Welcome To Seattle Three-attle

In just four hours on April Fools' Day, Seattle went from one Country station to three – and neither flip was a joke. At noon, Hubbard returned Adult Alternative **KPNW** to Country, 14 months after ending the five-year initial run of "98.9 The Bull." Four hours later, Lotus pulled the plug on the

30-year-old Hot AC format of **KPLZ** in favor of gold-based "Hank FM." **Country Aircheck** reached out to each of the three and analyzed signal and airplay info (see boxes page 10) for this profile of Seattle's new sound.

Backflipped: When Hubbard dropped Country from KPNW (formerly KNUC) early last year, it left Audacy **KKWF** with a format monopoly which saw the station top the market eight times since, pulling the largest share for any Country station in the market since 1994. Audacy RVP/Country and KKWF PD **Drew Bland** gave Country Aircheck the following statement regarding last week's changes: "It's nice to see all the sudden interest in the market around country music, a genre we've proudly delivered consistently to the Seattle market every day for nearly 20 years."

Hubbard's departure and relatively quick return is a bit of an admission from the company. "We thought going into Triple A we were filling a void

left in the market since The Mountain [KMTT] flipped out of the format," says Hubbard/Seattle OM **Scott Mahalick**. "If we had two or three more years it could've grown into a successful brand, but at the end of the day we're a commercial broadcaster and there's a bigger opportunity in Country. The exact timing of that flip was off. The music cycle had just heated back up, so that was a mistake.

"We questioned whether or not we should return to Country the past few months, but we wanted to give [Triple A] a year and see what kind of traction it got," elaborates Mahalick. "It got a very loyal audience, but it just wasn't big enough. We thought, 'Okay, The Wolf is a big No. 1 with no challenger,' and Lotus was probably thinking the same thing. Either we reenter or somebody else is going to; it was totally coincidental that we both flipped on the same day."

Special K: WOGK at 30

Few stations reach the level of consistent dominance exhibited by Saga's **WOGK/Gainesville, FL**. Since signing on as "K Country" March 11,


1994, the station has been No. 1 in 70 of 75 ratings surveys. WOGK was named CMA Small Market Station of the Year in just its second year on the air, and **Jim Robertson**, who served as GM from sign-on until his retirement in 2019, will be inducted into the Country Radio Hall of Fame in June. Incredibly, the current airstaff boasts a combined 122 years with the station.






host **Rick "Big Red" Brooks** (all with WOGK since its launch) share their thoughts about what makes WOGK so special.

"When I flipped the switch at 5pm that day, the phones lit up like a Christmas tree," recalls Stokes. "All the listeners were cussing us out. 'What the hell are you doing?' By day two, the phone calls subsided and we started getting positive feedback. By the time I did my first K Country remote, people were thanking us for bringing back the old songs."

"Young Country was so hot back then and a lot of stations had pulled out their gold titles," adds Brooks. "With the mix of newer and older music







when K Country went on the air," recalls Dugan. "All of a sudden, the owners were scrambling for everyone to sign a non-compete. I was young and didn't know any better. I didn't sign one and was let go; three months later I got a job working overnights at WOGK."

WOGK was playing, I knew it was going

Performing my own songs on

American Idol is something I was set on when I auditioned for the show. I wanted to sing some of my own songs earlier on. The way the show is formatted though, I didn't get the chance to sing an original until Mother's Day, when I got to sing my song "Mama."



My experience on the show taught me the art of "hurry up and wait," how to find patience in the chaos, and I learned a ton about the business on both the TV production and musical side of things.

My only goal with my debut album, *Bad For Me*, was to put together what I thought were some of the best songs from my collection. I guess there has been a theme in my writing overall, so that kind of took care of itself.

I wrote some of the songs a while back. They are as true to my story as they were when I penned them, so I absolutely connect with them in the same way as I did then. I got to cut a lot of music I have wanted to cut for a long time through doing this album.

