hill to Sun Prairie." We told people we'd award tickets to those people with the most unique, creative Garth and Q106 signage at local mall instead. The phone company representative became one of the judges.

I hope I leave behind a legacy of honesty, and that I've been able to help people. My first stint in Springfield, we had 40 people on staff. Today we have 19 or 20, so the industry has gone through a lot of change. But I hope I've left a positive feeling with my staff of working hard to guide, teach and allow them to grow.

I'll miss the friendships in radio and this staff, who will walk through fire for you. I'll miss talking with all the label people, who I've known for decades, even if they're always looking for a conversion. [Laughs] And I'll miss being able to introduce listeners to new music and announce major concerts.


I may not fully retire. Having pioneered the idea of "OM for hire" working in several markets for SummitMedia, I'd be open to taking a PD or OM chair on a temporary basis, especially in my home state of Wisconsin, or in Minnesota, where I'll be living. If someone needs help with programming or operations, or with FCC quarterly reports, I'm more than happy to entertain ideas. In the meantime, I'm looking forward to spending time with my family and not having to worry about whether tomorrow's log is edited or a new promo is produced.



BW: Tyler had a passion for architecture, but his teachers told us he should pursue law since he was a "spirited" debater and was determined to have his voice heard. Not sure this was a compliment.

TW: I have vivid memories of being on tour busses, backstage at concerts, going into radio stations with bands for interviews and being with my dad as he was playing songs for DJs. I didn't know exactly what my father did for a living until I was in my mid-teens and took more of an

interest in his day-to-day work activities.

As a little kid, I knew he was in the music business because he was always with an artist or on the phone talking about music. I remember seeing him with stacks of papers with letters and numbers all over them, but they were too confusing to understand. Now I know



these were radio station tracking sheets with call letters and spins.

BW: I believe Tyler's first concert was Chuck Mangione in Charlotte while I was doing promotion for A&M Records. Tyler was a constantly going to shows – ska, punk, rap, and now, country. Seeing and meeting so many stars from different genres may have driven his adventurous attitude in fashion ... and hair styles.

Tyler started his own punk band, The Fanatics, who enjoyed a nice following in New Jersey. They played one speed: wide open.

TW: My childhood and teen years were surrounded by music and me playing music. When I got accepted to USC for college and needed to choose a major, I discovered they offered a Music Business degree and learned a lot taking those classes. When my career being in a band was not in the cards, I knew I wanted to be behind the scenes and pursue a music career, like my father.

When I told him I wanted to follow in his footsteps and be a radio promotion rep, at first he didn't give me advice. He asked, "Are you crazy? You really want to do this?" I told him yes, I really did. "Are you sure? You're

really sure about this?" "Yes, dad, I'm sure about this."

BW: Dave Loncao, my RCA Head/Rock became good friends with Tyler and was impressed with his knowledge of ska, punk and rock. When Tyler was in his teens, Dave told him, "One day I'm going to hire you," and he did. When Dave became the head of Road Runner Records, he hired Tyler as his Atlanta rep.

TW: Twenty two years later and I'm still working in radio promotion.

BW: Tyler now thanks his lucky stars for landing at Big Loud, where he reports to the best in the business, Stacy Blythe.



TW: My father always told me: be truthful, be fair and *always* follow through. These tips, along with a crazy dedicated work ethic, showed me how to carry myself in this business, or in any business I ended up in.

BW: Advice I have given Tyler and anyone who has worked with me: You won't get fired for not getting the add. You'll get fired for not knowing why. And never take a "no" from someone who cannot give you a "yes."

TW: Another was, "You're only as good as the music you're working, so work good music!"

BW: When enjoying success, remember you did not get there just to be there. Your time is now. I am such a proud papa.