I love "If I Had A Week." I would have done more like this if we had the time. It's a song about missing home, wherever that may be, but also appreciating the journey you're on and where that road takes you. I also love "Addicted And Clean," which is a very honest song about where I was when I moved to Nashville. "Mama" is always special for me, and "Glitter" is one that's nice on the ears.

The response from fans to the new music has been awesome so far. We just started a tour with a new set and music, and it's amazing to see the listeners embracing the songs with open arms.

I don't even know what to expect from myself in 2024 and beyond. I couldn't have called how or when any of this was going to work out. I know now more than ever how important it is to be patient. But one thing I can guarantee is more music. I plan on doing what I have been doing – making music, playing shows and meeting my fans. Wherever that may take me, it's a road I'm happy to be on. I do know we will be sending another tune to radio soon, and I have my fingers crossed for that. Ultimately, I'm just happy to be right here, right now.






"We just had our 38th annual K Country Acoustic Concert," adds Stokes. "They go all the way back to when Blake Shelton was first out. After that show, we sang karaoke at a local bar." Brooks recalls another highlight: "We had Garth at 'The Swamp' [Ben Hill Griffin Stadium] in 2019 – 80,000 fans, that was nuts."

"What stands out to me is how we handled the pandemic," says Dugan. "When everything shut down, we were the only link to the outside world for a lot of listeners. We brought the world to them with acoustic concerts on Zoom. It was the human touch during all that."

"We have people who come up to us and say their family has grown with ours," says Forster. "If you can create that with your listeners, that's a major key. The re-born Bull will differ from its predecessor in some ways, notably by having market vet Fitz in mornings instead of the prior iteration's use of syndication (*The Bobby Bones Show*) – though the former manned the daypart prior to 2020. "We're letting the talent bring country back to 98.9," Mahalick says. "Fitz is currently the voice of The Bull 24/7. We realized we had a very loyal Country audience we abandoned, so we sincerely apologized [and] we're letting the company take the blame. We're going to keep that humble nature and build the brand back. The country life group likes a comeback story, and they'll forgive you if you're honest. It's like in a relationship when you split for a while, make your peace and get back together."

Mahlick says social media response has been overwhelmingly positive. "This is a very competitive market and we're not taking anything for granted," he admits. "The acceptance has been nice, but we know what we're up against; nobody's sitting around going, 'Isn't it great, everybody's coming back?' It's going to be a lot of hard work."

Hank's For The Memories:

"I started working on a concept for Country back in November, but the actual trigger wasn't pulled until about five or six weeks ago," says Lotus Pres. James Kalmenson of the decision to flip KPLZ. "We did a promotion in February and put a significant amount of money into marketing Star. I wasn't seeing any movement in the weeklies, and I had research that suggested Star as a brand had run its course. We were in a space with eight AC-ish stations next to each other and it was hard to break through. That, plus the obvious opportunity sitting there with Country, made it irresistible."



The launch wasn't initially planned for April 1. "I was planning to launch a week later but I moved it up because our sales manager was going to be on vacation," Kalmenson says. The morning of the flip, he called a meeting with his sales staff. "I could not believe the reaction. They almost stood up and applauded. One said, 'I pray this is not an Aprils Fool's joke.'"

Not long after that meeting, Kalmenson got a shock when KPNW made its flip. His reaction: "Are you f***ing kidding me? I kind of chuckled for a second, but as I digested the news, it began to feel good." He quickly called another meeting, "The staff's response was, 'We'd rather be one of three Countrys than one of eight ACs.'" Lotus launched its first Country station last month (KWEE/Reno), which also uses Kroeger Media's Hank FM brand.

"The fact that two stations flipped together generated so much press for Country in the market – that's fantastic for all three of us," says Kalmenson. "The waiter at dinner last night had heard about Hank. The Uber driver I had this morning heard about it. Everybody thinks Country is exploding in here, so it's nice for all of us to be associated with that. We're going to make Country look big, strong, and healthy in Seattle." 




